QUOTING HEAD COACH AMY BOND

"I was pleased with our play this year despite the fact that we fell short of our No. 1 goal of playing at the National Championship. I thought, though, that overall we had a good year.

"The most important aspect of the season that I will remember is that we were young and our young players gained valuable playing experience – experience that is going to help us for a couple of years to come. Our young players became veteran players this year with each player on our roster contributing to our success. I was very pleased that they continued to learn and wanted to keep working to become better golfers.

"We will miss Jessica Negron who finished her career with a flurry. She had a great senior spring. Jessica will be remembered for her ability to play well in the postseason and for playing in four consecutive NCAA Tournaments in her career. Not very many collegiate players play in the NCAA Tournament every year of their collegiate careers.

"We showed some great character as a team during the final round of the NCAA West Regional as we fired our best round of the tournament and one of the best rounds of the day. I hope we can build off that momentum for next season. I am looking forward to August and the addition of four new players to our team. We have a tremendous freshman class coming in. Our team next year will not have a senior so we will be young again, however, I expect us to be extremely good. I am excited for the possibilities of next year's team."

FLORIDA STATE WOMEN'S GOLF TEAM PLAYS IN RECORD EIGHTH CONSECUTIVE NCAA REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP AND FINISHES FOURTH IN ACC CHAMPIONSHIPS SENIOR NEGRON EARNS ALL ACC HONORS AND NAMED TO ALL-WEST REGIONAL TEAM

FLORIDA STATE CONTINUES TO BE AN NCAA REGULAR IN 2013

The Florida State women's golf team, under third-year head coach Amy Bond, played in its school record eighth consecutive NCAA Championship tournament, finished in fourth place in the ACC Championships, earned eight top 10 finishes in 11 events during the fall and spring seasons, finished in a season-best second place in the team standings at the Florida Challenge and Jessica Negron earned All-ACC honors for the first time in her career during the Fall 2012 and Spring 2013 seasons. The Seminoles earned four top five team finishes during the spring season – second at the Florida Challenge, fourth at the Florida State Match-Up, fourth at the Marsh Landing Invitational and fourth at the ACC Championships – and played in the NCAA West Regional for the first time in school history.

NEGRON NAMED TO ALL-ACC TEAM

Senior Jessica Negron, who will lead the Seminoles into the NCAA West Regional Championship May 9-11 at the Stanford University Golf Course, has been named to the All-ACC Women's Golf team in a vote by the league's nine head coaches and announced by the ACC Office. It marks the first time in her career that she has earned All-ACC honors and is the school-record 13th consecutive season at least one Seminole player has earned All-ACC honors. Negron (Ocala, Fla.) is the No. 6 ranked golfer in the ACC with a career-low 74.11 stroke average and has earned three top-10 finishes this year. She has been Florida State's leading golfer in five of the Seminoles' seven events this spring and finished in a career-best tied for third place at the Florida State Match-Up tournament in February.

NEGRON ONE OF NINE IN SCHOOL HISTORY

With her participation in the 2013 ACC and NCAA Regional Championships, senior All-ACC selection Jessica Negron joined a very elite Seminole club as one of nine Seminoles (Mabel Pascual del Pobil, current Seminole head coach Amy Bond, Sarah Capie, Allison Curdt, Carrie Sordel, Caroline Westrup, Macarena Silva and Hannah Thomson) who all played in four career ACC Championship Tournaments and four career NCAA Regional Championship tournaments.

SEMINOLES FINISH FOURTH AT ACC CHAMPIONSHIPS

Florida State freshman Olivia Hullert finished in a tie for 12th place in the individual standings and the Seminoles women's golf team finished in fourth place in the team standings at the 25th Annual ACC Women's Golf Championships at Sedgefield Country Club. It marked the fifth time in the last seven seasons the Seminoles have finished in the top four of the team standings in the toughest conference in women's collegiate golf. In finishing in fourth place in the ACC Championships, Florida State outpaced two teams ahead of it in the national rankings: No. 9 North Carolina and No. 39 Wake Forest.

SEMINOLES PLAY IN SCHOOL RECORD EIGHTH CONSECUTIVE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

Senior Jessica Negron finished in ninth place in the individual standings and the Florida State women's golf team finished in 19th place in the team standings as the 2013 NCAA Division I West Regional Championships on the Stanford University Golf Course. Negron shot a 1 over par score of 72 in the final round and missed qualifying for the NCAA Championship finals by one stroke. It marked the eighth consecutive NCAA Championships appearance for the Florida State women's golf program. Florida State finished with a 295 team score in the third round – a score that was tied for the fourth best team score of the final round. The Seminoles were led in the final round by sophomore Laure Castelain who carded an even par 71. In addition to Castelain's 71 and Negron's 72, the Seminoles counted scores of 75 by Carlton Kuhlo and 77 by Olivia Hullert.

A FIRST FOR FLORIDA STATE

Florida State's appearance in the 2013 NCAA West Regional Championship marked the first time in school history the Seminoles had played in the West Regional Championship. The Seminoles have played in the NCAA East Regional 13 times, the NCAA Central Regional Championship four times and the NCAA West Regional once.

BOND NOW THREE FOR THREE

Florida State head coach Amy Bond has now guided each of her first three teams to the NCAA Tournament. Including her four years as a Seminole player (1996-99) and her five years as a Seminole assistant coach (2002-06), Bond has participated in 10 of 12 NCAA Regional Championships while wearing the Garnet and Gold.

ONLY THREE PLAYED IN ALL 11 EVENTS

Senior Jessica Negron, sophomore Laure Castelain and freshman Olivia Hullert are the only three Seminoles that played in each of Florida State's first 11 events of the 2013 spring and fall seasons.

FLORIDA STATE BY THE PERCENTAGES

Florida State's All-ACC selection Jessica Negron led the Seminoles in percentage of rounds counted during the Fall 2012 and Spring 2013 seasons as she counted .967 percent – all but one of her 30 rounds during her senior season to the Seminoles' team score throughout the season. Two of the Seminoles' underclassmen – Olivia Hullert (.833 percent counted) and sophomore Laure Castelain (.833 percent counted) have both counted better than 80 percent of their rounds this season.

NEGRON ENJOYS BEST SEASON OF CAREER

Senior All-ACC selection Jessica Negron enjoyed the best season of her career as she averaged a career-low 73.90 strokes in 30 rounds during 11 tournaments as a senior. Her career low scoring average marked the first time in her career that she averaged below 74.00 strokes for an entire season and the second time in her career that she averaged below 75.00 strokes during her Seminole career.

HULLERT LEADS SEMINOLES AT ACC CHAMPIONSHIPS

Freshman Olivia Hullert led the Seminoles with a tied for 12th place finish in the individual standings in leading the Seminoles to a fourth place finish at the

2013 ACC Championships. Hullert finished as the Seminoles leader for the fourth time in her career as she finished with a three round score of 228.

KUHLO IMPROVES AVERAGE BY MORE THAN FOUR STROKES

Sophomore Carlton Kuhlo, who played in her first career ACC Championship and her first career NCAA regional championship, shaved more than four strokes off of her season average during her sophomore season as compared to her freshman season. Kuhlo played in four more events and nine more rounds as a sophomore than she did as a freshman while tying her career best for a single round (73) and establishing career bests for 36-holes (151), a three round tournament score (224) and earned the best finish of her career (Tied for 16th at the Florida Challenge) as a sophomore.

RAMSAY ENJOYS THE SEASON OF HER CAREER

Senior Mary Beth Ramsay enjoyed the best season of her career as she played in a career-high seven tournaments (she had played in eight during the first three years of her career), played in a career-high 20 rounds (she played in 22 rounds during the first three years of her career), earned her first career top 10 finish (tied for eight at the Florida Challenge) and earned the best single round (72 in the Florida Challenge) and tournament scores (225 at the Marsh Landing Invitational) of her career. Ramsay also finished in a career best tied for eighth place in the individual standings at the Florida Challenge.

MILAN ENJOYS BEST SEASON OF CAREER

Sophomore Alex Milan played in a career-high tying seven events including the second ACC Championship and the first NCAA regional championship of her career and carded a career low 77.50 stroke average as she enjoyed her best season as a Seminole. She finished in a team-best tying tied for third in the individual standings at the Florida Challenge as she played as an individual. Milan placed as the highest ranking Seminole player and one of three in the top 10 in the individual standings. She earned career best statistics for single round score (72), 36-hole score (146) and finish (tied for third) at the Florida Challenge on January 28, 2013 and totaled her best tournament score (224) in the Florida State Match-Up.

SEMINOLES TO HOST 2014 NCAA EAST REGIONAL

Florida State will play host to the NCAA East Regional Championship as part of the NCAA Division I Women's Golf Championship May 8-10, 2014 at Southwood Golf Club in Tallahassee. The Seminoles will serve as one of three sites for the regional championships and will host an NCAA regional championship for the first time in school history.

SEMINOLES WIN 12TH CONSECUTIVE CUP FOR SERVICE

The Florida State women's golf team earned their unprecedented 12th consecutive Athletic Director's Cup for Service Award at the annual Golden Nole Banquet on April 21. The women's golf team performed an average of nearly 83 hours of community service throughout the year to outdistance the Seminoles' softball team who averaged 45.5 hours of community service per team member. The women's golf team has won the award for service each year since 2001.
