NOTING ACC BASEBALL

ACC baseball is set for its third weekend of conference series with Boston College, Pitt, Virginia, Wake Forest, Notre Dame, NC State and North Carolina hosting three-game sets ... Top-ranked Louisville (6-0 in ACC play) holds a one game lead over Clemson in the early Atlantic Division standings and is two games in front of Florida State as the Cardinals travel to Raleigh to take on the Wolfpack ... North Carolina sits atop the Coastal Division, one game in front of Miami, Duke and Virginia Tech ... The Tar Heels play host to Miami this weekend.

Five ACC teams are ranked this week, led by Louisville, which holds the No. 1 spot in five of the six national polls. Clemson is ranked as high as No. 6 (Baseball America), the program's highest ranking since 2011. North Carolina, Florida State, and Virginia are also ranked this week.

The ACC continues to boast three teams among the nation's top five in home runs per game with Wake Forest (1.82) at No. 2, Georgia Tech (1.79) at No. 3, and Virginia Tech (1.65) at No. 5 ... Wake Forest also heads into this weekend's series versus Georgia Tech as the third-leading scoring team in the nation (9.1 runs per game) and second in team slugging percentage (.543) ... The trend continued in this week's 13-4 win over Charlotte, in which Logan Harvey posted his first-career four-hit game, finishing 4-for-4 with a grand slam, two doubles and five RBIs ... Harvey's grand slam was the fifth by a Deacon batter in 22 games this season.

Former Duke standout Marcus Stroman was named the 2017 World Baseball Classic MVP after pitching Team USA to its first WBC title Wednesday evening ... Stroman carried a no-hitter into the seventh inning of Team USA's 8-0 victory, successfully slowing a Puerto Rico lineup that carried a plus-37 run differential and 7-0 record for the tournament ... The no-hit bid, which ended with an Angel Pagan leadoff double in the seventh, matched the longest of Stroman's professional career. The former Blue Devil kept the Red Sox hitless for six innings in a start for Toronto on July 24, 2014 Stroman exited Wednesday's WBC final to a standing ovation from over 50,000 fans at Dodger Stadium on Wednesday night ... He was joined on the Team USA roster by fellow ACC alums Buster Posey (Florida State) and Andrew Miller (North Carolina).

Eleven ACC student-athletes are listed among Baseball America's most recent Top 100 MLB Draft prospects for 2017 ... The ACC's 11 ties for the most of any conference on a list that includes the No. 2 prospect in Louisville two-way standout Brendan McKay and the No. 3 prospect in North Carolina pitcher J.B. Bukauskas ... Virginia first baseman Pavin Smith (No. 11) and outfielder Adam Haseley (No. 18) are also among the top 20.

ACC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Williams hit .421 with three home runs, two doubles, 10 RBIs, three runs, two walks, a hit-by-pitch, 1.000 slugging percentage and .478 on-base percentage in leading Clemson to four wins in five games last week. The junior from Garden Grove, California, had at least one hit in all five games, including each of the games against No. 15 Virginia.

McKay struck out 12 while scattering five singles and issuing one walk in seven shutout innings versus Boston College to move to 4-0 on the season. In his four starts on the mound this season, McKay has allowed just one earned run in 25.0 innings (0.36 ERA) with 41 strikeouts and only six walks.

Anderson scattered five hits and two walks over eight scoreless innings pitched in a 17-0 win over No. 4 Florida State to pick up his league-high tying fourth win of the season. It was a career-high tying 8.0 innings and he notched his team-leading fourth quality start.
