The site confirmed that the lights are operational. The left taillight lens is damaged at the bottom. The rear work lights are absent. The headliner in the cab seems to be drooping at the rear. The material on the operator's seat is torn. The upper engine enclosure at the rear appears to be bent and has a dent in the screen. The engine oil is dark in color. The bucket steps are bent. The left track appears to be loose. The sprockets on both sides are worn out. The lift cylinder is leaking. The right sprocket appears to be oily, indicating a leak from the final drive. The tilt cylinders appear to be oily and possibly leaking.










