Key novelties Erasmus+ 2021-27

- □ A more inclusive and accesible programme
- Promoting the use of digital tools and the development of digital skills
- Making the programme more environmentally sustainable and fostering sustainable behaviours
- □ Enhancing active participation in society
- Fostering synergies between different funding schemes

... and a significantly increased budget

EUR 24.57 billion in current prices + additional 1.7 billion in 2018 prices





Policy context: Digital Education Action Plan

Priorities

- Priority 1: Developing a high performing digital education ecosystem
- Priority 2: Enhancing digital competences for the digital transformation

Guiding principles

- High quality, equality, accessibility and inclusiveness of digital education
- Transforming education for the digital age
- Enhancing competences of all teachers and trainers to become competent and confident users of digital education



The digital dimension of Erasmus+

Digital is part of the programme design, activities and processes

- mobility formats
- thematic priorities
- cooperation projects
- platforms
- communities
- tools
- policy support
- digitalisation of the programme's implementation



Mobility

inclusive & flexible formats: e.g. blended mobility and virtual learning
 mobility in digital fields to foster digital skills development

Examples

- Digital Opportunity Traineeships scheme: scaled-up for learners in higher education & expanded to VET
- new Youth participation activities: develop digital competences & media literacy
 Erasmus Online Linguistic Support Platform: e-learning linguistic support to accompany physical mobility in all sectors.



Cooperation

boost exchanges on digital, distance and online learning and teaching
 digital skills development for learners and educators
 innovative practices and digital pedagogies

Examples

European Universities, Centres for Vocational Excellence, Erasmus+ Teacher Academies

- reinforced support for platforms (eTwinning, EPALE, School Education Gateway or the Youth Portal)
- further development of tools (SELFIE, Europass, Youthpass, European Student Card initiative)



Policy support

- contribute to the development of modern digital policies and reforms at system level
- mutual learning activities, policy dialogue and experimentation for policy makers and practitioners
