Aztecs Notes

Quashing the Rebellion

San Diego State has a 21-10-2 record against UNLV all-time with a 14-6-2 mark since Mike Friesen took over the helm of the program. The Aztecs are 8-6-1 when playing at UNLV and 6-3-1 when playing in Las Vegas under Friesen. The Azetcs have won each of the last three matchups including last year in the regular season and MW Tournament.

Spartan Slayers
The Aztecs are 16-2-4 all-time against San Jose State. SDSU hasn't lost to SJSU since 2015 and is 14-1-4 against the Spartans under Mike Friesen including a 5-2-2 road record in San Jose during the Friesen era. SDSU won 2-1 in 2024.

Friesen's 200 victories (200-124-54) since the start of the 2007 season, the year he took control of the program, are the most by any coach in MW history. Boise State's Jim Thomas rank second among current MW head coaches. Friesen earned his 200th win against Grand Canyon on September 25.

Home Cooking

SDSU went 8-5-1 at home in 2024 and has lost just once in seven home matches in 2025. The Aztecs had a whopping 14-1 goal differential during their five home conference matches last season. San Diego State was perfect at home during conference play in 2023 as well and is 11-0-1 since the start of 2023 in conference home matches with a 29-5 goal differential.

Above the Rest

SDSU leads the all-time series against every current MW member. The records: AFA (24-1-2, .926), Nevada (15-2-0, .882), CSU (9-1-2, .833), SJSU (16-2-4, .818), USU (9-1-4, .786), FS (16-5-3, .729), Wyoming (18-7-4, .690), UNLV (21-10-2, .667), CC (7-3-6, .625), UNM (15-11-8, .559), BSU (11-10-0, .524) and GCU (1-0-0, 1.000).

Miller Time

Victoria Miller leads the Aztecs with five goals. After scoring against Cal State Bakersfield on August 17, Miller struck twice to tie the match at Pepperdine at two on September 11. She followed it up with the game-winning goal against UC Riverside and Nevada. The September 15 MW Offensive Player of the Week also scored the Aztecs' preseason goal at Southern California.

Goin(s) the Distance

A 2024 and 2025 Mountain West Preseason Watch List selection, Grace Goins was named the Mountain West Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 22 after leading the Aztecs defense to a pair of shutouts. Goins picked up her first point of the season on an assist on Miller's second goal at Pepperdine. She came through with four goals a season ago and has played nearly every minute of every match for the Aztecs since joining the team for the 2022 campaign.

Senn-sational

Katie Senn did not score a goal and had three career points on a trio of assists in her first 26 career matches including vs. Cal State Bakersfield. That changed at Pepperdine when Senn had an assist and scored the match winner for her first career score for a total of three points. She had a repeat performance with a goal and assist against UC Riverside in the next match before tallying her team-leading and conference-leading fourth and fifth assists against Nevada and Colorado College.

Staying in Our Lane
A two-time Mountain West Freshman of the Week in 2024 (Sept. 30 and Nov. 2), Mia Lane was the first player in program history to earn the award multiple times and second player overall. Lane garnered those accolades after logging a gool and an assist in a 5-0 win against Nevada on September 26 before another goal in the regular season finale at New Mexico on October 31. This year, she picked up an assist against Cal State Bakersfield before scoring her first goal of the season against Nevada. Lane found the back of the net for her second goal of 2025 for the game-winner in the conference opener at Grand Canyon.

Alexyz Nakamoto scored her first collegiate goal on September 15, 2024, to tie the match against Eastern Washington at one (the Aztecs would go on to win 4-2). In the team's next match, Nakamoto struck again, scoring against Utah Valley on September 22. She picked up her first point of 2025 on an assist of Alexis Leath's goal against Nevada.

Shipping up to Boston In her 2024 season debut against Nevada on September 26, Boston Girman attempted the second shot of her career and scored her first career goal.

Charlie Hustle

Charlie Gerson scored her first career goal against UC Riverside to double the Aztecs' lead to 2-0. Last season, she notched her first assist and point of her career when she found Denise Castro for the game-tying goal in the final three minutes at Air Force.

Jumping Into the Deep End
Last season, Alexyz Nakamoto and Mia Lane became the first pair of Aztec freshmen to score in the same season since Denise
Castro and Alexys Ocampo in 2021. •

Iron Mike

Head Coach Mike Friesen is in his 19th campaign leading the Mountain West's most successful women's soccer program. Friesen has guided his squad to 11 Mountain West championships (five tournament and six regular season), and five NCAA Tournament appearances, both the most among any current league head coach. Friesen has an 114-37-24 record. His 113 league victories are the most by any head coach in Mountain West history.

Looking into the Crystal Ball
San Diego State was picked to finish in fourth place in the MW coaches' preseason poll. This marks just the second time in 16 seasons the Aztecs have been picked to finish outside the top two. The only previous time SDSU was lower than second place in the preseason poll in that time was in 2019, a year in which the Aztecs were also predicted to finish fourth. That team earned a share of the Mountain West regular-season title at 8-2-0, and reached the championship match of the league tournament.

Best in the (Mountain) West

The Aztecs have won ten of the last 25 MW trophies (regular season and tournament), all of which have come under the direction of head coach Mike Friesen. In total, the 19th-year head coach has guided San Diego State to 11 conference titles.

Top of the Mountain (West)
San Diego State has earned 12 Mountain West titles since the conference's inception in 1999. SDSU was the regular season champions in 1999, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2019 and 2023. The program was the tournament champion in 2009, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2017. The Aztecs' lead all current teams in each category and have the most regular season titles while trailing only Brigham Young (7 tournament titles, 13 overall) in all-time titles.

Got My Eye On YouSDSU had three players selected to the Mountain West Preseason Watch List. This year's selections were senior Grace Goins (for the second straight season) and juniors Alexys Ocampo and Katie Senn.

Five current Aztecs were named Academic All-Mountain West last season for maintaining a cumulative 3.0 GPA or better while competing in at least half of the team's matches. Charlie Gerson, Grace Goins, Riley Gumm, Mia Lane and Alexyz Nakamoto earned the honor during the 2024 season. Goins also did so the year prior. Six members of the 2025 squad were named Mountain West Scholar-Athletes in 2024: Emma Fuller, Charlie Gerson, Riley Gumm, Brynn Korpela, Karoline Lundstrom and Alexyz Nakamoto. To become a Mountain West Scholar-Athete, student-athletes must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.50 or better while completing at least two semesters of school.

Finishing Strong
San Diego State has been strong when it came to finishing off opponents. In 2024, SDSU finished with a 9-2-1 record in matches in which it led including wins in the last eight matches led by the Aztecs prior to the Mountain West Semifinals. The Aztecs have not lost any of the seven matches they led in 2025. When that lead was at halftime, the team went 6-1-0 in 2024, and has won all three matches with a halftime lead this season.

Team of the Future

San Diego State has just five upperclassmen on the roster this season: senior Grace Goins and juniors Boston Girman, Taryn Grobbel, Alexys Ocampo and Katie Senn. The other 20 players on the roster are underclassmen (nine sophomores and 11 freshmen).

A Hot Start

When the Aztecs scored first since the start of the 2024 season, they have gone on to win eleven and tied three of their 15 matches. They were riding a seven-match winning streak before scoring first in a defeat in the Mountain West Semifinals.

We Have Portal at Home

Of the 25 players on SDSU's 2025 roster, 23 have spent their entire careers as Aztecs. Just two players, newcomers Victoria Miller and Rory Schank joined the Aztecs through the transfer portal. Schank redshirted during her season at Auburn and did not see the field in any matches while Miller is the lone Aztec to compete in a different uniform. She played in 15 matches, starting twice at Ohio State last season.

Going Global

San Diego State has five international players on its 2025 roster. A native on Montpellier, France, Lily Boudet is in her third season on the Aztecs and attempted two shots (one on goal) across ten matches back in 2023 before not seeing any action last season. Joining her are a pair of freshmen defenders from Northern Europe. Alexandra Myrestam is a native of Stockholm, Sweden, while Mia Hambro Svendsen hails from Oslo, Norway. In addition to the European trio, SDSU also has a duo of Canadian freshmen forwards: Ciara Jade Mitchell from Vancouver, British Columbia, and Eva Vespa, a native of St. Leonard, Quebec.

Across the Nation

The Aztecs have players from eight different states. 12 of the 25 players on the roster are in-state California natives. Two players: Victoria Miller and Taryn Grobbel come from Michigan. Meanwhile, SDSU has a player each from Colorado (Mia DeJohn), Georgia (Karoline Lundstrom), Hawai'i (Alexyz Nakamoto), Illinois (Riley Gumm), Pennsylvania (Eva Wierzbowski) and Texas (Rory

On the Hunt

SDSU's newest addition to the coaching staff for 2025 is goalkeeper coach Louis Hunt. He served as an assistant coach and the Head of Goalkeeping for San Diego Wave FC from their inaugural 2022 season through 2024. Hunt has previously worked at the collegiate level, as he was an assistant coach at DII Cal Poly Pomona from 2013-15. Finally, he has also worked with US Youth National Teams. Hunt has been a coach and scout for the U15-U20 age groups since 2015 and now is also the Goalkeeper Coach for the U23 squad.

Pacific Specifics

San Diego State played two exhibibtion matches and has 17 regular season matches this year. 11 of those 19 matches come at home (ten on the SDSU Sports Deck, one at Snapdragon Stadium). Seven of the eight road matches are in the Pacific time zone, meaning SDSU will leave PT just once, for a match at Colorado State on October 23. Of the other seven road matches, five are in California, one is in Arizona (during the part of the year that the state aligns with PT) and one is in Nevada.
