

TWO-TIME ALL-AMERICAN JACE PARDON LEADS FSU'S BEACH VOLLEYBALL PROGRAM AT THE AVCA COLLEGIATE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

THE NATION'S NEWEST SPORT

- The NCAA added Beach Volleyball to its list of championship sports beginning in 2016 becoming the 90th and newest National Championship hosted by the NCAA. The inaugural championship will be held in Gulf Shores, Ala., May 5-7.
- Florida State introduced what was then called sand volleyball as its 20th varsity sport in the spring of 2012 and competed as an emerging NCAA sport for four seasons.
- The sport changed names from sand to beach volleyball as it is known as the latter at all other levels of play throughout the world.
- Beach Volleyball is the fastest-growing NCAA sport with 55 colleges and universities sponsoring the sport as of January 2016.

AN ELITE PROGRAM

- Since the inception of the program in 2012, Florida State has advanced to the AVCA Championships in each of its first four seasons.
- The Seminoles finished as the national runner-up in 2014 falling to Pepperdine, 3-2, in the fi-

nals. FSU registered a pair of top three finishes at the AVCA Championships in 2012 and 2013.

- Florida State is one of just two beach volleyball programs (Pepperdine) to have played in the first four AVCA Championships (2012-15).
- Since 2012, FSU has been recognized with seven AVCA Beach All-America honors from five different players. The Seminoles' seven All-Americans are tied for the third most nationally.
- Jace Pardon (2013 & 2014) and Aurora (Newgard) Davis (2012 & 2014) hold the distinction as FSU's only two-time AVCA Beach All-Americans in the program's short history.
- Through its first four seasons, Florida State boasts an all-time winning percentage of .813 (65-15) recording a program record 19 dual match victories in 2014.
- FSU has recorded eight wins against ranked opponents dating back to 2013. The Seminoles highest ranked wins both came on the road at No. 3 Southern Cal in 2013 and at No. 3 Long Beach State in 2014.

FSU JOINS THE CCSA

- Florida State joined forces with the Coastal Collegiate Sports Association as a charter member for beach volleyball only for the spring 2016 season.
- FSU is one of eight founding members that will begin play in 2016 including: UAB, Florida Atlantic, Florida International, Georgia State, LSU, South Carolina and Tulane.
- The eight schools will battle for the first CCSA Beach Volleyball Championship at the LakePoint Sports Complex in Emerson, Ga.
- Florida State is the only school to sponsor beach volleyball in the Atlantic Coast Conference.

ATTRACTING THE VERY BEST

- First year head coach Brooke Niles earned third team All-America honors in indoor volleyball at UC Santa Barbara before moving on to a successful professional beach volleyball career. She was named 2009 AVP Beach Defensive Player of the Year and spent four seasons as a member of the USA Beach National Team.
- Assistant coach Hector Gutierrez has a wealth of international experience both as an indoor and beach volleyball coach. He served as head coach of the Slovakia Beach National Team and assistant coach on the German Beach National Team before spending time as a coach on the U.S. Beach National Team.
- Volunteer assistant Traci Weamer was a three-time All-American in indoor volleyball at Concordia University, Irvine and was named Student-Athlete of the Year in 2009. Weamer became the youngest female player to qualify for the AVP Championship in 2012 and has been a member of the U.S. Beach National Team since 2012.
- FSU Beach Volleyball has also attracted some of the very best athletes internationally since the program's inception in 2012 with players coming from Latvia, Serbia, Turkey and most recently Norway (Cecilie Woie) and Puerto Rico (Eva Torruella).





SEMINOLE BEACH VOLLEYBALL COURTS



Completed in 2011, Florida State's five beach volleyball courts were one of the first facilities to be built specifically for collegiate beach volleyball. Located north of the Seminole Soccer Complex and JoAnne Graf Field between Mike Long Track and the Spirit Way Parking Garage, the facility is wrapped in Florida State University graphics and logos highlighting the enormous success of the FSU Beach Volleyball team during the sport's first four years. The Seminole Beach Volleyball Courts remain one of the premier facilities in the nation.

There are three entrances where patrons can enter the facility with seating for approximately 150 people on the bleachers at sand level. The multi-level parking garage adjacent to the courts can also be used for spectator viewing. Spectators are encouraged to bring their own lawn chairs to the event as well. The courts are also equipped with permanent lighting to allow matches to be played at night.

The Seminole Beach Volleyball Courts were built using two types of sand. The lower level of sand is more powdery to allow precipitation to filter through to the drainage system. The upper level of sand is more dense allowing student-athletes a competitive playing surface each time out.

- Tully Gymnasium is the home of the Florida State Beach Volleyball team housing the coaches' offices, team lounge and locker room. Renovations to the Seminoles new home were completed in January of 2016 thanks to the support of the FSU Athletics Department and Seminole Boosters.
- The locker room features individual lockers for each student-athlete on the beach volleyball team identified with their own personal name plate, individual shower stalls and bath rooms. The lockers include plenty of storage for both hanging clothes and folded items along with power outlets that also feature USB ports.
- The team lounge provides ample space to hold team meetings, watch film or to give the beach volleyball student-athletes a quiet place to study. The lounge is equipped with a 64' HD-television screen, couches and chairs for plenty of comfort.
- A satellite workout facility is located just outside the beach volleyball office in Tully Gym featuring state-of-the-art equipment. The Tully Gym weight room is a clean and spacious 4,500 square foot facility equipped with mondo-rubber flooring, 10 squat racks, and houses 10 platforms for Olympic lifting. With an iPad on every rack and a change of facility design, Florida State continues to improve each of its strength and conditioning facilities.



THE CCSA



The FSU Beach Volleyball program will join the Coastal Collegiate Sports Association (CCSA) as a charter member for the spring 2016 season.

CCSA Beach Volleyball will begin play in the spring of 2016 with eight founding members: University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB), Florida Atlantic University, Florida International University, Florida State University, Georgia State University, Louisiana State University (LSU), the University of South Carolina and Tulane University.

The first CCSA Beach Volleyball Championship will be held at LakePoint Sports Complex in Emerson, Ga., on the Rally Volleyball Courts on April 22-24.

The CCSA, which was formerly known as the Coastal Collegiate Swimming Association at the Division I level, rebranded to include beach volleyball for the upcoming season.

Beach Volleyball became the 90th championship sponsored by the NCAA in the summer of 2015. The first NCAA Beach Volleyball Championship will be conducted May 5-7, 2016 in Gulf Shores, Alabama and will be hosted by CCSA member UAB.

The creation of CCSA Beach Volleyball provides student-athletes the opportunity to compete for conference honors and championships. The NCAA does not currently offer automatic qualification (AQ) into the beach volleyball championship for conference winners (a two-year championship history is required), but the CCSA will be in position to qualify for an AQ should they be offered in 2018.

The CCSA formed in 2007 as a partnership among swimming and diving programs in the Atlantic Sun Conference, Big South Conference, Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference and Southern Conference to provide championship opportunities for men's and women's swimming and diving student-athletes. Conference growth in swimming and diving now shows 15 institutions with competitors from eight separate Division I multisport conferences. With the addition of beach volleyball, the Coastal Collegiate Sports Association now has 22 member institutions with participants from 11 different NCAA Division I multisport conferences.



Florida State University athletics has announced the hiring of U.S. beach volleyball professional Brooke Niles as the Seminoles new sand volleyball head coach. Niles is a California native who earned All-American honors as a player and has coached at the collegiate, junior college, club and high school levels working with both indoor and sand volleyball teams.

“I am beyond excited to join the Florida State family as the head sand volleyball coach,” said Niles. “The school has a rich history of athletic and academic excellence and shows amazing support for sand volleyball. Although sand volleyball is still a relatively new collegiate sport, FSU had already inserted itself as a dominant force. I have already fallen in love with Tallahassee and the university and I can’t wait to share my passion, knowledge and love for the game with this team. I want to also thank Stan Wilcox, Vanessa Fuchs, indoor coach Chris Poole and the entire search committee for this amazing opportunity.”

“We are looking forward to Brooke joining us at Florida State to lead our sand volleyball team,” said FSU Director of Athletics Stan Wilcox. “Her broad and extraordinarily successful experience will be invaluable in continuing to grow the program. I know that she is as excited about leading our student-athletes as they are to be led by someone with her background and stature in the sand volleyball community.”



Niles, who earned a law and society degree from UC Santa Barbara in 2003, was a third-team All-American while playing for the Gauchos where she also was a three-time All-Big West selection and named conference freshman of the year. Following her playing career at UCSB, Niles spent three years as an assistant indoor coach at her alma mater before beginning a



successful professional beach volleyball career in 2007 that saw her win numerous pro tournaments along with being named the AVP Beach Defensive Player of the Year in 2009.

While climbing to a top five ranking in the National Volleyball Beach League and spending 2010-13 as a member of the USA Beach National Team, Niles was a first alternate for the USA 2012 London Olympic Beach National team.

The Woodland Hills, CA resident returned to coaching in 2010 at Oxnard Junior College with the indoor team. In 2012 she began coaching professional beach volleyball teams competing on the FIVB World Tour from the USA, Costa Rica and the Netherlands. Most recently Niles coached at Mira Costa High School in California and she was the director, founder and head coach of The Beach Team Club in Hermosa, CA.

“I’m very excited for Brooke to join our volleyball family,” said FSU Volleyball Head Coach Chris Poole. “She played beach volleyball and indoor volleyball at the highest level. She has also coached indoor volleyball at a Top 10 level in the NCAA Division I and she has coached and trained with some of the best beach players in the world. The references we got from National Team level players/coaches and Gold Medalist were outstanding. She had a very impressive resume and made an impact on everyone during her visit.”

“Brooke will lead the squad in a fantastic way and help the ladies grow and learn in so many ways,” said Kerri Walsh a three-time Olympic gold medalist in beach volleyball. “Her competitiveness is truly an asset as it leads her to work hard and push for excellence. She practices what she preaches and this to me is what coaching/teaching is all about.”

Niles will take over a program that has played in the AVCA National Championships in each of its four seasons since the program’s inception and will lead FSU into sand volleyball’s first season as a full-fledged NCAA championship sport in 2016.

Niles is married to Nick Lucena, a Florida State graduate and professional beach volleyball player on the AVP Tour. They have one child, Gunnar (2).

Hector Gutierrez is in his first season as an assistant coach with the Florida State beach volleyball team. His primary responsibilities will include the implementation of the day-to-day training and recruiting. Gutierrez joins the Seminole coaching staff after spending the last 10 months as a head coach on the United States Beach Volleyball national team.

Gutierrez comes to Florida State with a wealth of international experience both as an indoor and beach volleyball coach. Prior to his position with the U.S. National Team, Gutierrez served as head coach on the Slovakia (2014) Beach Volleyball national women's team and an assistant coach on the German Beach Volleyball national team from 2012 to 2013. He also worked with the Swiss Beach Volleyball national team for one year (2011-12).

With the U.S. squad, Gutierrez led the team of Brittany Hochevar and Heather McGuire to a ninth place showing at the Prague Open in the Czech Republic. He then led Hochevar and teammate Jennifer Fopma to a ninth place finish at the Long Beach Grand Slam in California.

As coach of the Slovakian Beach Volleyball team, Gutierrez led Dominika Nestracova and Natalia Dubovcova to a season-best third place finish at the Stavanger Grand Slam in Norway. The duo went on to post four top 10 finishes in 2014 en route to a final Federation Internationale De Volleyball (FIVB) ranking of 13th.

During his stint as an assistant with the German National Team, Gutierrez helped the women's team of Karla Borger and Britta Buthe to a second place finish at the 2012 World Championships in Stare Jablonki, Poland. That squad finished the 2012-13 season ranked 11th in the FIVB world rankings.

Gutierrez also spent time as a second assistant coach for women's indoor teams in Turkey (Diyarbakir V.C. – 2011) and Azerbaijan (Baki BAKU V.C. – 2012) and an assistant coach with MTV Stuttgart of the Women's Bundesliga I in Germany. He also served as head coach of the Volero Zurich men's team of the NLB League for one season.

His coaching background also includes stints with the Sunshine Volleyball Club in Santa Monica, Calif., and as an assistant coach at Brentwood High School in Los Angeles.

Gutierrez began his professional playing career at the age of 17 playing all throughout Spain. He was a member of C.V Orotava that finished second in the FEV Spanish Volleyball League "Pro 1" in 2004. He also played in the European League, CEV CUP, with C.V Arona in Tenerife, Spain, helping the team to a fifth place finish in the league "Pro 1."

Born in Lanzarote, Canary Islands, Gutierrez moved to Tenerife with his family when he was eight years old. He earned a bachelor's degree in Pedagogy from the University of La Laguna, Tenerife. Gutierrez is married to Katie Carter, an All-American volleyball player at UCLA and current professional indoor player.

Traci Weamer joins the Florida State beach volleyball coaching staff as a volunteer assistant for the 2015-16 campaign. Weamer's primary responsibilities will be in student-athlete development and in the implementation of day-to-day training.

Weamer was a three-time first team All-American in indoor volleyball at Concordia University, Irvine (2006-09) where she graduated cum laude with a bachelor's degree in International Studies and a minor in History. She was named the Female Student-Athlete of the Year in her final season at CU Irvine in 2009. Weamer began her college career at Cal State San Bernardino (2005-06) where she garnered NCAA Division II Freshman of the Year accolades.

Following a successful collegiate career, Weamer began playing beach volleyball in 2010 competing in the National Volleyball League (NVL), the Jose Cuervo Pro Series and the AVP (Association of Volleyball Professionals). In 2012, she became the youngest female player to qualify for the AVP Championship in Santa Barbara, Calif., and recorded her best finish on tour in 2014 with a fifth place showing in Salt Lake City, Utah. Weamer made her pro beach debut on the AVP Tour in 2010 at Huntington Beach with playing partner Tanya White.

Weamer has also competed internationally as a member of the USA Beach Volleyball team since 2012. She has tallied seven medal stand finishes including two gold medal finishes in St. Lucia (2012) and Punta Cana, Dominican Republic (2015). Other medal finishes include earning silver at Grand Cayman, Cayman Island (2015), Antigua, Guatemala (2014), Trinidad & Tobago (2012) and Chiapas, Mexico (2012). She also captured a bronze medal in San Jose, Costa Rica in 2013.

A native of Upland, Calif., Weamer began her coaching career as an undergraduate assistant at Concordia University Irvine in 2010. She then spent four seasons as a coach for the Tstreet Indoor Volleyball Club team in Irvine coaching all ages ranging from U-12, U-14, U-15, U-16 and U-17. Weamer led the U-14 Open division to a silver medal finish in 2011. She then served a one-year stint (2014-15) coaching club beach volleyball in Huntington Beach with the Bear Coast Beach Volleyball Club.

Weamer's coaching experience also extended to the AVP where she coached the AVPFirst, a non-profit arm of the AVP. When she's not coaching, Weamer also writes a blog for the AVPFirst and was a contributing writer for the blog 'The Unwritten Rules,' featured on the AVP website. Following the 2016 beach season at Florida State, Weamer plans a return to the AVP with her sights set on the FIVB World Tour.
