NOTING ACC BASEBALL

Louisville and Wake Forest swept ACC weekend series, with the second-ranked Cardinals taking three straight at Georgia Tech, while the No. 24 Demon Deacons won three in a row at home versus Notre Dame ... No. 5 North Carolina, No. 14 Virginia, No. 28 Florida State, Boston College and Miami were other weekend series winners.

Five ACC teams are ranked this week, with all five in the top 20 of every poll and three teams in the top five ... Louisville is the unanimous No. 2 team, while both Clemson and North Carolina are ranked as high as No. 3 in a national poll. Virginia is No. 11 in the NCBWA Poll, while Wake Forest is as high as No. 17.

The NCAA RPI update from Monday includes five ACC teams in the top 10 spots: No. 3 North Carolina, No. 4 Clemson, No. 5 Louisville, No. 9 Virginia, and No. 10 Wake Forest.

Louisville's sweep of Georgia Tech propelled the Cardinals to first-place in the Atlantic Division, one game up on Clemson ... North Carolina continues to hold a four-game lead over Virginia in the Coastal Division ... Louisville and Clemson each hit the 30-win plateau over the weekend ... North Carolina and Virginia (29 wins each) and Wake Forest (28 wins) are each closing in with just over a month still remaining in the regular season.

Wake Forest, which also picked up two non-conference wins last week, did not commit an error in the 5-0 stretch and is 18-0 this season when playing error-free baseball ... The Demon Deacons also matched their season-high by turning three double plays in Sunday's win over Notre Dame.

Louisville has won 23 of its 26 ACC series the last three seasons, and is 25-1 in ACC series finales during that stretch ... The Cardinals posted its fifth series sweep of 2017 by taking

three straight at Georgia Tech ... Brendan McKay reached base safely in three of his four plate appearances on Sunday adding two walks to go with his seventh home run of the season ... In four games last week, McKay was 7-for-13 (.538) at the plate with two home runs, six RBI, four walks and 1.077 slugging percentage, while also allowing just one hit in eight scoreless innings to earn the victory in Thursday's series-opener at Georgia Tech.

The ACC's three longest active winning streaks ended during weekend play ... North Carolina had rolled up 11 consecutive wins, including the opening two games of its ACC series versus rival NC State, before the Wolfpack clipped the Tar Heels 4-2 in Sunday's finale ... Johnny Piedmonte worked five scoreless innings of relief for NC State in the win ... Virginia's eight-game winning streak ended with a 7-5 loss at Virginia Tech in the final game of that series on Saturday ... The Hokies rallied with five runs in the bottom of the seventh ... Clemson had won seven games in a row before FSU claimed Sunday's 7-3 win ... Seminole starter Tyler Holton (5-1) allowed seven hits, three runs and three walks with nine strikeouts in a career-high 8.0 innings pitched ... Louisville (six games) and Wake Forest (five) now own the ACC's longest active winning streaks.

After dropping the first game of its road series at Pitt by a 10-3 score on Friday, Miami rebounded with two wins – including a 1-0 shutout of the Panthers in the second game on Friday's doubleheader ... Pitching on just four days' rest – two short of the normal six days off – junior Jed Bargfeldt delivered another gem in his first season as a Hurricane ... Bargfeldt allowed just one hit in five innings – a two-out bloop single to center in the fifth – and walked two batters with six strikeouts.

ACC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Fairchild hit .500 with 14 RBIs, 11 hits, nine runs, four home runs, and three doubles on the week to lead Wake Forest to a perfect 5-0 record. In a 19-9 win over defending national champion Coastal Carolina, he went 3-for-5 with seven RBIs and two home runs. In a sweep of Notre Dame, the junior outfielder from Seattle, Washington, tallied six hits with five runs and four runs driven in. Fairchild has reached base safely in 39 straight games dating back to last season, and is the only player in the league with double digits in both home runs (11) and stolen bases (10).

McKay allowed just one hit in eight dominant innings on the mound to lead No. 2 Louisville to a 3-0 victory over Georgia Tech in last Thursday's series-opener at Russ Chandler Stadium. McKay finished with eight strikeouts while surrendering only a fourth inning single to go with two walks to move to 5-2 on the season and 26-9 in his collegiate career. The junior from Darlington, Pennsylvania, retired the final 13 batters he faced while reaching eight strikeouts in a game for the 24th time. McKay, who ranks second in career strikeouts at Louisville with 321, has a 1.19 ERA and 76 strikeouts in his 53.0 innings this season.
