## ACC BASEBALL NOTEBOOK

Three weekend ACC series highlight the weekend schedule, which continues to be staggered due to semester exams ... Louisville travels to Notre Dame, while Boston College visits Wake Forest in a pair of Atlantic Division matchups ... Pitt travels to Georgia Tech for a Coastal Division series that is set to open on Saturday and conclude Monday night ... As the regular season hits its final run, Louisville is 2 1/2 games up on Clemson in the Atlantic Division race (four games ahead in the loss column), while North Carolina holds a five-game lead on second-place Virginia in the Coastal Division.

Several teams take a break this week for final exams while others continue to battle for position and seeding for the upcoming ACC Baseball Championship, set for May 23-28 at Louisville Slugger Field in Louisville, Kentucky ... The ACC's top 12 teams will qualify for the tournament, with the division champions earning the top two seeds.

Three ACC teams have now hit the 35-win plateau - Louisville (39-6), North Carolina (37-9) and Virginia (36-11) ... Clemson owns a 34-11 overall mark, while Wake Forest is at 30-13 heading into weekend play ... Nonconference series this weekend include Pacific at Florida State, Delaware at NC State and Bethune-Cookman at Miami (starting Friday), as well as Nevada at Clemson (starting Saturday).

League teams posted a 7-1 mark in midweek nonconference play this week, including Pitt's sweep of Maryland Eastern Shore and wins by top-10 members Louisville, North Carolina and Virginia ... ACC teams own a 215-88 (.710) record in nonconference play this season.

Five ACC teams continued to be ranked among the nation's Top 25 of all major polls ... That includes the nation's No. 2 team in Louisville and the consensus No. 3 team in North Carolina ... Clemson is ranked as high as No. 6 and Virginia as high as No. 7 ... Wake Forest sits at No. 17 in Baseball America's Top 25 ... All five of those team own impressive numbers in the latest RPI rankings with North Carolina at No. 2, Clemson at No. 4, Louisville at No. 7, Wake Forest at No. 8 and Virginia at No. 10.

Pete Frates was team captain during Mik Aoki's first season as head coach at Boston College. When Frates was diagnosed with ALS (amyotrophic laterals sclerosis or Lou Gehrig's disease) in 2012, his crusade to educate the public and find a cure began. It took the nation by storm in 2014 with the Ice Bucket Challenge ... Now head coach at Notre Dame, Aoki has seen to it that the Fighting Irish host an annual ALS awareness game. The tradition began in 2014, when Boston College and the Irish met for a series in Chicago. It continues this year when No. 2 Louisville visits Frank Eck Stadium on Saturday ... In 2015, Aoki added a new element, joining his wife in hosting Pints 4 Pete. The Aokis will host the South Bend edition of the Pints 4 Pete fundraiser after the game Saturday at Legends on the Notre Dame campus. The event will run from 8-10 p.m. at the restaurant just south of Notre Dame Stadium ... Silent auction items will be up for bid at both the game and Pints 4 Pete. In addition, Notre Dame will hold an online auction of the game-worn jerseys, featuring the Pete Frates #3 Fund ribbon on the sleeve.

**ACC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK**

McKay hit .429 with six home runs, 12 RBIs and a 1.286 slugging percentage as the No. 2 Cardinals went 5-0 overall last week. On Tuesday, he matched a school record with four home runs to go with a career-best nine RBIs in the 14-4 win at Eastern Kentucky. The four home runs is tied for the third most in a game in NCAA history. While hitting safely in all five games for the Cardinals, the junior from Darlington, Pennsylvania, capped the week with another multi-home run performance, connecting for two homers and three RBIs in Sunday's 17-2 win against Toledo. On the mound, the lefthander finished with 12 strikeouts in eight innings to earn the victory in Friday's series-opening win against Toledo.

Dunand was 9-for-15 on the week with 13 RBIs, eight runs scored, four home runs and four doubles. His four homers helped take sole possession of the ACC lead and tie for sixth nationally. The junior from Miami, Florida, homered in the first three games of the week, including two on Tuesday, the second multi-homer game of his career, as he recorded a career-best 10 total bases. Dunand also homered at East Carolina to help seal the win on Wednesday. On Friday, he ignited the Wolfpack offense in the win over Virginia Tech, as his solo home run knotted the game at one and the Wolfpack went on to win, 5-2. For the week, Dunand had a slugging percentage of 1.667 and an on-base percentage of .636 with 25 total bases.

Hiatt picked up a win and a save in No. 5 North Carolina's series sweep of No. 4 Clemson. The redshirt freshman reliever from Charlotte, North Carolina, worked two scoreless innings in a non-save situation on Friday before recording a save in a perfect ninth inning on Saturday. On Sunday, Hiatt threw 2.2 innings of hitless relief to get the win in the series finale. On the weekend, he retired 17 of the 21 batters he faced, striking out four, giving up zero walks, and only allowing three hits.
