NOTING ACC BASEBALL

The final full weekend of nonconference play for Atlantic Coast Conference baseball teams is a packed one with 49 games on the schedule. The slate includes Clemson's series with rival South Carolina, and both Notre Dame and NC State participating in the USA Baseball-Irish Classic at Cary, North Carolina ... Clemson and South Carolina, as has been their custom in recent years, will play each game of their three-game series at a different site. Clemson plays host to the Gamecocks on Friday night, and the teams will meet in Greenville, South Carolina, on Saturday afternoon. The series concludes at Columbia on Sunday.

Two ACC teams – Louisville and Virginia – remain among the nation's unbeaten and will carry 8-0 records into the weekend. The Cardinals are home for a three-game series versus Eastern Michigan, while Virginia welcomes La Salle and Niagara to Charlottesville for a rotating series of four games ... Nine ACC teams remain ranked in at least one major poll, with Florida State as high as No. 2 by Baseball America. The Seminoles, who are ranked among the nation's top five in four other polls, are set for a three-game series versus Oakland in Tallahassee ... ACC teams are 76-35 (.685) in nonconference games played thus far.

Following a season-opening trip to Houston, Wake Forest was hitting just .194 as a team and had only three players hitting better than .215. In the five games since, the Demon Deacons are hitting .394 as a team, with 30 extra-base hits. Six regulars are hitting .350 or better in that span, and eight are above .310, as the Deacs have averaged 14.0 runs per game ... that surge has increased the team average to .314. Every starter is hitting better than .240, with seven hitting above .285.

Boston College returns to the Snowbird Classic in Port Charles, Florida, for the fourth straight year ... Under seventh-year head coach Mike Gambino, BC is 11-4 in the tournament ... Friday starter sophomore RHP Jacob Stevens has not allowed an unearned run in the first 13 innings he has thrown this season, striking out 15, walking just four and giving up only six hits. Batters are hitting just .111 against him. He tied a career high with a seven-inning out against Northern Illinois last week, striking out six.

Since the start of the 2015 season, Miami is a whopping 72-12 in its last 84 home games, including its 2017 Opening Weekend series against Rutgers ... Miami finished 36-5 at home in 2015 and 34-6 at home in 2016. The Hurricanes went 13-2 in ACC play at The Light in 2015 and 12-3 at home in ACC play in 2016. Miami will play host to Dartmouth in a three-game series this weekend.

Pitt looks to build on its hot start as the Panthers head to Spartanburg, South Carolina, to face Wofford, USC Upstate, and Wright State. Pitt is on a five-game winning streak and has outscored opponents 45-22. Last weekend alone, the Panthers scored 25 runs in three games versus Siena. The pitching has also been solid, ranking second in the ACC with a 2.29 team ERA. In 63.0 innings, Pitt hurlers have struck out 58 batters, holding opponents to a .214 average.

ACC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Sheets had a monster week at the plate for the Demon Deacons, tallying 16 RBIs, 10 hits, three home runs, two doubles, three walks, and nine runs scored to lead Wake Forest to a midweek win over UNC Greensboro and a series victory over USC. The junior from Baltimore, Maryland, tied program records with three home runs and nine RBIs in the series-opening win over USC on Friday. Sheets hit .588 on the week, and posted a slugging percentage of 1.235 and an on-base percentage of .619.

Holton set a career-high with 11 strikeouts and tied a career-high with 7.0 innings pitched in a 8-0 win over Samford. The sophomore from Tallahassee, Florida, allowed just two hits and three walks on the day. In two starts this season, Holton has a 0.69 ERA in 13 innings pitched with 19 strikeouts and five hits allowed.

In just his second career start, Dalatri struck out 15 batters with no walks in a 7-5 win over Radford. The freshman from Wall Township, New Jersey, threw just 99 pitches with 75 strikes, and went to a 3-ball count just one time in 28 batters. The 15 strikeouts are the most by a Tar Heel pitcher since Matt Harvey struck out 15 at Clemson in 2010, and are the most for a North Carolina freshman under Mike Fox (since 1999).
