NOTING ACC BASEBALL

Five ACC teams are ranked this week, with all five in the top 20 of every poll and three teams in the top five ... Louisville is the unanimous No. 2 team, while both Clemson and North Carolina are ranked as high as No. 3 in a national poll. Virginia is No. 11 in NCBWA Poll, while Wake Forest is as high as No. 17.

No. 3 North Carolina, No. 5 Louisville, and No. 6 Clemson lead the way in the latest update of the NCAA RPI, with No. 11 Virginia and No. 12 Wake Forest giving the ACC five of the top 12 teams. With No. 29 Florida State, and No. 39 NC State, seven ACC teams rank in the top 40.

The College Baseball Foundation announced three watch lists this week ... The Brooks Wallace Award Watch List, given to the nation's top shortstop, includes Clemson's Logan Davidson, Florida State's Taylor Walls, Georgia Tech's Austin Whilhite, Louisville's Devon Hairston, North Carolina's Logan Warmoth, Virginia's Ernie Clement, Virginia Tech's Ryan Tufts, and Wake Forest's Bruce Steel.

The National Pitcher of the Year Watch List includes Clemson's Charlie Barnes, Clemson's Pat Krall, Florida State's Tyler Holton, Louisville's Kade McClure, Louisville's Brendan McKay, North Carolina's J.B. Bukauskas, Virginia's Adam Haseley, and Virginia Tech's Connor Coward.

The John Olerud Award Watch List, given to the top two-way player, includes Duke's Jack Labosky, Louisville's Brendan McKay, Virginia's Adam Haseley, and Virginia Tech's

Nick Anderson.

Wake Forest's Stuart Fairchild was named the NCBWA National Player of the Week ... The junior hit .500 with 14 RBIs, 11 hits, nine runs, four home runs, and three doubles last week to lead the Demon Deacons to a perfect 5-0 record.

Louisville enters the weekend one game ahead of Clemson and three games up on Wake Forest in the Atlantic Division standings ... North Carolina continues to hold a four-game lead over Virginia in the Coastal Division ... Each ACC team has 12 league games remaining as they open three-game series on Friday.

Saturday's game between Boston College and NC State is the 6th Annual ALS Awareness Game. The two teams will play at Fenway Park at 4 p.m. with the game broadcast on ESPNU.

Baseball America continues to project seven ACC teams in this year's NCAA postseason field, led by three national seeds in No. 2 North Carolina, No. 6 Louisville and No. 7 Clemson ... In addition to those three, Wake Forest and Virginia are projected as host schools for the sub-regional round, while Florida State and NC State are also in the field ... D1 Baseball also projects seven ACC teams in the NCAA field, and also projects UNC as the No. 2 overall seed, while Clemson is at No. 5 and Louisville at No. 6.

ACC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Fairchild hit .500 with 14 RBIs, 11 hits, nine runs, four home runs, and three doubles on the week to lead Wake Forest to a perfect 5-0 record. In a 19-9 win over defending national champion Coastal Carolina, he went 3-for-5 with seven RBIs and two home runs. In a sweep of Notre Dame, the junior outfielder from Seattle, Washington, tallied six hits with five runs and four runs driven in. Fairchild has reached base safely in 39 straight games dating back to last season, and is the only player in the league with double digits in both home runs (11) and stolen bases (10).

McKay allowed just one hit in eight dominant innings on the mound to lead No. 2 Louisville to a 3-0 victory over Georgia Tech in last Thursday's series-opener at Russ Chandler Stadium. McKay finished with eight strikeouts while surrendering only a fourth inning single to go with two walks to move to 5-2 on the season and 26-9 in his collegiate career. The junior from Darlington, Pennsylvania, retired the final 13 batters he faced while reaching eight strikeouts in a game for the 24th time. McKay, who ranks second in career strikeouts at Louisville with 321, has a 1.19 ERA and 76 strikeouts in his 53.0 innings this season.
