## NOTING ACC BASEBALL

Weekend conference series saw top-ranked Louisville sweep Boston College to remain the only unbeaten NCAA Division I team ... The Cardinals were also the only team to sweep their ACC weekend series ... No. 11 Clemson, No. 13 North Carolina, Virginia Tech, NC State, Notre Dame and Wake Forest were other series winners.

Five ACC teams are ranked this week, led by Louisville which holds the No. 1 spot in five of the six national polls. Clemson is ranked as high as No. 6 (Baseball America), the program's highest ranking since 2011. North Carolina, Florida State, and Virginia are also ranked this week.

Louisville (19-0) has posted the best start in program history and the second longest winning streak in school history behind only the 22 consecutive wins from 1956-58. The Cardinals have also won 35 straight regular season home games and 30 consecutive regular season weekend series at home.

In taking two of three versus No. 4 Florida State, Virginia Tech earned its third series win versus the Seminoles since 2010 ... It marked the Hokies' 11th overall series win over a ranked opponent as a member of the ACC ... The team's last series win over a ranked foe was in 2015, when Tech swept No. 1 Virginia in Blacksburg ... Virginia Tech nailed down the series in convincing fashion with a 17-0 win on Sunday as starting pitcher Nick Anderson held the Seminoles to just five hits and no runs over eight frames ... Anderson's eight innings pitched matched a career high ... The 17-0 win marked Virginia Tech's most runs scored in a shutout ever in an ACC game and the most since an 18-0 victory versus VMI on May 2, 2012 ... It was the Hokies' largest margin of victory in an ACC game and was only the eighth shutout recorded by Tech pitching against ACC competition since the school joined the league.

ACC Player of the Week Chris Williams hit .421 with three home runs, two doubles, 10 RBIs, three runs, two walks, a hit-by-pitch, 1.000 slugging percentage and .478 on-base percentage in leading Clemson to four wins in five games last week ... The junior from Garden Grove, California, had at least one hit in all five games, including each of the games against No. 15 Virginia ... He also caught all 45 innings behind the plate and did not allow a stolen base in one attempt during the week. On the season, he is hitting .350 with six runs, four doubles, three homers, 16 RBIs and a .413 on-base percentage in 13 games (10 starts).

Florida State's Quincy Nieporte hit two grand slams in the Virginia Tech series, giving him four for the season ... The four grand slams are the most in one season in FSU history, breaking a tie with J.D. Drew (1996), Jeremy Morris (1996), Dennis Guinn (2006), Buster Posey (2008) and Seth Miller (2012) ... Nieporte has five in his career, one shy of the career record of six by Drew and Morris ... Nieporte is also two grand slams shy of the season record of six set Kyle Bryan by of Alabama in 1984 (53 games).

North Carolina junior J.B. Bukauskas struck out a career-high 14 batters and improved to 3-0 on the year in Friday's series-opening win over Georgia Tech ... Bukauskas raised his ACC-leading strikeout total to 51 in 33 innings ... He has walked just seven batters on the season and ranks fourth among ACC regulars in ERA at 1.09.

Williams hit .421 with three home runs, two doubles, 10 RBIs, three runs, two walks, a hit-by-pitch, 1.000 slugging percentage and .478 on-base percentage in leading Clemson to four wins in five games last week. The junior from Garden Grove, California, had at least one hit in all five games, including each of the games against No. 15 Virginia.

McKay struck out 12 while scattering five singles and issuing one walk in seven shutout innings versus Boston College to move to 4-0 on the season. In his four starts on the mound this season, McKay has allowed just one earned run in 25.0 innings (0.36 ERA) with 41 strikeouts and only six walks.

Anderson scattered five hits and two walks over eight scoreless innings pitched in a 17-0 win over No. 4 Florida State to pick up his league-high tying fourth win of the season. It was a career-high tying 8.0 innings and he notched his team-leading fourth quality start.
