STARTING 9: WHAT TO KNOW

- Last time out: Florida State was 3-2 last week, beating No. 20 Florida Gulf Coast twice in Tallahassee before dropping two of three at NC State, Freshman **Drew Mendoza** was 6-for-12 at NC State with two doubles, his first career home run and three runs scored. He enters Tuesday's game with a five-game hitting streak.
- J.D. Drew jersey to be retired: Florida State announced that former outfielder J.D. Drew (1995-97) will have his No. 39 jersey retired prior to the game against Clemson on Saturday, April 15. He will join Dick Howser (No. 34) as the only Seminoles to have a jersey retired.
- Noles record second seven-run comeback win: On March 21, FSU trailed Jacksonville 7-0 before having an at-bat, and slowly chipped away at the JU lead until freshman J.C. Flowers' walk-off, two-run single with two outs in the ninth inning. Against Oakland (3/3), FSU also trailed 7-0 before winning 18-10.
- Walls leads country in walks: After notching seven walks in the final two games at Notre Dame, junior Taylor Walls leads the country with 37 on the season. As a team, the Seminoles have been walked 215 times, 11 more than the next closest school. Mercer.
- **Q** among nation's leaders: Senior first baseman/designated hitter Quincy Nieporte is 11th in the country with 41 RBI. He hit his third and fourth grand slams of the year at Virginia Tech, and he is now the single-season record holder for grand slams in a season at FSU. His four grand slams are the most in the country.
- Parrish shines at Notre Dame: On March 25, freshman Drew Parrish threw a complete game, three-hitter in Florida State's 5-1 win over Notre Dame. Only twice, in the 4th and 9th innings, did Parrish face more than one batter. and the Irish's lone run came on an error in the 4th inning. It is FSU's only complete game of the season.
- Noles on the basepaths: Florida State opened the season a perfect 27-for-27 in stolen bases and is currently 34-40 on the year. The Seminoles had the most stolen bases without being caught in the country. Dylan Busby leads the team with six stolen bases on the season.
- Martin active leader in wins: Head coach Mike Martin, now in his 38th year as head coach at Florida State, is the active wins leader with 1,919. He also is the all-time winningest coach by percentage, with a .737 mark. He needs iust 57 wins to pass Augie Garrido's all-time wins record (1.975).
- Holton among nation's best: Tyler Holton is the fourth FSU pitcher to earn three ACC Pitcher of the Week honors in one season after throwing seven innings of no-hit ball against No. 7 North Carolina. He was previously honored as the league's top pitcher after games against Samford (11 K) and Oakland (13 K).

11 GETS WIN NO. 1.900

- » Florida State head coach Mike Martin won the 1,900th game of his 38-year career in FSU's 11-3 win over VCU on February 19.
- » For perspective, if a head coach started coaching today and went 56-0 each season (the maximum number of regular season games a team can play under current NCAA rules), it would take almost 34 seasons for a coach to get 1,900 career wins.
- » Martin becomes just the second coach in NCAA history to reach 1,900 career wins and the first to do so at one program. In fact, Martin is just 9 games away from participating in his 3,000th FSU baseball game - 96 as a player (1965-66), 288 as assistant coach (1975-79) and 2,607 as head coach (1980-present).

HOLTON IN ELITE COMPANY

- fallahassee native Tyler Holton continues to show why he is one of the top pitchers in college baseball this season, with a 2.47 ERA and 4-1 record in eight starts.
- Holton is a three-time ACC Pitcher of the Week, joining Paul Wilson (1993 & 1994), Mike Ziegler (2000) and Sean Gilmartin (2011) as the only FSU pitchers to earn the award three times in one season.
- Holton was stellar against No. 8 North Carolina (4/1), pitching a no-hitter before being pulled after 109 pitches in the eighth inning. He walked only one batter, his final of the game, and struck out 8.
- Before the walk, all four baserunners that reached were via error, and each runner was stranded.
- Against Oakland (3/4), Holton struck out 13 batters in just six innings of work without allowing a walk. He set a career-high in strikeouts for the second consecutive week after having 11 against Samford (2/25).
- Holton also became the first Nole with 13 K since Luke Weaver had 14 against Troy in the 2013 NCAA Regionals. He is the first Seminole with consecutive games of 10+ K's since Sean Gilmartin in 2011.

- Freshman Drew Parrish allowed just three hits and one unearned run in Saturday's 5-1 win over Notre Dame (3/25), throwing the first complete game of his young
- The outing dropped Parrish's ERA from 5.16 to 3.69, and the Rockledge, Fla., native is 3-2 on the season.
- The complete game was the first for FSU this season, and the first since Drew Carlton threw a two-hit shutout at No. 1 Florida in last season's Super Regionals.
- Luke Weaver was the last FSU player with more than one complete game in a season, when he accomplished the feat against Wake Forest and Boston . College in 2014.
- Parrish is the first FSU freshman to throw a complete game since Sean Gilmartin had two in 2009.

 When FSU swept Notre Dame on March 24 and 25, it was the first three-game road sweep for Florida State since winning three times at Boston College in 2014.
- It was FSU's first time winning a game at Frank Eck Stadium after the Noles were swept in 2015. Notre Dame joined the ACC prior to the 2014 season.

WALLS NAMED ALL-AMERICAN

- » Taylor Walls, one of the top shortstops in the country, was named the 43rd first team All-American in school history after earning the honor by Baseball America.
- » The Cordele, Ga., native started all 63 games for Florida State in 2016 and became just the third first team All-American shortstop at FSU, joining Dick Howser (1957-58) and Stephen Cardullo (2009).
- Walls also earned third team marks from NCBWA and D1Baseball.com. Walls led FSU with 72 runs scored (No. 2 in the country) and had a .355 average on 88 hits.
- » Over the past summer, Walls played for the USA Collegiate National Team, leading the team with a .405 on-base percentage in 19 games.
- » To begin 2017, Walls has four doubles, two triples and three home runs. He ranks 25th nationally with 35 runs scored and leads the nation in walks with 37.
