## NOTING ACC BASEBALL

Division leaders Clemson and North Carolina recorded weekend series sweeps in ACC play, along with Notre Dame and Virginia ... Wake Forest defeated Louisville in Friday night's series opener to end the Cardinals 37-game regular-season home winning streak, but the Cardinals bounced back to take the next two games and the series ... Miami and NC State were the other weekend series winners, taking two of three from Duke and Florida State, respectively.

Six ACC teams are ranked again this week, led by three in the top five spots ... Louisville holds steady at No. 2 again this week in five of the six polls, while Clemson and North Carolina are both ranked as high as No. 4 ... Virginia, Wake Forest, and Florida State also hold spots in the polls.

A handful of ACC players earned midseason honors over the last week ... D1 Baseball named Louisville's Brendan McKay the National Midseason MVP, while North Carolina's J.B. Bukauskas was named Top Pitcher ... Georgia Tech C Joey Bart and Virginia OF Adam Haseley joined McKay and Bukauskas on the Midseason All-America Team ... McKay also was named Midseason Player of the Year by Perfect Game ... Perfect Game Midseason All-America honors went to Bart, McKay and Bukauskas on the first team and Wake Forest 1B Gavin Sheets, Duke OF Griffin Conine, and Haseley on the second team.

No. 5 North Carolina scored 48 runs in its sweep of Boston College, setting a new record for runs scored in a three-game ACC series ... The Tar Heels surpassed the 45 runs posted by the 2002 squad in a sweep at Duke. It also marked the first time a UNC team reached double figures three times in an ACC series since a 2002 sweep over NC State.

No. 4 Clemson limited Virginia Tech - which leads the ACC in both home runs and extra base hits - to seven runs in three games in their series ... Clemson's strong pitching effort was led by Friday night starter Charlie

Barnes (4-2), who earned the win by allowing only four hits, one run and two walks in 7.2 innings pitched. He was assisted by a team-season-high three double plays by the Tiger defense and punctuated his stellar effort with a career-high 11 strikeouts.

Notre Dame has now won six of its last seven home games after completing a sweep of Georgia Tech on Sunday ... The Fighting Irish outlasted the Yellow Jackets 9-6 on Sunday as Cole Daily drove in three runs and starting pitcher Brad Bass retired nine straight batters during one portion of his six-inning stint.

No. 22 Virginia nailed down its first ACC series sweep of the season with Sunday's 4-3 win over visiting Pitt ... Adam Haseley, who leads the ACC in batting (.402) gave Virginia another quality start on the mound and earned the win, allowing three runs and three hits while striking out six in 6 1/3 innings ... Haseley (5-1) cruised through six innings, retiring 18 of 19 batters and allowing just one hit, before running into trouble in the seventh inning ... The bullpen then stepped up for UVA, which limited Pitt to six runs and 11 hits in the series.

NC State grabbed a 4-0 lead in the first inning of Sunday's series finale versus Florida State and went on to post an 8-4 victory ... The Wolfpack is 14-3 this season when scoring first ... NC State's Joe Dunand hit his 11th home run of the season and is tied for second in that category among ACC leaders, two behind leader Sam Fragale of Virginia Tech who has 13.

The ACC midweek nonconference schedule includes several rivalry games on Tuesday, including ACC-SEC matchups Florida at Florida State, Georgia Tech at Georgia, and North Carolina versus South Carolina in Charlotte, N.C. ... With Easter weekend straight ahead, two upcoming ACC series - Virginia at Virginia Tech and Louisville at Georgia Tech - are set to begin on Thursday and end on Saturday.

**ACC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK**

Smith had a big week as part of Virginia's 5-0 stretch, driving in 14 runs while racking up nine hits, five extra-base hits, and five runs scored. In an 18-5 win on Tuesday over an Old Dominion squad that entered the game with 12 wins over its last 14 contests, Smith recorded his second career multi-home run game, hitting a grand slam as well as a two-run homer. The junior first baseman and outfielder from Jupiter, Florida, had four RBIs in the series opener against Pitt, including a three-run double, and was named a National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball.

Barnes held Virginia Tech, the national leader in home runs, to just four hits, one run, and two walks with a career-high-tying 11 strikeouts in a 12-1 win on Friday. The junior from Sumter, South Carolina, faced just four batters over the minimum as he improved to 4-2 on the season with a 1.51 ERA, and a .216 opponent batting average in 53.2 innings pitched.

Dunshee limited No. 2 Louisville to one run on six hits in 7.0 innings pitched on Friday. The 2-1 win for the Demon Deacons snapped a 37-game regular season home winning streak dating back to last year by the Cardinals.
