Florida State head coach Sue Semrau and the Seminole women's basketball staff compiled one of the nation's top signing classes in the country this fall. FSU inked four high school stars in center Kai James, guard Brittany Brown and forwards Gabrielle Bevellard and Ivey Slaughter. The class is ranked No. 7 in the nation by All Star Girls Report, No. 11 by Blue Star Basketball and No. 12 by Collegiate Girls Report. FSU also will add three highly touted transfers next season in former McDonald's All-American and All-Big Ten wing Morgan Jones (Northwestern), point guard Emiah Bingly (Iowa State), who won Big 12 Newcomer of the Week earlier this season and 6-5 post Quaneisha McCurdy (Indiana). All three are currently practicing with the Noles.



GABRIELLE BEVELLARD • 6-3 • FORWARD • BISHOP, GA.

A 6-3 inside-outside forward, Gabrielle Bevellard is from Oconee County High School...Ranked the 33rd-best player in the country by National Basketball Insider and a three-star prospect by ESPN HoopGurlz...Was the first commitment to the Seminoles in this current signing class...Averaged 17 points, 12.2 rebounds and 5.0 blocks per game as a junior in 2011-12, leading Oconee to a 23-7 record and the Class AAA Georgia state tournament for the first time in over a dozen years...Had a double-double in 26 of 30 games...

Named the All-Northeast Georgia Girls Basketball Player of the Year by the Athens Banner-Herald...Captured Player of the Year for Region 8-AAA South and earned first-team All-Class AAA honors for the second consecutive year after earning honorable mention honors as a freshman...Has scored over 1,000 points in her career.



BRITTANY BROWN • 5-8 • GUARD • FORT WALTON BEACH, FLA.

Brittany Brown, a 5-8 combo guard, stars for Choctawhatchee High School and was a 2011-12 Florida Association of Coaches 6A All-State selection...Rated the fourth-best player in the state by National Basketball Insider...Was the first member of Florida State's 2013 Class to sign her National Letter of Intent...Averaged 23 points, seven assists, six rebounds and six steals a game as a junior, while leading her Choctaw squad to a 25-2 record...Two-time Northwest Florida Daily News Player of the Year...Rated the No. 64

prospect in the country by All Star Girls Report, No. 85 by ESPN HoopGurlz and No. 118 by Blue Star Basketball...Competes for the Miami Suns on the AAU circuit and is coached at Choctaw by her father, Don Brown.



KAI JAMES • 6-5 • CENTER • PALM BEACH GARDENS, FLA.

Kai James, a 6-5 center from Dwyer High School in Palm Beach Gardens, Fla., is ranked as the 22nd best player in the country, and the No. 3 center in the 2013 signing class by ESPN HoopGurlz...WBCA All-America Honorable Mention selection...McDonald's All-America nominee...Rated as the country's eighth-best player by National Basketball Insider, No. 12 by All Star Girls Report, No. 19 by Full Court and No. 23 by the Blue Star Basketball Report...Won a gold medal in August with Team USA at the FIBA Under-17 World

Championships in Amsterdam, making her international debut and averaging 2.9 points and 2.5 rebounds per game...Competes for the Miami Suns on the AAU circuit...Averaged 12.1 ppg, 13.4 rpg and 3.4 bpg as a junior in 2011-12, leading Dwyer to a 23-5 record...As a sophomore, she tallied 12.0 ppg, 15.8 rpg and 5.2 bpg as Dwyer went 22-7...She was a Florida Association of Basketball Coaches Class 8A All-State selection in 2011-12.



IVEY SLAUGHTER • 6-2 • FORWARD • MACON, GA.

Four-star forward Ivey Slaughter, a Macon, Ga., native, is ranked the No. 21 forward in the 2013 high school class and the No. 79 player overall by ESPN HoopsGurlz...Stars for Tattnall Square Academy where she scored at least 30 points four times as a junior and was named All-Region Class AAA...Rated the 69th best player in the country by the All-Star Girls Basketball Report and No. 86 nationally by National Basketball Insider...A star on the track as well, Slaughter finished third in the 100-meter dash and fourth in

the 400-meter dash at the Georgia Class AAA state track and field meet this past spring...As a sophomore at Crawford County High School, Slaughter was an honorable mention All-State selection by Georgia sportswriters.
