ACC BASEBALL NOTEBOOK

Five ACC series are set this weekend as several schools break for semester exams ... The slate includes defending conference champion Clemson traveling to North Carolina in a meeting of top-five teams ... Virginia visits Florida State, while Miami is at Boston College, Duke at Notre Dame, and Virginia Tech at NC State ... Georgia Tech, Louisville and Pitt have nonconference games on tap.

With nine league games remaining on the schedule, Louisville maintains a one-game lead over Clemson in the Atlantic Division while Wake Forest is four games back ... North Carolina is four games up on second-place Virginia in the Coastal race.

Five teams are ranked this week, with four earning spots in the top 10 and three in the top five ... Louisville is ranked as high as No. 2, Clemson and North Carolina both hold No. 3 rankings, Virginia is as high as No. 8, and Wake Forest is No. 17 in the Baseball America Top 25. In the RPI, ACC teams comprise five of the top 14 and six of the top 24 in the latest update.

Midweek nonconference action included NC State's 13-0 win over North Carolina Central, which marked Elliott Avent's 1,000th career win as a collegiate head coach ... Now in his 28th season as a head coach and 21st at NC State, Avent became one of five active coaches in the ACC and one of 15 active coaches among NCAA Division I to accomplish the feat.

Other midweek action included Tuesday's four-home run outburst by Louisville's Bren-

dan McKay in the Cardinals' win at Eastern Kentucky ... McKay matched a school record with his four home runs and finished with a career-best nine RBI ... The four home runs equaled the school record total first achieved by Jim LaFountain against Western Kentucky on April 24, 1976 ... The four home runs is tied for the third most in a game in NCAA history ... Florida State's Marshall McDougal holds the NCAA and ACC record after hitting six in a game in 1999.

Reigning Dick Howser Trophy winner Seth Beer of Clemson accepted an invitation from USA Baseball to play for the 2017 Collegiate National Team this summer. ... It will be his second summer playing for Team USA, as he donned the red, white, and blue when the team traveled overseas in 2016.

North Carolina junior J.B. Bukauskas currently leads the ACC in wins with a 7-0 record for the season, and he also ranks first among league pitchers in strikeouts (89) and ERA (1.53). Bukauskas is bidding to become the seventh hurler to claim the ACC's pitching "Triple Crown" and the first since Clemson's Steve Reba in 2001.

Clemson's Pat Krall was named one of 10 finalists for the Senior CLASS Award ... The senior is 6-1 with a 2.62 ERA and 46 strikeouts against 16 walks in 58.1 innings pitched over 10 starts in 2017.

ACC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Busby became the first Seminole with three or more RBI in five straight games, leading Florida State to a series win over No. 4 Clemson and a split with rival Miami. Against the Tigers, Busby's three-run double gave FSU its first lead. Against Stetson on Wednesday, Busby went 3-for-4 with two home runs and three RBIs. At the Hurricanes on Friday, Busby was 3-for-5 with a 3-run home run and an RBI double in the ninth. His average has jumped to .305, 35 points higher than when the Clemson series started April 15. The junior third baseman was 8-for-18 in the five games during the week, with 10 runs driven in, two doubles, and three walks.

Against No. 18 Wake Forest, one of the nation's top offenses, Eubanks tossed a seven-hit shutout with a career-high 12 strikeouts against no walks to earn the win in the first game of a doubleheader on Saturday. He threw 116 pitches and did not allow a baserunner past first base until the eighth inning. It was his second ACC shutout in 2017 (at Boston College on March 25). On the year, he is 6-3 with a 3.36 ERA, .239 opponents' batting average and 67 strikeouts against nine walks in 64.1 innings pitched over 10 starts.
