NOTING ACC BASEBALL

This week marks 2017 Spring Sportsmanship Week in the ACC. At all ACC home competitions during Spring Sportsmanship Week, every league team will showcase its continued dedication to sportsmanship by participating in a pregame handshake. All spring sports (baseball, golf, track and field, rowing, softball, lacrosse and tennis) will be involved in this week's initiative.

Six ACC teams are ranked again this week, led by three in the top five spots ... Louisville holds steady at No. 2 again this week in five of the six polls, while Clemson and North Carolina are both ranked as high as No. 4 ... Virginia, Wake Forest, and Florida State also hold spots in the polls.

Seven players from the ACC were listed on the 40-man Midseason Golden Spikes Award Watch List released on Wednesday: Florida State's Tyler Holton, Georgia Tech's Joey Bart, Louisville's Brendan McKay, North Carolina's J.B. Bukauskas and Logan Warmoth, and Virginia's Adam Haseley and Pavin Smith.

D1 Baseball released a midseason list of the top 100 prospects, and the ACC is well represented on the list with 18 total players, including five of the top eight: No. 1 Brendan McKay of Louisville, No. 3 J.B. Bukauskas of North Carolina, No. 4 Pavin Smith of Virginia, No. 7 Logan Warmoth of North Carolina, and No. 8 Adam Haseley of Virginia.

ACC teams posted a 12-3 record in nonconference midweek action ... ACC victories included No. 5 North Carolina's 20-5 win over No. 11 South Carolina in Tuesday night's game at Charlotte ... No. 24 Wake Forest picked up a pair of wins, including Tuesday night's 19-9 win over defending NCAA champion Coastal Carolina.

In addition to the Tar Heels' 15-0 win over the Gamecocks last year, North Carolina has outscored South Carolina by a 35-5 margin over the last two meetings between the two ... The Tar Heels have scored 68 runs in

its last four games, its most in a four-game stretch since 1987.

North Carolina and NC State renew their rivalry this weekend with three games in Chapel Hill ... NC State's Elliott Avent currently sits in 998 career wins, and will be the fifth different active ACC coach to reach the 1000 win milestone when he tallies two more victories.

Wake Forest's win over Elon was its 25th victory of the year in its 35th game ... That's the fastest the Deacons have reached 25 wins since doing so in 31 games in 2002, which was also the last time Wake Forest hosted an NCAA Regional.

Virginia has won six straight games heading into its three-game series against rival Virginia Tech, its longest win streak since a 10-game stretch to open the season. The Cavaliers are ranked as high as 12th nationally this week in the USA Today Coaches poll. UVA leads the ACC and ranks seventh nationally in batting average (.325) ... Virginia Tech leads the nation in home runs (63) this season. Led by Jack Owens (.368), the Hokies have four of the ACC's top 20 batters and rank fifth in the ACC in team batting (.290) with a league-high 143 extra-base hits ... Virginia holds a 98-82 advantage in the all-time series with the Hokies, but Virginia Tech has won three of the last four series in Blacksburg.

With Tuesday's win against Purdue, Louisville achieved the best record through 32 games in program history (28-4) surpassing the 2010 team, which had 26-6 record through the same number of games ... In 15 ACC games this season, the Cardinals pitching staff has a 2.96 ERA with 141 strikeouts in 134.0 innings of work.

The upcoming three-game ACC series between Georgia Tech and Louisville will be the first-ever meetings between the teams at Atlanta's Russ Chandler Stadium.

ACC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Smith had a big week as part of Virginia's 5-0 stretch, driving in 14 runs while racking up nine hits, five extra-base hits, and five runs scored. In an 18-5 win on Tuesday over an Old Dominion squad that entered the game with 12 wins over its last 14 contests, Smith recorded his second career multi-home run game, hitting a grand slam as well as a two-run homer. The junior first baseman and outfielder from Jupiter, Florida, had four RBIs in the series opener against Pitt, including a three-run double, and was named a National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball.

Barnes held Virginia Tech, the national leader in home runs, to just four hits, one run, and two walks with a career-high-tying 11 strikeouts in a 12-1 win on Friday. The junior from Sumter, South Carolina, faced just four batters over the minimum as he improved to 4-2 on the season with a 1.51 ERA, and a .216 opponent batting average in 53.2 innings pitched.

Dunshee limited No. 2 Louisville to one run on six hits in 7.0 innings pitched on Friday. The 2-1 win for the Demon Deacons snapped a 37-game regular season home winning streak dating back to last year by the Cardinals.
