## UPDATED CWS NOTES: NOLES LOOK TO EXTEND SEASON (AGAIN)

- In the 1,000th game in College World Series history, Florida State beat Cal State Fullerton, 6-4, in an elimination game Monday afternoon. FSU drew eight walks, including three-in-a-row in the seventh inning that scored the go-ahead run, and the FSU bullpen allowed just one hit and one walk in 3.1 innings.
- Freshman Drew Mendoza hit his ninth home run against the Titans in the sixth inning, giving FSU a 3-1 lead. After missing the first 26 games of the season, Mendoza has hit four postseason home runs - two in the ACC Championship Game against North Carolina, one against Tennessee Tech in the Tallahassee Regional, and one Monday against Cal State Fullerton.
- As a team, Florida State has hit 74 home runs, the most for the Seminoles since hitting 86 in 2010.
- Starting pitcher Drew Parrish had four strikeouts against Cal State Fullerton, and relievers Chase Haney, Alec Byrd and Drew Carlton each added one. On the season, FSU has 631 strikeouts, tied for the seventh-most in school history and the most since also having 631 in 2000. The 631 strikeouts are the most in the country this season.
- In 13 games in the postseason (ACC and NCAA Tournament), FSU has a 2.03 team ERA, 140 strikeouts and 29 walks.
- Junior Taylor Walls walked and scored a run against the Titans Monday. Walls leads the country in walks with 67 (four in the College World Series) and is second in runs scored with 82, trailing LSU's Kramer Robertson by one. As a team, FSU ranks fourth nationally with 498 runs scored.
- Walls' walk vs. Cal State Fullerton gives him 178 for his career, the fourth-most in FSU history, trailing only Brooks Badeaux (203), Paul Sorrento (195) and Sherman Johnson (180).
- Catcher Cal Raleigh has started 118 consecutive games at catcher for the Seminoles and is the only Nole to play in all 68 games this season.
- Quincy Nieporte earned a bases loaded walk in the seventh inning vs. Cal State Fullerton that tied the game at 4-4. Nieporte has 80 runs batted in this season, fourth nationally and the most for a Seminole since Buster Posey had 93 in 2008. He has a team-high 19-game streak of reaching base.
- With eight walks against Cal State Fullerton, FSU extended its season total to 393, most in the country and 20 more than second place South Alabama. Over the past eight years, FSU has ranked first in walks six times; third one time (2013); and sixth one time (2016).
- Alec Byrd and Drew Carlton both made their team-high 35th appearances of the season against Cal State Fullerton. For Byrd, it was his 100th career appearance, the ninth most in FSU history.
- Steven Wells tallied two RBI, giving him six in the postseason. The Key West junior had two in the regular season.
