NOTING ACC BASEBALL

Clemson, Florida State and Pitt posted weekend ACC series sweeps, while Virginia, Wake Forest, Louisville and North Carolina were also series winners ... After three weekends of conference play, Clemson and Louisville share the Atlantic Division lead with 8-1 ACC records, two games up on Florida State and Wake Forest ... North Carolina (6-3) maintains its lead in the Coastal Division, with Virginia, Pitt, Duke and Miami all tied at two games back in the still-early log-jammed race.

Louisville and Clemson have already hit the 20-overall win mark for the season ... Four other ACC teams – Florida State, Wake Forest, North Carolina and Virginia – have a chance to do so by the end of March ... The ACC's Tuesday night nonconference schedule includes North Carolina at home versus defending national champion Coastal Carolina, Florida State versus rival Florida in a matchup of nationally ranked teams in Jacksonville, and Pitt playing host to rival West Virginia.

Six ACC teams are ranked this week, including four that are ranked in the top 10 ... Wake Forest is ranked in the Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball, and NCBWA polls, becoming the 10th ACC team this season to earn a national ranking ... The Demon Deacons have won each of their first three ACC series for the first time since 2002 and have earned their first national ranking since 2012.

While top-ranked Louisville maintains a share of the Atlantic Division lead after taking two of three at NC State, the Wolfpack's lone series win on Friday night was noteworthy in that it marked the first win for the program versus the nation's top-ranked team since April 27, 2013, when NC State defeated North Carolina.

Clemson senior pitcher Pat Krall is among the 30 candidates announced Monday for the 2017 Senior CLASS Award® in collegiate baseball ... To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition ... The award will be announced in June during this year's College World Series.

J.D. Drew's No. 39 jersey will be retired by Florida State prior to the Seminoles' home game versus Clemson on April 15 ... In 1997, Drew became the first player in college baseball to hit 30 home runs and steal 30 bases in a season, finishing with 31 and 32, respectively. He hit .455 on the season and pulled off the triple-triple with 106 hits, 110 runs scored and 100 RBI while earning consensus national player of the year honors ... Drew was a two-time consensus All-America selection as a sophomore and junior in 1996 and 1997. The Hahira, Georgia native totaled 69 home runs and hit .391 over his three-year Seminole career.

North Carolina's Brandon Riley has been named the ACC Player of the Week, while Clemson's Alex Eubanks took Pitcher of the Week honors ... Riley hit .600 with his first two home runs of the year as No. 10 UNC went 3-1 for the week with wins over East Carolina and a series victory over Miami ... Eubanks tossed a three-hit shutout in Clemson's 1-0 win over Boston College on Saturday. In 9.0 innings pitched, he allowed just three singles, no runs and no walks with a career-high-tying 10 strikeouts.

ACC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Riley hit .600 in four games last week as No. 10 North Carolina went 3-1 with a win at East Carolina and a series victory over Miami. The sophomore outfielder tallied nine hits, eight RBIs, two home runs, five runs scored, and reached base safely in 10 of 16 plate appearances. Against the Pirates, he went 3-for-4 with two runs, four RBIs, and hit a three-run home run. Riley, who posted a slugging percentage of 1.067 and an on-base percentage of .588, scored a run and tallied at least one hit in all four games on the week.

Eubanks tossed a three-hit shutout in Clemson's 1-0 win over Boston College at Kingston, Rhode Island, on Saturday. In 9.0 innings pitched, he allowed just three singles, no runs and no walks with a career-high-tying 10 strikeouts. He faced just 30 batters and threw only 103 pitches, including 78 for strikes. The sophomore from Moore, South Carolina, also did not allow a leadoff batter to reach base and did not go to a three-ball count on a batter.
