HATTERS QUICK HITTERS

- ◆ Stetson will be looking to break an 11-game losing streak against Florida State when the teams meet in Tallahassee on Wednesday. The game was supposed to be the second in a two-game mid-week series, but the first game was cancelled because FSU was over-scheduled. The teams are scheduled to play again next week in DeLand.
- ◆ Hatters coach Steve Trimper is winless in five previous games against the Seminoles, all of which came during his tenure at the University of Maine. His Bears dropped a pair of games to the then fifth ranked Seminoles in 2011 and were swept in a three-game series against an eighth ranked FSU squad in 2012.
- ◆ Trimper enters play this week three wins shy of 500 for his career.
- ◆ The Hatters dropped both games against FSU last year, losing 8-5 and 8-6 in two games played in Tallahassee. The teams tried on two different dates to play in DeLand, but rain forced the cancellation of both games.
- ◆ Tonight's game will be the first for the Hatters against an unranked Florida State team since at least 1992.
- ◆ The Hatters enter this week ranked second in the nation in total strikeouts with 385. USF (387) held the national lead last week, due in part to the 14 strikeouts the Bulls posted against Stetson. Arkansas (384) is third, followed by UL Lafayette (378) and Oklahoma (377) in the top five. Stetson is fifth in strikeouts per nine innings, averaging 10.1 per game. USF leads the nation with 10.6 K/9.
- ◆ Stetson junior Brooks Wilson is currently second in the nation with 85 Ks so far this year. He trails the Citadel's J.P. Sears by two entering the week. Sophomore Logan Gilbert ranks seventh with 81 Ks and Jack Perkins is tied for 13th with 75.
- ◆ There is a total of 27 players across the nation with at least 70 strikeouts this year. No team other than Stetson has more than one pitcher with at least 70 strikeouts this year.
- ◆ Stetson has a record of 6-6 on the season when a Hatters player hits a home run. The Hatters are just 3-9 on the year when their opponents hit a home run.
- ◆ Senior Tyler Keller enters play this week two pitching appearances shy of 100 for his career, which would tie him for fifth in Stetson history with Joe Dye. Stetson's all-time career record for pitching appearances is 151 by Tom Hickox from 1988-91.
- ◆ The next strikeout recorded by junior Brooks Wilson will be the 200th of his career.
- ◆ Sophomore Kirk Sidwell has been the Hatters' hottest hitter over the last five games, batting .400 (6-for-15) with three RBI over that stretch. As a team, the Hatters have hit .267 over the last three games in going 2-3.
- ◆ Stetson freshman left-hander Austin Bogart is coming off one of his better outings of the year on the mound. He pitched three innings against USF last week, allowing one run on two hits with a season-high six strikeouts. In his

HATTERS QUICK HITTERS

- ◆ four starts this year, Bogart has posted an 8.73 ERA with eight walks and 12 strikeouts over 11.3 innings of work.
- ◆ Bogart's mound opponent, Will Zirzow, has never faced the Hatters in his two prior seasons at FSU.
- ◆ Walks will play a huge role in tonight's game. Hatters pitchers have allowed 156 walks this year, 4.08 per 9 IP, while FSU hitters have drawn 232 free passes, which ranks second in the nation behind Mercer (237).
- ◆ Stetson's weekend starting pitchers allowed 11 earned runs in 18 innings of work for a 5.50 ERA in the series against Kennesaw State. The bullpen stepped up in the series, allowing four ER in 9 IP. Walks were the problem as the Hatters issued 20 in the series while KSU pitchers allowed just four.
- ◆ The Hatters' loss last Tuesday night was the second this year in which Stetson took a lead to the ninth inning but was unable to close out the victory. The Hatters had a 6-2 lead over the Bulls going to the seventh inning but allowed a run in the seventh, two in the eighth and three in the ninth to lose 8-6.
- ◆ Sophomore Kirk Sidwell added his name to the four-hit club in the USF game last week. He is the fourth different player to have a four-hit game this year. As a team, the Hatters have equalled the total number of four-hit games from 2016 with five.
- ◆ Stetson has not had a player with five hits in a game since Cory Reid did it against LIU Brooklyn on March 20, 2015.
- ◆ In the series against FGCU, the Hatters and Eagles put on quite an impressive pitching display. There were a total of 10 runs scored during the weekend, five by each team. Stetson pitchers combined for 39 strikeouts in the series, including 18 by sophomore Logan Gilbert in Sunday's dramatic 1-0 Stetson win.
- ◆ Gilbert started his outing against FGCU by striking out the first 10 batters he faced. While no records exist on consecutive strikeouts, there are only a few such streaks known about. Navy's Luke Gillingham posted 12 consecutive Ks against North Carolina A&T on opening day, 2015, Bethune-Cookman's Ali Simpson struck out the first 10 against Alabama A&M on Feb. 19, 2011, and Wake Forest had a pitcher named Cuthrell who struck out 13 straight against West Virginia in April of 1914. Jared Weaver also had 10 straight Ks to open a game twice for Long Beach State in 2004, against BYU and USC.
- ◆ Gilbert's 18 total strikeouts are the second most in a game by any pitcher in Division I this year. J.P. Sears had 20 strikeouts against VMI in a game in March. The performance also left him one strikeout shy of the school record, which was set by George Tsamis against Bethune-Cookman in 1986.
- ◆ According to ASUN archives, it was the most strikeouts in a game for a league hurler since at least the 2000 season. There were two previous 17 strikeout performances - Dan Jackson of Florida Atlantic vs. Samford on March 31, 2000, and Tim Bascom of UCF vs. Siena on March 5, 2005.
- ◆ Gilbert retired the first 23 batters in the game before hitting a batter with two out in the eighth. He lost his no-hit bid to open the ninth inning and finished by allowing two hits in the complete-game shutout.
- ◆ For his performance, Gilbert was named the ASUN pitcher of the week and was also recognized by Collegiate Baseball, Baseball America, Perfect Game and College Sports Madness.

- ◆ Gilbert will take an amazing streak into his start at USC Upstate this weekend. He has struck out the side in the first inning in each of his last four starts.
- ◆ The shutout against FGCU was the fourth for the Stetson pitching staff this season, which is tied for 23rd in the nation. Oregon State and UL Lafayette have eight shutouts on the year.
- ◆ In addition to not getting a deserved win on their ledger last Tuesday against Florida, the Hatters also lost plenty of individual stats with the cancellation of the game. When the game was stopped, all nine members of the starting lineup had at least one hit. Sophomore Jack Gonzalez had three hits, including a pair of doubles, and junior Austin Hale had two hits, including his first home run of the year, scored three runs and drove in three. As a team, the Hatters had a season-high six doubles, with freshman Jorge Arenas also picking up two.
- ◆ Stetson opened ASUN play with a three-game sweep of NJIT. It was the first series sweep for the Hatters since taking three games from the Highlanders in Newark, NJ, last year.
- ◆ After the series with FGCU, Stetson is now 2-3 on the season in extra-inning games and 5-6 in one-run games. The most one-run games in any of the previous 10 years was 17 in 2013, with an 11-6 mark in those games.
- ◆ Since the 2002 season, the Hatters have an overall record of 27-25 in extra-inning games. The most extra-inning games for Stetson during that time was five in 2011.
- ◆ Freshman Jorge Arenas added his name to the list of Hatters with four hits in a game when he capped his four-hit performance in the opener against NJIT with his first career home run. Arenas, Jacob Koos (twice), Ben Rowdon and Kirk Sidwell all have four-hit games.
- ◆ Another sophomore, DH Jack Gonzalez, had a career day in the series opener against NJIT, driving in six runs in going 3-for-3 at the plate. The nine runs he drove home in four games last week was one more than he had produced in the previous 26 games this year.
- ◆ Freshman catcher Chris Tidwell has seen very few at bats since Austin Hale returned from injury but, when he got his chance in the opener against NJIT, he took advantage, ripping a triple on the first pitch he saw.
- ◆ Stetson sophomore RHP Jack Perkins earned his first career ASUN Pitcher of the Week award for his performance against Tulane. Perkins went the distance in the Hatters' 5-1 win and struck out a career-high 13. He faced just four batters over the minimum in the game and retired the final seven Green Wave hitters in order, including the last two on strikes. Perkins is the first Stetson player to be honored as Pitcher of the Week since Brooks Wilson shared the award with Chris Erwin of Kennesaw State last April 4.
- ◆ The Hatters posted a season high 13 runs in taking the first game of the series from NJIT. The last time the Hatters scored as many as 13 runs in a game was May 25 of last year in the opening game of the ASUN Championship in a 13-7 win over Kennesaw State.
- ◆ In scoring 12 runs in the finale at Tulane, the Hatters had a seven-run first inning. It was the most runs in an inning for the Hatters since an eight-run fourth inning at NJIT on May 8 of last season. It was the most runs in the first inning of a game for Stetson since May 14, 2009, when the Hatters scored seven in the first inning of a 22-8 win over JU.

HATTERS QUICK HITERS

- ◆ The Hatters broke out of their offensive slump in the first game against Florida. Not only did Stetson have a season high 20 hits in that game, it was the most hits in a game for the Hatters since a 29-hit performance against USC Upstate on May 16, 2014.
- ◆ In the game and a half the Hatters played against Florida this year Stetson had a total of 34 hits.
- ◆ The Stetson hitters were not the only ones to shine in the first game against Florida. The Hatters' six pitchers combined to record a season high 16 strikeouts, the most since a 17 K game against Central Michigan on Feb. 21, 2015.
- ◆ The Hatters are still looking for their first bunt hit of the year. Stetson is 0-for-18 on bunts, but does have 26 successful sacrifice bunts.
- ◆ Sophomore Joey Gonzalez made just his second career start in the first game against Florida and posted career-bests for both innings pitched (4.2) and strikeouts (8). He shut Florida out for most of his outing before giving up four runs while trying to record the final out in the fifth inning.
- ◆ During the series against Fairfield the Hatters were shutout for the third time this year. Stetson suffered just one shutout loss during the 2016 season after getting shutout three times in 2015. The program record for shutout losses in a season is six, which has been done several times, most recently in 1988.
- ◆ The Hatters have posted four shutout wins this season after having just one such win last year. The most shutouts for the Hatters in a single season is eight, which was accomplished in 1972 and again in 1974.
- ◆ Since the end of World War II, the Hatters have played 362 games that have ended in a shutout, winning 206 of those contests.
- ◆ So far this year the Hatters have an 11-14 record in games at Melching Field. The Hatters are 9-6 overall this year in day games but just 6-13 at night.
- ◆ In the three games at Tulane, the Hatters pitchers combined to issue just six free passes. They allowed seven to USF in the first meeting, but just six to NJIT in three games and seven to FGCU.
- ◆ In the series at The Citadel the Hatters used just five pitchers over the three games. Junior Brooks Wilson went the distance on Friday, while sophomore starter Jack Perkins went eight innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts in the opening game on Saturday. Mitchell Senger pitched the final inning in that game. Logan Gilbert and Ryan Stark combined for the second game Saturday, with Stark earning his first career save.
- ◆ The 18 runners left on base by the Hatters in the first game against Seton Hall was the second most in program history. The only time a Stetson team left more runners on base in a game was against Campbell on March 21, 2008. The Hatters left 19 runners on in that game, a 6-5 loss to the Camels in 11 innings.
- ◆ Stetson senior Tyler Keller established a new career-high by pitching four innings against Seton Hall. The left-hander threw a total of 78 pitches, allowing one run on four hits with three strikeouts and two walks.
- ◆ The loss to Connecticut was a tough one for the Hatters. Not only did Stetson set a new program record for most strikeouts in a game (20), the Hatters also committed four errors in the 9-3 loss. The old record for strikeouts in a game was 19, set in 2008 in a 12-inning game against

Florida Gulf Coast.

- ◆ Late inning woes have been especially costly to the Hatters this year. Stetson has allowed a total of 57 runs in the eighth, ninth and extra innings this year. On the flip side, the Hatters have scored just 26 runs in those late innings.
- ◆ The loss to Bethune-Cookman broke a streak of 97 consecutive wins for the Hatters in games in which they had taken a lead to the ninth inning. The last time Stetson lost when leading after eight innings was March 23, 2013, when Mercer scored four times in the top of the ninth to take a 7-4 victory.
- ◆ The Hatters were 27-0 in 2016 when leading after eight innings, 25-0 in 2015 and 23-0 in 2014.
- ◆ The 2017 season marks the 100th in Stetson Baseball history. The program played its first game in 1901 and played games each year through 1917 before taking off 1918 during World War I. The program resumed in 1919 but played just seven seasons before the program went dormant from 1926-36. After returning in 1937, the program was again interrupted from 1941-45 by World War II. Since resuming in 1946, the Hatters have played each of the last 71 seasons.
- ◆ The 2017 Stetson baseball season is also a historic one for another reason. For the first time since 1979, someone other than Pete Dunn made out the Hatters' lineup card on opening day. New coach Steve Trimper is no stranger to Melching Field, having coached against the Hatters in 2005, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 16. Trimper posted a 4-7 record against Dunn and the Hatters and he now stands just 12 wins shy of 500 in his career.
- ◆ Historically speaking, coaching changes have been extremely rare for Stetson baseball. Since the program was restarted in 1937 there have been just six men in charge of the program. That list includes Carl H. "Doc" Johnson from 1937 to 1940, 1946 and from 1951-64; Ben Clemmons from 1947-50; Bob Weickel from 1965-68; Jim Ward from 1969-79 and Dunn from 1980 until 2016.
- ◆ Stetson posted win No. 1 of the Trimper era on Feb. 21 thanks largely to freshmen. Starting pitcher Ryan Stark worked into the eighth inning without allowing a run to earn the win while Andrew MacNeil had two hits and drove in four runs. Freshmen combined for five hits, six runs and six RBI in the game.
- ◆ Junior Austin Hale was the only Stetson player selected to the preseason All-ASUN team for 2017. Hale is also a candidate for the prestigious Johnny Bench Award as the top catcher in the nation.
- ◆ Senior Colton Lightner and juniors Austin Hale and Brooks Wilson serve in the role of team captains this spring.
- ◆ The Hatters had three players selected in the 2016 MLB Amateur Draft, including a pair of juniors. Senior closer Walker Sheller was selected in the 9th round by the Kansas City Royals while junior starting pitcher Mitchell Jordan was taken in the 10th round by Oakland and junior outfielder Vance Vizcaino was picked in the 11th round, also by Kansas City.
- ◆ Stetson also had a pair of signees who were selected in the draft last spring. Kole Enright, a third baseman, was selected in the third round and signed with the Texas Rangers while first baseman/catcher Luke Van Rycheghem was selected in the 23rd round by Arizona and signed.

HEAD COACH STEVE TRIMPER

Stetson University Director of Athletics Jeff Altier introduced Steve Trimper as the 23rd head baseball coach in the history of the Hatters baseball program on December 21, 2016, at a news conference in the Hall of Fame room at the Edmunds Center.

Trimper, a native of Newton, New Jersey, has agreed to a four-year contract to coach the Hatters. Terms of the contract will not be disclosed. He will begin his duties with the Hatters on January 2, 2017, and will make his coaching debut in Stetson green on February 17 against Southern Illinois.

Trimper completed 11 seasons as head coach at the University of Maine where he compiled a 309-292-2 overall record, including a 140-115 mark in America East Conference play. He took his team to the conference tournament nine times, winning the event to advance into NCAA Regional play in 2006 and 2011.

In 2013, Trimper was named America East Coach of the Year after leading the Black Bears to a mark of 37-22 overall, 20-9 in America East conference play. Maine was the top seed in the 2013 America East Tournament before falling in the title game to Binghamton.

During the 2012 season Trimper's Maine team put together a 14-game win streak and advanced to the title game of the America East Tournament before falling to Stony Brook. That Stony Brook team advanced all the way to the College World Series in Omaha.

During his career, Trimper has coached 18 players who were selected in the MLB draft – nine during his time at Maine and nine while coaching at Manhattan. In addition, he has coached 10 freshman All-Americans

Trimper has spoken at numerous national conventions in recent years. He addressed the 2005 ABCA National Convention in Nashville, Tenn., and the 2013 convention in Chicago. He has also served as a clinician at numerous conventions, including the Ohio State baseball coaching convention and the World Baseball convention in Connecticut.

Trimper has served as the Northeast Chair of the American Baseball Coaches Association.

In 2011, Trimper's Black Bears posted a 33-24 record, which included an 18-6 mark in league play. Maine raced through the America East Tournament, defeating Albany in the title game 10-1 to earn an NCAA Regional bid. Maine traveled to North Carolina for the NCAA Regionals, where the Bears earned a victory over #20 Florida International.

The Black Bears won 14 of their last 15 games of the regular season in 2011, including a stretch of 11 consecutive wins. The win over FIU marked the first NCAA Regional win for Maine since the 2005 postseason. Early in that 2011 season, the Black Bears recorded a 5-3 victory over North Carolina, ranked 11th in the nation at the time.

In his first season at Maine, Trimper led the Black Bears to their second straight America East Tournament Championship with a 5-3 victory over Stony Brook in the title game. Maine advanced to the Chapel Hill Regional of the NCAA Tournament where they fell to sixth-ranked North Carolina, a team that finished as NCAA Runners up,



despite holding leads of 4-1 and 6-4 in the game.

Prior to his time at Maine, Trimper served as head coach at Manhattan College for seven years (1999-2005), leading the Jaspers to the MAAC Tournament in each of his last three years. While at Manhattan, Trimper led the Jaspers to 20 or more wins in each of his seasons, including a school-record 32 wins during the 2002 season which earned him MAAC Coach of the Year honors.

In 2005, the Jaspers finished 27-21 and 15-8 in MAAC play. The team earned a berth in the 2005 MAAC Tournament for the third year in a row. In 2004, the Jaspers advanced to the championship round of the MAAC Baseball Tournament for the first time in program history.

Trimper compiled a record of 172-174-2 in his seven seasons at Manhattan. He ranks second on the all-time wins list and posted a record of 93-83 in MAAC play.

Prior to his time at Manhattan, Trimper served as an assistant coach at the University of Vermont (1994-98), where he helped lead the Catamounts to three America East Conference Tournament appearances while posting a record of 92-79 over four seasons.

Trimper served as the associate head coach at Wentworth College in Boston (1992-94) and also served as head coach of the Eastern Tide of the New England Collegiate Baseball League in the summers of 1996 and 1997.

Trimper is a 1992 graduate of Eastern Connecticut State University with a degree in physical education. He played baseball for three years and was a member of the Warriors' 1990 NCAA Division III National Championship team under legendary coach Bill Holowaty. He transferred to ECSU after one year at Elon College, which reached the NAIA national tournament and finished 36-9 in his lone season there. Trimper earned his master's degree in administration from Vermont in 1997.

Trimper and his wife, Lisa, have twin daughters, Ally and Morgan (16), who are sophomores at the Taft School in Connecticut where they play ice hockey.

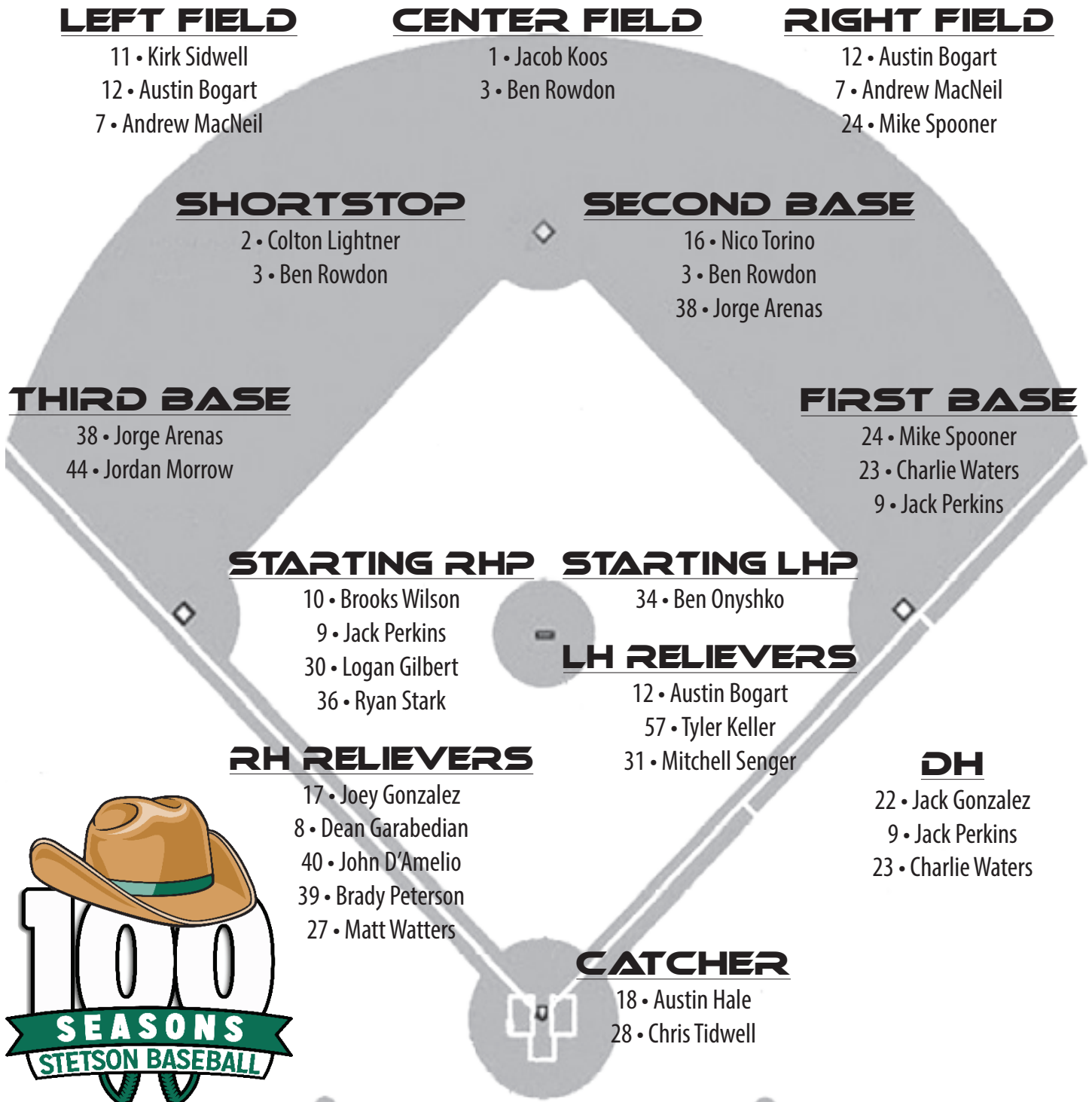
