NOTING ACC BASEBALL

Regular-season conference play hits the halfway mark for ACC teams this weekend ... One key series finds Wake Forest traveling to Louisville in a matchup of nationally-ranked Atlantic Division teams ... Louisville is unbeaten at home this season and has won 37 consecutive regular-season games at Jim Patterson Stadium ... Other action includes North Carolina at Boston College, Georgia Tech at Notre Dame, Pitt at Virginia, Virginia Tech at Clemson, Florida State at NC State, and Duke at Miami ... The Duke-Miami series begins on Saturday and concludes Monday night on ESPNU ... Louisville and Clemson continue to share the top spot in the Atlantic Division with 10-2 league records, two games up on Wake Forest ... North Carolina (9-3) holds a three-game lead in the Coastal Division over second-place Pitt and Virginia Tech.

Six ACC teams are ranked this week, with three in the top five in the country ... Louisville is the unanimous No. 2-ranked team, while Clemson and North Carolina are both ranked as high as No. 4 ... Florida State, Virginia, and Wake Forest also hold spots in the polls.

The ACC posted a collective 13-2 record in midweek nonconference games ... That included a 4-1 mark versus ranked teams, a 3-0 record against SEC teams and a 2-0 mark against SEC division leaders ... Wins included Louisville's 5-3 victory over rival and fellow top-10 ranked Kentucky, Florida State's two-game sweep of No. 17 Florida Gulf Coast, Georgia Tech's win at No. 13 Auburn, and Clemson's 4-0 decision at Georgia ... It marked the Tigers' first shutout win at Athens since 1910.

With roughly a month and a half remaining in the regular season, Baseball America projects North Carolina, Clemson and Louisville as national seeds for the 2017 NCAA Championship ... The publication places UNC at No. 2, Clemson at No. 4 and Louisville at No. 8 among the national seeds ... Wake Forest is also projected as a regional host ... Three additional ACC teams – Florida State, NC State and Virginia – are projected to receive NCAA bids.

North Carolina owns the No. 1 strength of schedule in the country, according to WarrenNolan.com ... The Tar Heels are one of four ACC teams – along with Clemson, Louisville and Wake Forest – to have won each of their four conference series to date.

Virginia, whose collective team batting average of .322 is 10 points higher than the next closest ACC team, put together another big night at the plate on Wednesday with 15 hits in an 11-1 win over George Washington ... The Cavaliers totaled 29 runs and 43 hits over its two midweek victories ... Pavin Smith had five hits and 10 RBI in the two games ... Adam Haseley had a pair of hits versus George Washington and continues to lead the ACC in batting at .410 ... Each Virginia starter recorded at least one hit on Wednesday night.

Pitt extended its winning streak to three games and ended a four-game losing streak versus rival Penn State with Tuesday night's 3-2 win over the Nittany Lions ... In posting their first win in the series since March 27, 2013, the Panthers had a strong pitching performance from freshman Dan Hammer (5.0 IP), freshman Chris Gomez (1.0 IP), freshman RJ Freure (2.1 IP) and junior Isaac Mattson (0.2 IP) ... The four combined to limit Penn State to seven hits.

ACC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Rohlman went 8-for-16 (.500) with two homers, two doubles, eight RBIs, five runs, six walks, a hit-by-pitch, 1.000 slugging percentage and .652 on-base percentage to lead Clemson to four wins in five games last week. He had at least one hit and one walk in all five games and had an outfield assist on Saturday when he threw a runner out at the plate. On Wednesday, the junior outfielder from Moore, South Carolina, hit a walk-off single in a win over Winthrop. On Sunday, he went 3-for-5 with two homers, a double, seven RBIs, three runs and a walk in Clemson's 13-6 win at Georgia Tech. It was the first time since 2010 a Tiger totaled more than five RBIs in a game.

Holton held No. 8 North Carolina without a hit in seven innings pitched while striking out eight on Saturday. Before walking a batter to start the eighth, Holton had allowed just four baserunners, all on errors, and each was stranded. The sophomore from Tallahassee, Florida, dropped his ERA from 2.31 to 1.93 with the outing and has now struck out 58 batters on the season.

Johnstone threw a three-hit complete game shutout in a 9-0 win at Miami on Sunday with five strikeouts and no walks. He retired 17 straight batters from the third inning through the eighth inning and improved to 4-0 on the mound this year. It was his second complete-game shutout of the season.
