NOTES/CLARIFICATIONS

Florida State is the third winningest program in the ACC in the last nine seasons (behind only Duke and North Carolina) and averages 22.7 wins per season in those nine years...the Seminoles have played in a school record nine consecutive postseason tournaments...Florida State welcomes its leading scorer and leader in steals (Aaron Thomas, 14.5 ppg and 1.6 spg), its leader in assists (Devon Bookert, 2.8 apg) and its leading shot blocker (Boris Bojanovsky, 1.9 bpg) from its NIT Final Four team in 2014...junior Aaron Thomas, who earned All-ACC Honorable Mention honors as a sophomore as he averaged a team-leading and career-high 14.5 points per game, returns as Florida State's leader as a junior...Thomas is the fourth leading returning scorer in the ACC for the 2014-15 season...Thomas enters his junior season with 726 points and needs only 274 points to become only the 43rd player in school history to score 1,000 or more career points...Bookert enters his junior season as the Seminoles' all-time leader in 3-point field goal shooting with a career mark of .466 from long range...Bookert is one of the ACC's most experienced guards who will lead the Seminoles from the point guard position for the third consecutive season...has played in 70 games while starting 38 in the first two seasons of his career at the point guard position...one of five returning point guards in the ACC who has started at least 35 games in his career (Clemson's Rod Hall 75 career starts; Notre Dame's Eric Atkins, 73; North Carolina's Marcus Paige, 67; Duke's Quinn Cook, 60; Florida State's Bookert, 38)...Bojanovsky enters his junior season with 92 career blocked shots – the 14th highest career total in Florida State history...he is looking to become only the 14th player in school history to earn 100 or more career blocked shots...junior guard Montay Brandon was the only player to start all 36 games for the Seminoles and one of only 23 players in the ACC who started each of his team's games during the 2014 season...Brandon is one of the most versatile players in the ACC who will look to earn his position as a starter for the Seminoles for the third consecutive season...spent his freshman season as Florida State's primary point guard and was a standout in his second season as Florida State's wing guard.
