## Week 6 - vs. California Baptist; Weekend Home Series vs. Colorado State - San Diego, Calif.

### Aztecs Host CBU, Opens MW Play Against CSU

The San Diego State softball team will host California Baptist on Wednesday to conclude the non-conference portion of its schedule. Then, SDSU begins its final season of Mountain West competition by hosting Colorado State for a three-game home series from Friday through Sunday.

The Aztecs play the Lancers at 6 p.m. PT on Wednesday night. The Colorado State series will feature games at 6 p.m. on Friday night, 4 p.m. on Saturday and noon on Sunday. Saturday's contest will be broadcast on the Mountain West Network.

SDSU is 7-1 against the Lancers all-time including a 6-2 win against California Baptist on February 25 of last season. All eight games have come since 2019 and SDSU is 6-0 going back to the start of the 2021 campaign. The Aztecs 72-43 against Colorado State all-time. The teams split a pair of games in Fort Collins last season but the last time the Rams traveled to San Diego, SDSU swept a three-game series in 2024.

Last week, SDSU scored 13 runs including seven in the first inning as Faith Jordan no-hit Long Beach State in a 13-0 win at the Beach on Wednesday night. Jordan's outing was the fifth no-hitter in recorded program history. Following a 5-4 defeat against Wisconsin on Thursday in which the Badgers scored all their runs in the seventh inning, Notre Dame scored four times in the first inning and SDSU's comeback came up short in a 4-3 final against the Fighting Irish on Saturday. The Aztecs finished the weekend in style on Sunday when Jazmin Williams, Angie Yellen and Jayleen Hernandez each homered to power the Aztecs past Princeton by a 14-6 score in six innings. Yellen finished a triple shy of the cycle in the game, going 4-for-4 with a single, two doubles and the homer. She hit .667 over the course of the week, tallying a 1.750 OPS, four RBIs, 13 total bases and five runs scored. Williams also put together an excellent week, hitting .500 with a 1.604 OPS, seven RBIs, seven runs scored and 15 total bases. Key-annah Pu'a had a pair of special performances, throwing 6.1 scoreless innings against both Wisconsin and Notre Dame, allowing no walks and just nine hits.

Two-time MW Player of the Week Jade Ignacio and Jazmin Williams (.418, 1.183 OPS, 22 RBI, 21 R, 5 SB) lead the Aztec hitters (.444, 1.118 OPS, 3 HR, 20 RBI, 16 R, 8 2B, 5 SB). Other top hitters for SDSU include Angie Yellen (.406, .981 OPS, 9 RBI, 11 R, 2 HR, 4 2B, 2 SB), Olivia Gigante (.261, .890 OPS, 6 HR, 18 RBI, 10 R, 3 2B), Julie Holcomb (.296, 16 R, 7 SB) and Quinn Waiki (.324, .788 OPS, 8 RBI, 7 R, 5 2B). In the circle, Faith Jordan (3.09 ERA, 43.0 IP, 28 K, 6-2, 1 SV) and Matti Kwarta (4.86 ERA, 36.0 IP, 18 K, 5-3) have been major contributors to the pitching staff. Key-annah Pu'a (2.83 ERA, 47.0 IP, 16 K, 2-3, 1 SV) was selected as MW Pitcher of the Week on Feb. 16.

## Stacey Nuvean Deniz

Head Coach | 5th Season (18th overall) | UCLA, 2002

- Was named San Diego State's fifth head coach in program history on June 8, 2021, taking over for SDSU's all-time winningest head coach Kathy Van Wyk.
- Helped lead SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 14 seasons on The Mesa as an assistant coach, associate head coach and head coach in waiting.
- In her first season as SDSU's head coach in 2022, San Diego State went 39-16 (.712) for the second-best winning percentage in school history, winning the Mountain West regular-season title for the first time since 2014.
- Was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year in 2022 in her first season as head coach and again last year.
- Through 2025, is 147-72 (.671) as head coach at SDSU leading the Aztecs to a MW Tournament title each of the last three years as well as two of four regular season championships.
- Was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits for the 2018 season, leading the Bandits to the NPF Championship series in her first year.
- Led the AUSL Bandits to the title game in the league's inaugural season last summer
- Also has served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team and USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) Selection Camps.
- As a player, was a three-time U.S. Olympian, winning gold medals in 2000 and 2004, and a silver medal in 2008. Also helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003).
- Was a standout player at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a four-time first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02).
- In 1999, Nuvean Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and 91 RBIs.

## 15 NCAA TOURNAMENT APPEARANCES

### Notes on the Season so Far

- \* SDSU finished the 2025 campaign with a 38-19 record, recoding the team's fourth straight 30-win season under Stacey Nuvevan Deniz and appearing in the NCAA Los Angeles Regional, earning a win over Arizona State.
- \* San Diego State earned the Mountain West's bid to the NCAA Tournament for the fourth straight year after winning four straight games to earn the MW tournament title for the third consecutive season after it was brought back following a 16-year hiatus.
- \* The Aztecs are off to a 14-10 start through 24 games with 13 played at home (9-4), two on the road (2-0) and nine at neutral sites (3-6).
- \* SDSU ranks 26th in the nation in accumulative attendance at 8,985 despite playing fewer home games than all but a dozen of the teams ranked ahead of it. The only other teams to rank as highly outside of autonomous four conferences are South Florida (tenth, American), Louisiana (12th, Sun Belt) and McNeese State (19th, Southland).
- \* The Aztecs' opponents this season combined for at least a share of ten conference championships in 2025.
- \* San Diego State has played ten games against teams from autonomous four conferences this season including four against ranked opposition.
- \* According to NCAA RPI (as of March 10), San Diego State is ranked 53rd out of 308 teams.
- \* The Aztecs have played the 44th-toughest strength of schedule in the country this year and are 44th in non-conference.
- \* The teams the Aztecs have played this year have a combined winning percentage of .589, 45th best in the nation.
- \* San Diego State's average adjusted RPI loss this season is 67, an improvement from last season.
- \* The Aztecs have played six games against top-25 RPI schools this season in No. 13 Texas Tech (L, 0-5), No. 14 Oklahoma (L, 2-10), No. 21 Washington (L, 2-16; L, 3-11) and No. 23 Baylor (W, 4-3; L, 2-11).
- \* 12 of SDSU's 50 games this year come against top-50 RPI schools (SDSU is 2-5 so far).
- \* SDSU has won eight games this season via walk-off plays including five on go-ahead plays. The Aztecs had six walk-offs in ten games after two weekends.
- \* Ava Schaffel and Candace Tarle combined to allow one hit in the win over North Dakota on February 14, marking the 40th one-hitter by San Diego State this century and first since Sarah Lehman and Dee Dee Hernandez limited San Jose State to one hit in five innings in an 8-0 win in the 2023 Mountain West Tournament championship game on May 13 of that year.
- \* San Diego State won three extra-inning games as part of the Campbell/Cartier Classic, matching the most extra inning wins in a season by the Aztecs since the 2023 team that made NCAA Super Regionals went 3-0 in extra-inning games.
- \* Only half of San Diego State's games this season have been seven innings. The Aztecs have played in eight games decided by the run rule, going 5-3 in those contests. SDSU is 3-1 across four extra-inning games this season. The Aztecs are 6-6 in seven-inning games.
- \* The Aztecs have wins against teams from eight different conferences so far this season (SouthEastern Conference, Big Ten, Big 12, West Coast Conference, Atlantic 10, Big West, Summit League and Ivy League).
- \* SDSU hit back-to-back-to-back home runs in the first inning at San Diego on February 26. It marked the first time the Aztecs accomplished the feat in the last decade and Jade Ignacio, Jazmin Williams and Angie Yellen became the third SDSU trio to each homer in an inning during that time frame. Mac Barbara, Cali Decker and AJ Murphy each homered in the first inning of a 9-1 win at Boise State on May 9, 2024, during the Quarterfinals of the Mountain West Tournament. The previous time was in a 10-4 win over Miami (Ohio) on March 4, 2017. The player to homer in that inning were Jenavee Peres, Katie Byrd and Jaylene Ignacio, Jade's sister.
- \* Jazmin Williams would go on to homer in each of the next two days as well, becoming the first Aztec to hit a home run in three straight days since Mac Barbara did so between February 24-26, 2022. Williams hit her home runs against San Diego, Washington and Washington while Barbara's were against Cal State Fullerton, Northwestern and Missouri in the 2022 Mary Nutter.
- \* Faith Jordan no-hit Long Beach State on March 4, becoming the fourth Aztec pitcher to throw a no-hitter, the fifth in recorded SDSU history. The others were Maggie Balint (May 6, 2022), Celena Velasquez (March 4, 2005) and Bre DeSanta (March 4 & 18, 2003). Three of SDSU's five recorded no-hitters occurred on the fourth of March.
- \* Jazmin Williams, Angie Yellen and Jayleen Hernandez each homered in the offensive outburst against Princeton on March 8. It marked the most home runs San Diego State hit in a home game since also hitting three against Northern Illinois on February 12, 2023. The last time SDSU had more was a five-homer game against Miami (Ohio) on March 4, 2017. The 14-6 win marked the most runs scored in a game by San Diego State since a 14-1 win at San Jose State on April 12, 2024.
- \* Olivia Gigante and Jazmin Williams became the first pair of Aztec teammates since Lorena Bauer and Patrice Jackson in 2013 to each hit at least six home runs prior of the start of conference play. That season, Bauer and Jackson combined for 31 homers.
