## NOTING ACC BASEBALL

The first weekend of conference play is in the books for ACC teams ... Louisville and Clemson got off to fast starts with sweeps of their three-game series, and strong pitching held the key ... Louisville allowed just three runs in its sweep of visiting Pitt ... The defending ACC champion Tigers allowed just six runs while taking three games from visiting Notre Dame ... Florida State, Wake Forest, North Carolina, Duke and Miami were other weekend series winners.

Five of the six national polls have an ACC team ranked No. 1 this week, but they differ on which league team should hold the top spot ... Florida State is No. 1 in D1 Baseball's poll, while Louisville is No. 1 according to Baseball America, USA TODAY Coaches Poll, NCBWA, and Perfect Game ... The No. 1 rankings are the first in program history for Louisville.

ACC teams face a tough nonconference schedule in midweek action, as Duke takes on #18 East Carolina, Georgia Tech hosts #20 Oklahoma, and Florida State travels to #5 Florida in Tuesday action. The Seminoles also face #24 Florida Gulf Coast on Wednesday.

Sophomore Alex Eubanks pitched 7.0 scoreless innings of four-hit ball with seven strikeouts to earn the win in Clemson's 4-0 victory over Notre Dame on Sunday ... On the season, he is 2-1 with a 2.96 ERA and .221 opponents' batting average along with 24 strikeouts against six walks in 24.1 innings pitched over four starts.

Duke sophomore outfielder Jimmy Herron, the ACC Player of the Week posted another tremendous week, totaling 10 hits, two doubles, two home runs, eight RBI and six runs scored to help Duke to an ACC series win over Virginia Tech ... Over Duke's five games last week, Herron hit .476 to raise his batting average for the year from .292 to .348 ... He had multiple hits and at least one RBI in all but one game.

With another standout effort against Boston College, Tyler Holton of Florida State improved to 4-0 on the season after not allowing an earned run for the third time in four starts this year ... his ERA fell from 0.47 to 0.36 ... Holton has allowed just nine hits in 25.0 innings on the year. He holds a 40-6 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

Louisville junior lefthander Brendan McKay, the ACC Pitcher of the Week had a career-high 15 strikeouts while allowing only two hits in seven shutout innings to earn the victory in the Cardinals' 3-0 series-opening win against Pitt ... The Darlington, Pennsylvania native improved to 3-0 on the season and 24-7 in his collegiate career with the win ... The 15 strikeouts were two better than McKay's previous high of 13, and the outing marked the 20th time he has finished with eight or more strikeouts in a single game ... McKay has allowed only one earned run in 18.0 innings (0.50 ERA) this season with 29 strikeouts and just five walks, and holds a higher batting average (.548) than ERA.

Junior outfielder Carl Chester extended his hitting streak to a career-best nine games and had multi-hit performances in each of Miami's three games in a series win over No. 23 Georgia Tech ... Chester had his first collegiate four-hit game in the series opener, totaled a team-best .500 average in five games, reached base at a .565 clip and slugged .650 over the course of five games.
