FLORIDA STATE OVERVIEW

- Florida State is led by 38th-year head coach Mike Martin.
- The Seminoles fell at home against Florida 10-7 on Tuesday. They are hitting .261 and have a 3.82 ERA and .966 fielding percentage.
- Rhett Aplin is hitting .310 with six homers and 23 RBIs, while Quincy Nieporte is batting .296 with six homers and 41 RBIs.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson has had seven shutouts in 34 games. The 20.6 shutout percentage is fifth-best in a season in Tiger history.
- Clemson's bullpen has a 9-1 record, 2.30 ERA and .200 opponents' batting average in 2017.
- Clemson has followed its last four losses with at least five wins in a row (five, eight, nine, six (current)).

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,650 fans per home date (23), 11th-highest figure in the nation and first in the ACC (through games of April 13).
- Entering 2017, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance 23 straight seasons and a top-10 figure 15 years in a row.

POLLS

- Clemson is ranked No. 5 by Baseball America, No. 4 by Collegiate Baseball and No. 4 in the USA Today coaches poll.
- The Tigers have been ranked in the top 25 by at least one poll for 15 straight weeks dating to the 2016 season.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is in first place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 13-2 league mark, ahead of second-place Louisville (13-3).

The Tigers travel to Florida State for a Saturday to Monday series.

CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- The Tigers, who have won six games in a row, defeated Charleston Southern 6-5 in 11 innings at home on Tuesday night.
- The Tigers are averaging 6.4 runs per game and hitting .282 with a .391 on-base percentage and 36 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 2.71 ERA, .233 opponents' batting average and 4.19 strikeout-to-walk ratio and Clemson is fielding .969.

• Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is in first place, ahead of second-place Louisville (13-3) and North Carolina (12-3).

ROAD WARRIORS

- Clemson had a school-record 16 wins in a row away from home that started in 2016 and ended with a loss at Georgia Tech on April 1, 2017.
- The streak included 10 road wins and six neutral-site wins.
- The Tigers won their last eight games away from home in 2016, including a 4-0 record in the ACC Tournament to win the league championship.
- The previous Tiger record for consecutive wins away from home was 12, set between the 1981 and 1982 seasons. Ten of those 12 were road wins.
- Clemson has a 10-1 record in games away from home in 2017, including an 8-1 record in road games and 2-0 neutral-site record.

EARLY SUCCESS

- Clemson's 29-5 record is due in large part to its success scoring runs early in games in 2017.
- The Tigers are outscoring the opposition 33-5 in the first inning and 25-7 in the second inning (combined 58-12 in the first two innings).
- Clemson's highest-scoring innings are the first inning (33) and seventh inning (33).
- Clemson is hitting .299 with a .410 on-base percentage in the first inning.
- Chris Williams is 7-for-13 (.538) with two doubles, a homer, eight RBIs and four runs in the first inning.
- Seth Beer is 8-for-23 (.348) with three doubles, a homer, five RBIs and 11 walks in the first inning.
- The Tigers are 13-0 when scoring in the first inning and 24-1 when scoring first.
- Opponents have scored in the first inning just four times (five combined runs), and Clemson is 4-0 in those four games.
- Clemson has allowed 21 hits (.178 opponents' batting average), four earned runs (1.06 ERA) and four walks with 42 strikeouts in the first inning.

SHUTOUTS

- Clemson has seven shutout victories in 2017, its highest total since recording eight shutout wins in 2013.
- The only other years Clemson had more shutout wins were 1977 (11), 1996 (10), 1980 (9), 1972 (8), 1991 (8), 1992 (8), 1995 (8) and 2013 (8).
- The shutout wins this season were against Elon (2), Notre Dame, Boston College (2), Furman and Georgia.
- The Tigers registered three shutout victories in a row from March 25-28 against Boston College (2) and Furman.
- It was the first time the Tigers had three shutout wins in a row since 1992 and the fourth time in school history.
- Six of the seven shutout wins have been combined efforts, while Alex Eubanks pitched a three-hit shutout at Boston College on March 25.
- The Tigers have had three games in which they allowed only unearned runs, meaning they have had 10 games of allowing no earned runs in 2017.

K CLUB

- Clemson is averaging 9.46 strikeouts per nine innings pitched in 2017 thanks to 331 strikeouts in 315.0 innings pitched.
- The school record for strikeouts per nine innings pitched is 9.69, set by the 1996 squad that featured Kris Benson and Billy Koch.
- The Tigers have allowed just 79 walks, good for a 4.19 strikeout-to-walk ratio. The school record in that category is 3.16, set in 1996.

• Charlie Barnes (67-10), Alex Eubanks (50-7), Tyler Jackson (46-7) and Ryley Gilliam (30-7) all have stellar ratios.

- Charlie Barnes, Ryley Gilliam and Brooks Crawford had a school-record 23 strikeouts in the 1-0 victory over Elon in 13 innings on Feb. 24.
- Five pitchers combined for 32 strikeouts against two walks in the three-game sweep at Boston College in Kingston, R.I., from March 24-26.

WEEKEND ROTATION STRONG

- Clemson's weekend rotation of Charlie Barnes, Alex Eubanks and Pat Krall has been one of the strongest parts of the 2017 team.
- Overall, they are a combined 15-4 with a 2.48 ERA, .242 opponents' batting average, 29 walks and 153 strikeouts in 152.2 innings pitched.
- Overall, Charlie Barnes is 4-2 with a 1.51 ERA, Alex Eubanks is 5-2 with a 2.92 ERA and Pat Krall is 6-0 with a 3.09 ERA.
- In ACC games, they are a combined 12-1 with a 2.18 ERA, .233 opponents' batting average, 17 walks and 98 strikeouts in 99.0 innings pitched.
- In ACC games, Charlie Barnes is 4-1 with a 1.85 ERA, Alex Eubanks is 4-1 with a 2.31 ERA and Pat Krall is 4-0 with a 2.40 ERA.

BARNES BALLIN'

- Junior lefthander Charlie Barnes has solidified himself as the Tigers' Friday starter, as he is 4-2 with a 1.51 ERA in eight starts.
- In 53.2 innings pitched, he has allowed just 41 hits (.216 opponents' batting average) and 10 walks with 67 strikeouts.
- He is holding opponents to a .169 batting average with runners on base and a .185 batting average with two outs.
- In five ACC starts, he is 4-1 with a 1.85 ERA, .203 opponents' batting average and 43 strikeouts versus seven walks in 34.0 innings pitched.
- He gave up just four hits, one run and one walk with 11 strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched to earn the win at Boston College on March 24.
- He was named ACC Co-Pitcher-of-the-Week by totaling 11 strikeouts in 7.2 innings pitched to earn the win against Virginia Tech on April 7.
- In his career, he is 11-8 with a 3.50 ERA and 174 strikeouts against 42 walks in 172.1 innings pitched over 36 appearances (26 starts).
- His 4.14 career strikeout-to-walk ratio is third in Clemson history.

BEER GETTING ON BASE AGAIN

- Sophomore Seth Beer is doing what he does best... finding a way to get on base.
- He has a .452 on-base percentage thanks to 37 walks (11 intentional) and eight hit-by-pitches against only 19 strikeouts in 34 games.
- He reached base via a hit or walk in 66 consecutive games that he had a plate appearance, a streak that ended on Feb. 26.
- He then reached base in 26 consecutive games from February to April.
- He has reached base in 92 of his last 94 games with a plate appearance.
- Beer is hitting .252 with nine doubles, nine homers, 27 RBIs, 27 runs and a .555 slugging percentage in 2017.
- He has made 16 starts in left field, nine in right field, five at first base and four as the DH in 2017.
- Beer won the Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the South Carolina series from March 3-5. He had two homers and seven walks in the series.

NOTES

- With Clemson trailing 3-2, a 3-2 count and two outs in the ninth at No. 4 South Carolina on March 5, he hit a solo homer in the Tigers' win.
- In his career, he is hitting .326 with 22 doubles, 27 homers, 97 RBIs, 84 runs and a .504 on-base percentage in 96 games (96 starts).

CRAWFORD FILLING RELIEF ROLE

- Sophomore righthander Brooks Crawford has turned into one of the team's most reliable relievers in 2017.
- He is 4-0 with an 0.52 ERA and a .200 opponents' batting average in 17.1 innings pitched over 13 relief appearances.
- He has 17 strikeouts against only five walks.
- He pitched the final 4.2 innings, allowing two hits and no runs to earn the win in Clemson's 6-5 win over Notre Dame on March 11.
- In his career, he is 7-0 with a save, 2.81 ERA and .240 opponents' batting average in 64.0 innings pitched over 39 appearances (two starts).

DAVIDSON COMING ON AS A FRESHMAN

- Freshman Logan Davidson has been Clemson's most dynamic freshman, as he has a .424 on-base percentage in starting all 34 games.
- He is batting .302 with 36 runs, five doubles, six homers, 23 RBIs, 29 walks and eight steals.
- In ACC regular-season games, he is hitting .327 with a .500 on-base percentage and .942 fielding percentage at shortstop.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk each of the last 18 games and in 33 of the 34 games in 2017.
- He is tied for the team in multiple-hit games (12).
- He went 6-for-9 with a homer, three RBIs, seven runs, three walks and a steal in the three-game sweep of Virginia Tech from April 7-9.
- His dad, Mark, played at Clemson (1982) and played six years (1986-91) in the majors with the Twins (1987 World Series champion) and Astros.

EUBANKS IN COMMAND

- Sophomore righthander Alex Eubanks was a reliever and starter in 2016, but has found a full-time home in the weekend rotation in 2017.
- He is 5-2 with a 2.92 ERA, .231 opponents' batting average and 50 strikeouts against seven walks in 52.1 innings pitched over eight starts.
- In five ACC starts, he is 4-1 with a 2.31 ERA, .223 opponents' batting average and 33 strikeouts versus three walks in 35.0 innings pitched.
- He pitched 7.0 scoreless innings of four-hit ball with seven strikeouts to earn the win in a 4-0 victory over Notre Dame on March 12.
- He pitched a three-hit shutout with 10 strikeouts against no walks in Clemson's 1-0 win at Boston College in Kingston, R.I., on March 25.
- He earned ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week honors on March 27 for his three-hit shutout at Boston College.
- In his career, he is 11-7 with a 3.64 ERA and 120 strikeouts against 28 walks in 133.2 innings pitched over 31 appearances (19 starts).
- His career 4.29 strikeout-to-walk ratio is second in Clemson history.

GILLIAM PROVIDING RELIEF

- Sophomore righthander Ryley Gilliam has cemented his role as the Tiger closer in 2017.
- He is 1-0 with three saves, an 0.44 ERA and 30 strikeouts against seven walks in 20.1 innings pitched over 13 relief appearances in 2017.
- He has allowed only eight hits and has a .118 opponents' batting average, while opponents are 2-for-24 (.083) with two outs.

- In the 1-0 win over Elon on Feb. 24, he allowed just one hit, no runs and no walks with nine strikeouts in 4.1 innings pitched in relief.
- He combined with Charlie Barnes and Brooks Crawford for a school-record 23 strikeouts against no walks versus Elon on Feb. 24.
- He gave up two hits and one earned run with four strikeouts in 3.1 innings pitched in two Tiger wins over No. 4 South Carolina on March 4,5.
- In his career, he is 4-2 with three saves, a .188 opponents' batting average and 46 strikeouts in 51.1 innings pitched over 28 appearances.

HENNESSY PITCHING OFTEN

- Freshman lefty Jacob Hennessy has pitched in a team-high 17 of Clemson's 34 games this season and has a 2.05 ERA in 26.1 innings pitched.
- Hennessy has given up nine walks with 30 strikeouts and has two saves.
- He is holding opponents to a .215 batting average and 4-for-29 (.138) with two outs.
- He recorded his first career save by tossing 2.0 scoreless innings in Clemson's 3-0 win over Elon on Feb. 26.

KRALL STARTING ON WEEKENDS

- Senior lefthander Pat Krall was a first-team All-American as a reliever in 2016, and he adjusted as a starter in 2017.
- He is 6-0 with a 3.09 ERA, .282 opponents' batting average and 36 strikeouts against 12 walks in 46.2 innings pitched over eight starts.
- In ACC games, he is 4-0 with a 2.40 ERA and 22 strikeouts against seven walks in 30.0 innings pitched over five starts.
- He pitched 7.1 scoreless innings to earn the win in Clemson's 2-0 victory at Boston College in Kingston, R.I., on March 26.
- In his Tiger career, he is 18-6 with eight saves, a 2.61 ERA and .232 opponents' batting average in 165.1 innings pitched over 64 outings.
- His career 3.48 strikeout-to-walk ratio is eighth in Clemson history.

PINDER AMONG OFFENSIVE LEADERS

- Junior Chase Pinder is hitting .310 with eight doubles, 17 RBIs, a .429 on-base percentage and six steals in 33 games (32 starts).
- He is tied for the team in multiple-hit games (12).
- In his career, he is hitting .287 with 24 doubles, 14 homers, 89 RBIs, 115 runs, 15 steals and a .401 on-base percentage in 143 games.

ROHLMAN ROUNDING INTO FORM

- Junior Reed Rohlman is hitting .361 with nine doubles, a triple, three homers, 17 RBIs, 21 runs and a .459 on-base percentage in 33 games.
- He is 19-for-40 (.475) with four doubles, three homers, 12 RBIs and nine runs during his current 11-game hitting streak.
