UPDATED CWS NOTES: NOLES LOOK TO EXTEND SEASON

- FSU fell to LSU, 5-4, in Game 2 of the 2017 College World Series Saturday night in front of 25,305 at TD Ameritrade Park. In its 22nd appearance, FSU fell to 28-43 all-time in the College World Series.

- Junior Dylan Busby, selected in the 3rd Round of the MLB Draft by the Pittsburgh Pirates, hit a two-run home run in the first inning, his 15th HR of the year. The home run was Busby's 38th of his career, most among active players in the ACC. Busby's home run was the second in TD Ameritrade Park history (309 games) to reach the center field gap between the seats. As a team, FSU has hit 73 home runs this year, most for FSU since hitting 86 in 2010.

- Tyler Holton was named a first team All-American by D1Baseball.com and the ABCA, FSU's 44th first team All-American. Holton struck out five LSU hitters in the opener, pushing his season total to 144. Entering Sunday's games, Holton's 144 strikeouts are the most in the country and the most for a Seminole since Mike Ziegler had 149 in 2000 (eighth-most in school history). Holton allowed a season-high eight hits against LSU.

- As a team, FSU has struck out 624 batters on the season, the most in the country. FSU's 624 strikeouts are the ninth-most in school history and most since having 631 in 2000.

- In 12 games in the postseason (ACC and NCAA Tournament), FSU has a 1.86 team ERA, 133 strikeouts and 25 walks.

- Junior Taylor Walls, selected in the 3rd Round of the MLB Draft by the Tampa Bay Rays, reached base safely in four of five plate appearances against LSU, including each of the first three. With three walks against the Tigers, Walls leads the country with 66. Walls also ranks second in runs scored with 81 after scoring three times against LSU. Before grounding out in the seventh inning, Walls had successfully reached base 14 straight plate appearances, dating back to the first game of the Super Regional against Sam Houston State. That set a new school record, topping Paul Sorrento's 13 in 1985. Walls' three walks give him 177 for his career, tied for fourth-most in FSU history with Tyler Holt and Jeff Ledbetter.

- Catcher Cal Raleigh has started 117 consecutive games at catcher for the Seminoles and is the only Nole to play in all 67 games this season.

- Quincy Nieporte was 1-for-3 against LSU on Saturday, including an RBI single in the fifth inning. Nieporte has 79 runs batted in on the season, most for FSU since Buster Posey had 93 in 2008. Nieporte ranks fourth nationally in RBI, five behind national leader Gavin Sheets of Wake Forest. Nieporte has a team-high eight game hitting streak and extended his career-high reached base streak to 18 games.

- With five walks drawn against the Tigers, FSU extended its season total to 385, most in the country. Over the past eight years, FSU has ranked first in walks six times; third one time (2013); and sixth one time (2016).

- Alec Byrd and Drew Carlton both made their team-high 34th appearances of the season against LSU. For Byrd, it was his 99th career appearance, the ninth most in FSU history.
