NOTING ACC BASEBALL

After posting an 8-1 record in midweek games, ACC baseball teams launch another busy weekend of nonconference play with one game on Thursday and 14 on Friday. Upcoming weekend series include No. 17 Miami's three-game series at second-ranked rival Florida ... Ten of the ACC's 14 teams play at home this weekend ... other road trips include Virginia Tech's first-ever trip to Nevada, Pitt's three-game series vs. Siena in Vero Beach, Florida, and Notre Dame in the Tony Gwynn Classic in San Diego.

Several ACC coaches reached milestones during the opening week of the season. Last weekend saw Florida State head coach Mike Martin post his 1,900 career victory, while Mike Fox picked up his 800th victory as head coach of the Tar Heels ... Martin is only the second coach to reach 1,900 wins, and Fox is the winningest coach in UNC history ... On Tuesday, Virginia's Brian O'Connor recorded his 600th career coaching win as the Cavaliers defeated VMI, becoming the second fastest in ACC history to reach the 600-win plateau (825 games, second only to Florida State's Martin, 802 games). O'Connor currently is the winningest coach in program history and 10th in career wins in ACC history.

A number of ACC batters have gotten off to fast starts, with two having already accumulated double-digit runs batted in ... Reigning ACC Player of the Week Sam Fragale of Virginia Tech has driven in 11 runs in only four games. Georgia Tech's Kel Johnson has 10 RBIs thus far ... Johnson has already launched five home runs, including three in Tuesday night's road win at Georgia Southern ... Fragale hit three home runs in Virginia Tech's season opening win at USC Upstate, and Louisville's Brendan McKay also boast three homers (with nine RBIs) four games into the season, including his first career grand slam on Tuesday against Eastern Kentucky.

Four ACC teams head into Week 2 ranked among NCBWA's top 10, led by Florida State at #4. Louisville holds the #8 spot, followed by #9 North Carolina and #10 NC State. A total of eight ACC teams are ranked in the poll.

ACC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

A redshirt junior first baseman from Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, Virginia Tech's Sam Fragale posted a monster season-opening game, hitting three home runs in his first three at bats and finishing the day 5-for-5 with a double and triple and a career-high seven RBI. The 11-3 win over USC Upstate marked the first season-opening victory for Virginia Tech since 2013. Fragale became the first Tech player with a three-home run game since Chris Kay (May 10, 2009 vs. Delaware State), and became just the fifth Hokie with seven RBI in a single game since Virginia Tech joined the ACC. In the second game of the series, he added a two-RBI single in the first inning and had a single and scored a run in the series finale. The Hokies swept USC Upstate for its first road sweep since 2013.

Wake Forest's Connor Johnstone threw the first complete-game shutout by a Wake Forest pitcher since 2006 in an opening day win over Nicholls. The senior from Roswell, Georgia, only allowed one hit with six strikeouts and two walks in the nine inning effort, setting a new career high in innings pitched and strikeouts. The one hit allowed marked the fewest by a Wake Forest pitcher since 2012.
