ACC BASEBALL NOTEBOOK

The penultimate weekend of the regular season gets underway on Friday ... Louisville holds a four-game lead over Clemson with six games remaining, while North Carolina sits five games up over Virginia in the Coastal Division as teams battle for position in the upcoming ACC Baseball Championship, set for May 23-28 at Louisville Slugger Field ... The top 12 teams in the final ACC standings will earn spots in the tournament, with the division winners claiming the top two seeds.

Five teams – Clemson, Louisville, North Carolina, Virginia, and Wake Forest -- have officially clinched spots in the field in Louisville.

A top-10 matchup highlights this weekend's action as #7 Clemson hosts #2 Louisville in a battle of the two teams atop the Atlantic Division standings ... The series gets underway on Friday at 6:30 p.m. and Saturday at 4 p.m., and the series finale on Sunday at noon will be televised on ESPN2 ... Other key division matchups include Georgia Tech at Duke, Miami at #8 Virginia, #3 North Carolina at Virginia Tech, and #19 Wake Forest at Florida State ... NC State and Pitt square off in crossover series.

Two ACC coaches are nearing career milestones ... Louisville's Dan McDonnell sits on 499 career wins, while Notre Dame's Mik Aoki has compiled 398 in his career.

In the latest NCAA tournament projections, D1Baseball has seven ACC teams making the field with three (Clemson, Louisville, and North Carolina) as national seeds, two more (Virginia and Wake Forest) hosting regionals, and two squads (Florida State and NC State)

on the road for regionals.

Six ACC teams – Florida State, Louisville, North Carolina, Clemson, Virginia, and Wake Forest – are ranked among the nation's Top 25 in the national polls heading into weekend action, with Louisville and North Carolina still consensus No. 2 and No. 3 respectively ... Clemson and Virginia also hold spots in the top 10. In the updated NCAA RPI, eight ACC teams are ranked in the top 54, including five of the top 11.

The selection of Louisville's McKay as ACC Pitcher of the Week marked the seventh weekly honor of his career (six Pitcher of the Week honors and one Player of the Week award), setting the all-time ACC career record for weekly recognition previously held by Clemson's Kris Benson, Florida State's J.D. Drew, and Paul Wilson, and NC State's Terry Harvey.

ACC teams fared well in midweek nonconference games, posting a cumulative 10-4 mark ... ACC teams now own a 235-95 (.712) record versus nonconference opposition during the 2017 season.

As the regular season winds down, Virginia's Adam Haseley leads the ACC with a .399 batting average, just ahead of Clemson's Reed Rohlman (.398) ... North Carolina's J.B. Bukauskas (1.51) and Louisville's Brendan McKay (1.92) lead the ACC in ERA ... Five ACC sluggers rank in the top 20 in the nation in home runs this season: Wake Forest's Gavin Sheets (17), NC State's Joe Dunand (16), and Wake Forest's Johnny Aiello, Virginia Tech's Sam Fragale, and Louisville's Brendan McKay (15).

ACC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Sheets hit .364 with six RBIs over the weekend to lead the No. 20 Demon Deacons to a series win over Boston College. In the series opener on Friday, he posted his third multi-homer game of the season and his fourth game with at least five RBIs. The junior first baseman leads the nation with 69 RBIs on the season and leads the ACC with 17 home runs.

McKay threw eight scoreless innings allowing only an infield single with eight strikeouts to lead the Cardinals to a 2-0 series-opening victory at Notre Dame last Friday night. The junior from Darlington, Pennsylvania, improved to 7-3 on the season and 28-10 in his collegiate career while leading Louisville to its ninth shutout of the season. This week's outing marked the second time in four starts McKay has allowed just one hit in eight shutout innings after achieving the feat in a victory at Georgia Tech on April 13. Through 11 starts and 75.0 innings pitched this season, McKay has a 1.92 ERA with 103 strikeouts and opposing batters are hitting just .160 overall against him.

This is the seventh career weekly award for McKay (six Pitcher of the Week honors and one Player of the Week award), setting the all-time ACC career record for weekly recognition previously held by Clemson's Kris Benson, Florida State's J.D. Drew, and Paul Wilson, and NC State's Terry Harvey.
