NO. 16 WAKE FOREST AT NO. 25 FLORIDA STATE

THE MATCHUP

• No. 16 Wake Forest returns to ACC play over the weekend, traveling to No. 25 Florida State for a three-game ACC series.

LAST TIME OUT

- Wake Forest split a pair of midweek games, falling to High Point before rebounding with a 9-2 victory at High Point.
- Tied at 2-2 heading into the seventh, the Demon Deacons hit three home runs over the last three innings to pull away. Stuart Fairchild hit what proved to be the game-winner in the seventh, while Ben Breazeale went deep in the eighth and Bruce Steel homered in the ninth.
- Deacon pitchers combined to strike out nine batters without a walk, allowing just six hits. Morgan McSweeney earned the win in relief after John McCarren received a no decision despite tossing 5.0 shutout frames.

WAKE FOREST STORYLINES

- The Deacons are a consensus top-25 team for the first time in more than a decade. Wake Forest is ranked by Baseball America (16), NCBWA (19), USA Today Coaches (20), D1Baseball (21) Perfect Game (21), and Collegiate Baseball (23).
- Wake Forest clinched a spot in the ACC Baseball Championship with Sunday's win over Boston College. The Demon Deacons have already locked up a top-nine seed, as they're guaranteed to finish in front of or hold tiebreakers over Boston College, Duke, Georgia Tech, Notre Dame and Virginia Tech.
- For the first time in program history, five different Demon Deacons have double-digit home run totals: Gavin Sheets (17), Johnny Aiello (15), Stuart Fairchild (11), Keegan Maronpot (10) and Bruce Steel (10). The last time Wake Forest had at least four players in double figures was 2001: Jamie D'Antona (17), Carlos Brackley (14), Cory Sullivan (13) and Corey Slavik (10).

OPPONENT AND SERIES HISTORY

- Florida State leads the all-time series by an 88-25 margin. Last year, Wake Forest won its first series over the Seminoles since 2002, taking 2-of-3 from then-No. 4 FSU in Winston-Salem.
- The Seminoles enter the weekend with a 32-18 overall record, including 11-12 in the ACC. Florida State has series wins over Boston College, Notre Dame and Clemson, dropping series to Virginia Tech, North Carolina, NC State and Virginia.

LOOKING AHEAD

- Wake Forest plays App State in Shelby on Tuesday before wrapping up the regular season vs. Pittsburgh Thursday-Saturday.

OFFENSIVE FIREPOWER

- The Demon Deacons rank among the national leaders in several offensive categories. Wake Forest's 82 longballs are most in the nation, and marks the first time reaching 80 since 1999. The Deacs also rank in the top 30 nationally in average, runs, hits, doubles, slugging and walks.
- Individually, Gavin Sheets leads the country with 70 RBIs. He is joined by Johnny Aiello in the top 50 nationally in homers.

WALTER WINS 200

- Wake Forest head coach Tom Walter won his 200th game at the helm of the Demon Deacons vs. USC on Feb. 26.
- Last year, he surpassed John Caddell's (1926-39) mark of 183 for third-most wins as the skipper all-time. George Greer (1988-04) leads with 608, while Marvin Crater (1976-87) is second with 269.

SWING AND A MISS

- Right-handed pitcher Parker Dunshee fanned 102 batters in 101.1 innings last year, becoming the first Deac to strike out 100+ since Kyle Sleeth in 2003. The mark of 102 ranks tied for seventh in program history.
- Dunshee ranks second in program history for career strikeouts with 302. That number is 10 away from John Hendricks' all-time record of 312 strikeouts from 1996-99. Dunshee has racked up 83 so far this season through 72.2 innings pitched.

TEAM LEADERS

- Wake Forest has three captains for the 2017 season: seniors Parker Dunshee and John McCarren, and junior Gavin Sheets.
- Dunshee earns the role for the second-straight season.

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- Heading into his junior year, two-time All-ACC honoree Stuart Fairchild collected national honors from various media outlets.
- He was named to the 55-man Golden Spikes Award preseason watch list by USA Baseball.
- Baseball America (second team), Collegiate Baseball (second team), D1Baseball (third team) and Perfect Game (third team) recognized Fairchild as a Preseason All-American.
- Additionally, the NCBWA picked senior Parker Dunshee as a third team Preseason All-American.
- D1Baseball rated Dunshee as the No. 7 senior prospect in the 2017 MLB Draft. Fairchild was rated as a top-100 collegiate prospect in the upcoming draft by Baseball America, D1Baseball and Perfect Game.

DRAFTED DEACS

- Wake Forest had a total of four players drafted in the 2016 MLB Draft, including two who decided to return to the Deacs in 2017.
- Will Craig was selected 22nd overall in the first round by the Pittsburgh Pirates and signed a pro contract. He became Wake Forest's sixth-ever first-round pick, and the first since 2008.
- Nate Mondou was drafted 382nd overall in the 13th round and also began his professional career.
- Parker Dunshee (Cubs - 14th round, 434th pick) and Chris Farish (Indians - 31st round, 932nd pick) were also drafted but chose to continue their collegiate careers.
- The Demon Deacons have had a current player or incoming signee selected in the MLB Draft for 37 consecutive seasons.

- Additionally, graduated seniors Aaron Fossas (Reds) and Garrett Kelly (Twins) signed free agent contracts and began their pro careers last summer.

PARDON OUR MESS

- Thanks in large part to a \$3 million gift from David Couch, construction wrapped up on the first phase of a \$14 million player development center. The stadium was dedicated as David F. Couch Ballpark in February 2016 in honor of the former Wake Forest baseball and football student-athlete.
- Along the third-base line, the 41,000-square foot facility includes a team locker room, lounge, training room, equipment room, a full kitchen and pro players locker space. The project included renovation and relocation of the home dugout and bullpen and construction of a pitching laboratory, complete with 18 high-speed cameras to analyze the biomechanics of each player. Players moved into the new building on Feb. 20.
- Fundraising efforts are still underway for future phases of construction and renovations, including the video conference room, team meeting room, and coaches' offices on the second floor, as well as a 100'x100' indoor batting facility, which will be adjacent to the player development center and will be constructed without interior supporting posts. Above the facility, renovations include the concessions stands and restrooms as well as a concourse-level viewing area.
- Previous renovations include:
 - 2015: Visiting clubhouse converted into state-of-the-art weight room facility.
 - 2013: Multi-colored chairback seats replaced with modern all-black seats.
 - 2012: 18' x 24' LED video board installed.
 - 2011: AstroTurf GameDay 3D52H Grass installed, as well as the manual scoreboard in left field.
 - 2010: Indoor hitting facility built beyond left field.
 - 2009: Wake Forest purchased and moved into stadium. It previously belonged to MiLB team Winston-Salem Dash since it was built in 1956.

WAKE FOREST HEAD COACH TOM WALTER



- Head coach Tom Walter is in his eighth season at the helm of Wake Forest baseball.
- Prior to coming to Wake Forest, Walter was the head coach of New Orleans from 2005-09, compiling a record of 153-147.
- He started his head coaching career as the head mentor of George Washington from 1997-2004. Walter won 275 games and had a winning percentage of .599.
- Walter is the only active head coach in the country to lead three different programs to the NCAA Division I Tournament, becoming just the seventh coach all-time to do so. He joins the ranks of Larry Cochell, Augie Garrido, Sunny Golloway, Andy Lopez, Ron Polk and Jack Stallings.
- Players drafted from Wake Forest under Walter include Mac Williamson, Tim Cooney, Brian Holmes, Michael Dimock, Pat Blair, Niko Spezial, John McLeod, Jack Fischer, Connor Kaden, Conor Keniry, Matt Pirro, Will Craig, Nate Mondou, Parker Dunshee and Chris Farish. Williamson and Cooney made their MLB debuts in 2015 after being third-round picks in 2012.
- At Wake Forest, Walter has overseen the development of 2016 National Player of the Year Will Craig, All-America selections Craig, Nate Mondou and Stuart Fairchild, and a total of 11 All-ACC selections. Wake Forest had five All-ACC picks in 2016, the program's most since 2002.
- Walter also has experience working with USA Baseball, spending time in the summer of 2016

as a manager of the Stars team at the 17U National Team Development Program.

- Walter donated his kidney to outfielder Kevin Jordan days before the 2011 season after Jordan was diagnosed with a serious kidney disease.
- Wake Forest has posted five straight winning seasons (2012-16) for the first time since the Deacs had seven straight from 1997-2003.
- He guided his 2006 team at New Orleans through the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina. The team spent the fall in Las Cruces, New Mexico, then spent time in Mobile, Alabama, and Westwego, Louisiana, before returning to campus in March.
- The Johnstown, Pennsylvania native earned his degree from Georgetown in 1991 and a master's from George Washington in 1994.

Walter started all four seasons for the Hoyas as a catcher and outfielder.

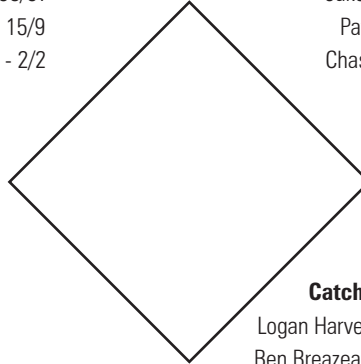

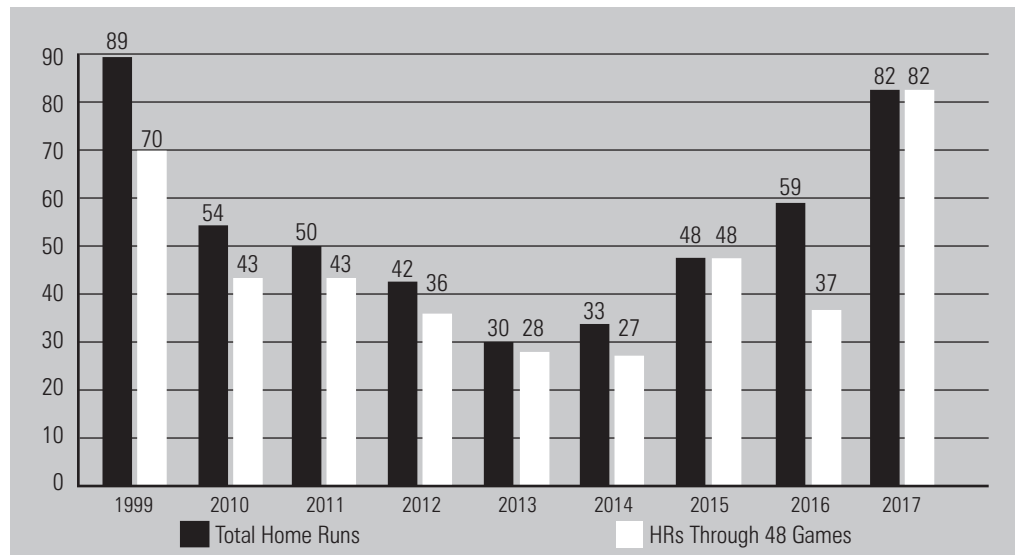
