STARTING 9: WHAT TO KNOW

- Last time out:** No. 22 Florida State won a pair of one-run games over No. 20 FGCU, 7-6 and 3-2, on Tuesday and Wednesday. Tuesday's game ended on a walk-off double by Jackson Lueck (3-for-5, 3 RBI), while Wednesday's game ended in the fifth after a lightning and rain delay. It was FSU's first rain-shortened win since 2013 vs. USF.
- Holton among nation's best:** ACC Pitcher of the Week Tyler Holton had perhaps the best outing of his career Saturday, throwing seven no-hit innings against No. 8 North Carolina. The Tallahassee native ranks fourth nationally in hits allowed/9 IP with 4.29 and is ninth in the country in WHIP (0.74). He has been ACC POTW three times this yr.
- Noles record second seven-run comeback win:** On March 21, FSU trailed Jacksonville 7-0 before having an at-bat, and slowly chipped away at the JU lead until freshman J.C. Flowers' walk-off, two-run single with two outs in the ninth inning. Against Oakland (3/3), FSU also trailed 7-0 before winning 18-10.
- Walls leads country in walks:** After notching seven walks in the final two games at Notre Dame, junior Taylor Walls leads the country with 36 on the season. As a team, the Seminoles have been walked 194 times, 15 more than the next closest school, Mercer.
- Q among nation's leaders:** Senior first baseman/designated hitter Quincy Nieporte is ninth in the country with 38 RBI. He hit his third and fourth grand slams of the year at Virginia Tech, and he is now the single-season record holder for grand slams in a season at FSU. His four grand slams are the most in the country.
- Parrish shines at Notre Dame:** On March 25, freshman Drew Parrish threw a complete game, three-hitter in Florida State's 5-1 win over Notre Dame. Only twice, in the 4th and 9th innings, did Parrish face more than one batter, and the Irish's lone run came on an error in the 4th inning. It is FSU's only complete game of the season.
- Noles on the basepaths:** Florida State opened the season a perfect 27-for-27 in stolen bases and is currently 34-40 on the year. The Seminoles had the most stolen bases without being caught in the country. Dylan Busby leads the team with six stolen bases on the season.
- Martin active leader in wins:** Head coach Mike Martin, now in his 38th year as head coach at Florida State, is the active wins leader with 1,918. He also is the all-time winningest coach by percentage, with a .737 mark. He needs just 58 wins to pass Augie Garrido's all-time wins record (1,975).
- J.D. Drew jersey to be retired:** Florida State announced that former outfielder J.D. Drew (1995-97) will have his No. 39 jersey retired prior to the game against Clemson on Saturday, April 15. One of the most decorated players in college baseball history, he remains the only player with a 30 HR/30 SB season.

THE WINNINGEST ACTIVE COACH IN COLLEGE BASEBALL, MARTIN...

- » was inducted into the American Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame January 5, 2007
- » was inducted into the Florida Sports Hall of Fame in 2005
- » has 24 50-win seasons (no other coach at FSU has one)
- » owns the highest career winning percentage among active DI collegiate coaches (.738)
- » owns the second-most wins all-time in NCAA Division I baseball history and most among active coaches (1,918)
- » has led Florida State to 37 consecutive NCAA Regional appearances
- » has taken the Noles on 15 trips to the College World Series
- » has overseen 17 conference championships (11 Metro Conference, 6 Atlantic Coast Conference - 95, 97, 02, 04, 10, 15)
- » coached eight consecutive ACC Atlantic Division Championships (2007-2014) including setting the school record for the most conference wins in a season with a 24-6 mark in 2008 & 2012
- » produced 19 first round draft picks with 17 coming since 1990. Overall, Martin has coached 49 of FSU's 69 players that have reached the Major Leagues
- » coached 89 All-Americans, 125 All-ACC selections and a record four Golden Spikes winners
- » is a seven-time ACC Coach of the Year - 1996, 1998, 1999, 2001, 2007, 2009, 2012
- » is a six-time Metro Conference Coach of the Year

11 GETS WIN NO. 1,900

- » Florida State head coach Mike Martin won the 1,900th game of his 38-year career in FSU's 11-3 win over VCU on February 19.
- » For perspective, if a head coach started coaching today and went 56-0 each season (the maximum number of regular season games a team can play under current NCAA rules), it would take almost 34 seasons for a coach to get 1,900 career wins.
- » Martin becomes just the second coach in NCAA history to reach 1,900 career wins and the first to do so at one program. In fact, Martin is just 34 games away from participating in his 3,000th FSU baseball game - 96 as a player (1965-66), 288 as assistant coach (1975-79) and 2,604 as head coach (1980-present).
- » Here is a look at the other milestone wins of Martin's illustrious career:

AGAINST THE WOLFPACK

- » Florida State leads the all-time series against NC State, 67-28, and hold a 65-25 record against the Wolfpack under head coach Mike Martin.
- » Last season, FSU beat NC State twice - once in the regular season, 8-5, in Tallahassee and 7-3 in the ACC Tournament in Durham, N.C.
- » Two games were cancelled during the regular season due to inclement weather in Tallahassee.
- » In the regular season last year, Cal Raleigh hit a home run and a double, Jackson Lueck had three RBI and Taylor Walls added a pair of hits. Tyler Warmoth picked up his first save by striking out the side in the ninth.
- » FSU opened the ACC Tournament with a 7-3 win in Durham. Walls and Dylan Busby each had two RBI, and Quincy Nieporte had two hits. Chase Haney picked up the win after striking out two in the eighth inning.

MARTIN vs. AVENT

- » FSU has won 10 of the past 11 against NC State, and Mike Martin is 65-25 against the Wolfpack.
- » Since Elliott Avent took over as head coach in 1997, Martin is 49-20.
- » In Raleigh, Martin is 18-9 against Avent and the Seminoles have won five straight series at NC State.
- » In 2015, FSU won a pair of one-run games, 3-2 and 1-0, before dropping the series finale 11-7 on Sunday. The 1-0 win at NC State is the last time FSU won a 1-0 game.
- » The last shutout for FSU in the series prior to 2015 was also a 1-0 win in 2008 in Tallahassee.

GAME NOTES vs. NC STATE

HOLTON IN ELITE COMPANY

- » Tallahassee native Tyler Holton continues to show why he is one of the top pitchers in college baseball this season, with a 1.93 ERA and 4-0 record in seven starts.
- » Holton is a three-time ACC Pitcher of the Week, joining Paul Wilson (1993 & 1994), Mike Ziegler (2000) and Sean Gilmartin (2011) as the only FSU pitchers to earn the award three times in one season.
- » Holton was stellar against No. 8 North Carolina (4/1), pitching a no-hitter before being pulled after 109 pitches in the eighth inning. He walked only one batter, his final of the game, and struck out 8.
- » Before the walk, all four baserunners that reached were via error, and each runner was stranded.
- » Against Oakland (3/4), Holton struck out 13 batters in just six innings of work without allowing a walk. He set a career-high in strikeouts for the second consecutive week after having 11 against Samford (2/25).
- » Holton also became the first Nole with 13 K since Luke Weaver had 14 against Troy in the 2013 NCAA Regionals. He is the first Seminole with consecutive games of 10+ K's since Sean Gilmartin in 2011.
- » Andrew Karp also struck out 11 batters at Florida (3/14). A look at the last five times a Seminole reached double-digit strikeouts:

PARRISH CG SHUTS DOWN IRISH

- » Freshman Drew Parrish allowed just three hits and one unearned run in Saturday's 5-1 win over Notre Dame (3/25), throwing the first complete game of his young career.
- » The outing dropped Parrish's ERA from 5.16 to 3.69, and the Rockledge, Fla., native is 3-1 on the season.
- » The complete game was the first for FSU this season, and the first since Drew Carlton threw a two-hit shutout at No. 1 Florida in last season's Super Regionals.
- » Luke Weaver was the last FSU player with more than one complete game in a season, when he accomplished the feat against Wake Forest and Boston College in 2014.
- » Parrish is the first FSU freshman to throw a complete game since Sean Gilmartin had two in 2009.

NOLES SWEEP IRISH

- » When FSU swept Notre Dame on March 24 and 25, it was the first three-game road sweep for Florida State since winning three times at Boston College in 2014.
- » It was FSU's first time winning a game at Frank Eck Stadium after the Noles were swept in 2015. Notre Dame joined the ACC prior to the 2014 season.
- » The sweep was the fifth for the Seminoles since 2010, and only once in that span has FSU swept two opponents on the road in one season:

- » For the first time this season, FSU won on a walk-off hit when freshman J.C. Flowers' two-run single capped FSU's 10-9 comeback win vs. Jacksonville (3/21).
- » The Seminoles trailed 7-0 after the top of the first inning, the second time this year that FSU rallied from a 7-0 deficit (Oakland, 3/3).
- » Against the Dolphins, the FSU bullpen allowed just one earned run in 8.1 innings, striking out 8 without walking a batter.

7-R 1st = WINNING RECORD

- » The Jacksonville game (3/21) was the fifth time in school history that FSU has allowed seven runs in the first inning, and the Noles are amazingly 3-2 in those games.
- » The 7 runs allowed are the most in school history in a first inning, and was done most recently in 2010 against NC State.

NIEPORTE SETS SLAM RECORD

- » With a grand slam in each of the first two games at Virginia Tech (3/17-18), senior Quincy Nieporte set an FSU record with his fourth grand slam this season.
- » Q also leads the country in grand slams and is the only player in the country with more than two this year.
- » The national record for grand slams in a season is 6, by Kyle Bryan of Alabama in 1984.
- » Nieporte also had six RBI in the game at Virginia Tech (3/18), a new season high and one shy of his career high of 7 at UCF in 2015, when he hit his only grand slam prior to this season.
- » With his fourth grand slam, he passed five other Seminoles that previously had three in a season:

- » Against Florida (3/14), sophomore Andrew Karp struck out 11 Gator batters, topping his career-high of nine from his first start this season (USF, 2/21).
- » He joins Tyler Holton (13 vs. Oakland, 11 vs. Samford) with 10+ strikeouts in a game this season.
- » Before this year, the last time an FSU player had double-digit strikeouts was Mike Compton against Coastal Carolina in 2015.
- » Karp is just the 10th FSU pitcher, and first since 1996, to record at least 11 strikeouts against the Gators:

9-GAME WINNING STREAK

- » The Seminoles had a nine-game winning streak snapped against Boston College (3/10).
- » It was FSU's longest winning streak since an 11-game stretch early in the 2015 season.

ZIRZOW WOVES VS. KNIGHTS

- » At UCF (3/8), redshirt junior Will Zirzow pitched a career-high five innings, allowing one hit & striking out a career-high seven in earning the win in a 5-0 shutout.
- » Only two batters reached base against Big Z - a single that was erased on a pickoff, and a strikeout that

- » Zirzow's previous career highs in innings and strikeouts came in last year's ACC Championship Game against Clemson (4.1 innings, 6 strikeouts).

NOLES SCORE 44 vs. OAKLAND

- » In three games against Oakland (3/3-5), the Seminoles outscored the Golden Grizzlies 44-17 and scored 10+ runs in each game of the series.
- » It was the first time since 2010 against Hofstra that FSU scored in double-digits in each game of a three-game series. That season, FSU accomplished the feat each of the first two weekends of the season, against Georgia State and Hofstra.
- » Against Samford (2/24-26), FSU scored 37 runs in a three-game sweep.

CARLTON MOVES TO BULLPEN

- » Florida State's Opening Day starter, junior Drew Carlton, was named the team's closer after four games in 2017.
- » Carlton made his first relief appearance of the year against Samford (2/26) in a non-save situation.
- » Against Jacksonville (2/28), the Lakeland native was perfect for the final two innings in picking up his first career save in FSU's 6-5 win over the Dolphins.
- » The game against Jacksonville was Carlton's 38th career appearance, but just his eighth out of the bullpen.
- » At UCF (3/7), Carlton again entered in the eighth inning and was perfect against all six batters faced, closing out FSU's 5-2 win.
- » In 12 relief appearances in 2017, Carlton is 2-1 with a 0.92 ERA in 19.2 innings, with 21 strikeouts against just five walks.
- » Carlton was the winner in both of FSU's walkoff wins - vs. Jacksonville (3/21) and Florida Gulf Coast (4/4).

- » Freshman Drew Parrish allowed just two hits and a run while striking out six in six innings in his first career start vs. Samford (2/26).
- » Senior Will Zirzow allowed two runs in three innings in his first career start, against FGCU (4/5).

- » **For just the fourth time in school history, the Seminoles allowed no more than four runs in any of the first seven games of a season.**

- » Five players - Nick Derr (LF), Rhett Aplin (LF), J.C. Flowers (CF), Kyle Cavanaugh (DH), Tyler Daughtry (DH) made the first starts of their career in the opening series against VCU.

NOLES ON THE ROAD

- » The Seminoles won at Jacksonville, 6-5, in its first road game of the season before sweeping UCF (3/7-8).

WALLS NAMED ALL-AMERICAN

- » Taylor Walls, one of the top shortstops in the country, was named the 43rd first team All-American in school history after earning the honor by Baseball America.
- » The Cordele, Ga., native started all 63 games for Florida State in 2016 and became just the third first team All-American shortstop at FSU, joining Dick Howser (1957-58) and Stephen Cardullo (2009).
- » Walls also earned third team marks from NCBWA and D1Baseball.com. Walls led FSU with 72 runs scored (No. 2 in the country) and had a .355 average on 88 hits.
- » Over the past summer, Walls played for the USA Collegiate National Team, leading the team with a .405 on-base percentage in 19 games.
- » To begin 2017, Walls has four doubles, a triple and three home runs. He ranks 21st nationally with 34 runs scored and leads the nation in walks with 36.
