ACC BASEBALL NOTEBOOK

The final weekend of the regular season begins with Louisville and North Carolina having clinched division titles and a total of eight teams assured of berths in the 2017 ACC Baseball Championship ... The upcoming ACC series remain crucial as teams battle for the remaining spots in the 12-team field and try to improve their seeding for the tournament, which will be held May 23-28 at Louisville Slugger Field ... The closing three-game series – all of which will be played Thursday through Saturday – include Notre Dame at Boston College, Virginia at Georgia Tech, Florida State at Louisville, Clemson at NC State, Duke at North Carolina, Pitt at Wake Forest, and Virginia Tech at Miami.

In addition to Louisville and North Carolina, six other teams – Clemson, Wake Forest, Florida State, NC State, Virginia and Miami – are assured of spots in the ACC Championship. None of the league's 14 teams have been mathematically eliminated.

Louisville has captured the Atlantic Division every year since joining the conference prior to the 2015 season ... The winningest coach in school history with a 502-198 record overall, Dan McDonnell has averaged more than 45 wins per season in his 11 years at Louisville while ranking in the top five nationally among active coaches in winning percentage (.717).

North Carolina has clinched the Coastal Division title for the first time since 2013, but the Tar Heels own six ACC Coastal crowns since the league went to divisions starting in 2006 ... UNC has won nine ACC series this season, matching the school record set by the 2008 team that won nine series and tied one.

Five ACC teams are ranked again this week, with all five holding spots in the top 15 of the Baseball America Top 25. Louisville and North Carolina are No. 2 and No. 3, respectively, in every national poll. Virginia is ranked as high as No. 8 this week, while Clemson is ranked as high as No. 12 and Wake Forest at No. 15.

ACC teams will close the regular season with a 249-98 (.718) record against nonconference opposition ... ACC teams won 10 of 12 collective games versus opponents from outside the league on Tuesday.

In the latest NCAA tournament projections, both D1Baseball and Baseball America project seven ACC teams in the field, with Louisville and North Carolina as national seeds, Clemson, Virginia, and Wake Forest as regional hosts, and Florida State and NC State also in the field.

NC State has now won six consecutive ACC games and 11 of its last 12 overall to run its record to 31-21 on the year and 14-13 in conference action ... During the aforementioned 12 games, the Pack has compiled a .329 batting average and has limited opponents to a .214 clip. NC State has scored 99 runs during that stretch while holding opponents to 35.

Five ACC teams rank among the top 13 of the most recent RPI with North Carolina at No. 2, Louisville at No. 3, Clemson at No. 8, Wake Forest at No. 9 and Virginia at No. 13 ... Florida State is at No. 26, and NC State has moved up to No. 36 with its late-season run.

ACC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Fitch paced the way offensively during a 4-0 week for the No. 2 Cardinals as the junior hit .500 (7-for-14) with three home runs, five RBIs, five runs scored, 1.214 slugging percentage and .529 on-base percentage. Fitch hit safely and drove in at least one run in each of Louisville's four wins against top 25 foes.

In five games last week, Steel drove in nine runs and had five extra-base hits to lead the Demon Deacons offensively as they won a series over Florida State in Tallahassee for the first time since 1993. The redshirt sophomore from Jupiter, Florida, recorded his first-career multi-homer game and set a new career-high with five RBIs in Sunday's series finale against the Seminoles as Wake Forest tied a program record with the 17th ACC win on the season.

Holton turned in the finest performance of the season for Florida State, tossing a complete-game shutout against No. 19 Wake Forest. The sophomore from Tallahassee, Florida, allowed just four hits, all singles, and no walks, and no Demon Deacon reached second base in the game.
