NC STATE WELCOMES #22 FLORIDA STATE FOR WEEKEND SERIES

The NC State baseball team will welcome the 22nd-ranked Florida State Seminoles to campus this weekend for a three-game series. Friday and Saturday's games are set for 6:30 p.m. and Sunday's first pitch is 1 p.m. at Doak Field at Dail Park.

All three games of the series will be broadcast live on the ACC Network Extra, as well as radio coverage on WKNC 88.1 FM and on GoPack.com for premium subscribers.

NC State enters the weekend with a 16-14 overall record and a 5-7 mark in Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) play. Florida State heads into the series with a 20-11 record in 2017 to go along with a 6-6 clip against league opponents.

Last Time Out

In its most recent outing, the Wolfpack collected a season-high 18 hits to earn a 13-1 win against UNC Asheville at home on Tuesday.

Florida State also won its last outing, collecting a 3-2 victory against No. 20 Florida Gulf Coast in a rain-shortened contest at home on Wednesday afternoon.

LAST TIME VERSUS FLORIDA STATE

NC State and Florida State last met in the first game of the 2016 ACC Championship for both teams, as the Seminoles earned a 7-3 win at the Durham Bulls Athletic Park (DBAP). The Wolfpack led early in the contest, but the 'Noles pulled away late with four runs in the bottom of the eighth.

Last year's regular-season series was altered due to weather, as the teams were only able to play one game, which FSU won 8-5 in Tallahassee.

LAST TIME FLORIDA STATE VISITED RALEIGH

Florida State last visited Doak Field in 2015 when NC State won the series finale, 11-7, after dropping one-run games on Friday and Saturday. Joe O'Donnell earned the win for the Wolfpack with 2.2 innings of relief.

SCOUTING FLORIDA STATE

Florida State heads to Raleigh with a 7-4 record in road games, including a 4-2 mark in away games in ACC play. The Seminoles won both of their midweek games at home against Florida Gulf Coast earlier this week.

FSU's two wins against the Eagles snapped a four-game losing streak, as the Seminoles were swept at home in their last conference series.

Florida State owns a team batting average of .259, while opponents have been hitting at a .234 clip. Rhett Aplin leads the squad at the plate with a .320 average to go along with a team-best 33 hits.

The Seminoles average 8.52 hits per game and are scoring 7.29 runs per game. On the mound, Florida State's pitchers have compiled the fourth-best earned run average (ERA) in the conference with a 3.44 mark.

AVENT APPROACHING 1,000 CAREER WINS

NC State head coach Elliott Avent is approaching 1,000 career wins, as he heads into the weekend with 995 to his credit. He would become the fifth active head coach in the ACC with 1,000 or more career wins.

Additionally, Avent would join an elite group as only 15 active Division I head coaches have reached 1,000 career wins.

#PACKPAIR

The Wolfpack has turned 33 double plays this year, the second most in the ACC and seventh-best in the NCAA. NC State has turned a double play in 22 of 30 games, highlighted by a season-high four double plays at UNCG.

DUNAND GOES YARD

Junior Joe Dunand leads the team and is tied for third in the conference with 10 home runs. The Miami, Fla., native has logged 103 at-bats in 2017 to average a homer every 10.3 at-bats.

His 10 home runs this season are a career-high, as he notched seven as a freshman and four as a sophomore to own 21 long balls for his career, fifth most among active players in the ACC.

JOHNNY ON THE SPOT

Redshirt senior Johnny Piedmonte made his first start of the season for NC State in Tuesday night's game and delivered a strong performance to earn the win. He allowed just two hits and one earned run to go along with four strikeouts in five innings pitched.

HITTING STRIDE

The Wolfpack collected a season-high 18 hits in Tuesday's win against UNC Asheville. NC State batters tallied at least one hit in seven of the eight innings, as the Pack did not bat in the bottom of the ninth.

Also, each batter in the NC State lineup that recorded a hit had more than one. Seven players logged multi-hit performances.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

The Wolfpack has hit 67 doubles as a team in 2017, tied for the third most in the conference behind Georgia Tech with 72 and Duke with 71.

In addition, junior Josh McLain is tied for the ACC lead with 15 doubles this season.

FIRST TO SCORE

The Wolfpack is 12-3 when scoring the first run of a game this season.

THE MORE, THE BETTER

NC State has recorded more hits than its opponent in 12 games this year and has won all 12 contests. Additionally, the Wolfpack is 3-4 when hits are tied and 1-10 when the opponent tallies more hits.

DUNAND TIMES TWO

Junior Joe Dunand tallied his first multi-home run game in NC State's 15-run outburst at Charlotte last Tuesday night. He hit a solo home run in the fourth inning and launched a two-run blast in his next at-bat in the fifth inning.

It was also the first multi-homer game of the year for a Wolfpack player.

CAREER BEST FOR DEBO

Brad Debo, a freshman from Durham, N.C., recorded a career-best six RBI against the Charlotte 49ers. His six runs batted in are the most by a freshman in the ACC this season.

He hit a sacrifice fly in the first inning, a bases-clearing double in the fourth and a two-run homer in the fifth.

SEVEN-RUN FOURTH

NC State scored seven runs in the fourth inning at Charlotte last Tuesday, sending 11 batters to the plate in the frame. It was the most runs the Wolfpack has scored

HERE COMES STALEY

NC State reliever Austin Staley has made a team-high 15 appearances this season, which is tied for eighth in the ACC.

LUCKY SIX

NC State has scored 29 runs in the sixth inning this season, the most in any inning this year. Also, the Wolfpack is 12-3 when scoring at least six runs in a game.

Additionally, NC State is 15-3 when limiting opponents to fewer than six runs.

DON'T RUN ON THE PACK

NC State outfielders have collected six assists this season on plays at the plate when the runner is trying to score from second base on a hit or tag and score from third base on a fly ball. Right fielder Brock Deatherage leads the group with three assists, while Brett Kinneman has also thrown out two runners at the plate.

Jack Conley, who made his first career start in left field last Sunday, joined the group by throwing out a runner at the plate in the series finale against Louisville.

Additionally, Tommy DeJuneas threw out a runner at second base against Western Carolina, after the runner made a wide turn around second and the throw came in behind the runner for the out.

GRAND SLAM FOR THE WOLFPACK

NC State batters have hit two grand slams this season, as Joe Dunand was responsible for the latest against George Mason on March 15.

FIRST GRAND SLAM

With NC State trailing Wake Forest, 5-1 and the bases loaded, freshman Will Wilson stepped to the plate and crushed the first pitch of his at-bat over the left field wall for a grand slam to tie the score at five.

It was the freshman's first collegiate grand slam and also the first grand slam of the season for the Wolfpack.

11 FOR THE FRESHMAN

Wilson's grand slam actually helped to extend his hitting streak to 11 games, the longest of the season for an NC State player, but it came to an end in the following game against Elon as he was 0-for-5.

POWER TRIP

NC State hit a season-high three home runs in the Wolfpack's 8-5 win at UNCW and NCSU's 15-10 win against Charlotte at the Charlotte Knights Ballpark

FIRST COLLEGIATE HOME RUNS

Wolfpack freshmen Brad Debo and Will Wilson each hit their first collegiate homers against UNCW. Debo hit a solo home run to center field, while Wilson hit a two-run blast over the left field fence.

BACK-TO-BACK JACKS

NC State hit consecutive home runs for the first time this season when Brad Debo and Evan Mendoza hit back-to-back homers in the third inning at UNCW.

SNAPPED AT 10

Wolfpack junior shortstop Joe Dunand extended his hitting streak to 10 games with a single in the third inning against Western Carolina. The streak started against Hawai'i in the series finale and Dunand kept it rolling until it came to a close in game one at Wake Forest.

DEATHERAGE IN CENTER FIELD

Junior Brock Deatherage made his first start of the season in center field against Western Carolina and made an excellent defensive play to earn a spot on the SportsCenter top 10 plays. His diving grab checked in at No. 7 on the list.

It was his fourth collegiate start in center field, as he started two games at the position a season ago and one in his freshman campaign.

LATE SURGE

In the eighth inning this season, the Wolfpack has plated 22 runs, the second most in an inning for the squad.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

Freshman Brad Debo is second on NC State with 10 multi-hit games and classmate Will Wilson paces the group with six multi-RBI games.

FIRST COLLEGIATE WIN

Wolfpack freshman Dalton Feeney recorded his first collegiate win against UNCG Tuesday, as he threw 1.2 innings of shutout relief.

FIRST COLLEGIATE START

Freshman Mathieu Gauthier made his first collegiate start against Charlotte on Wednesday. The Canadian pitched 4.2 innings pitched, allowing one earned run with five strikeouts in a no decision.

He earned his first collegiate win in Saturday's game against Austin Peay.

TURN TWO

NC State turned four double plays in its 8-2 victory against UNCG and all of them were inning-ending double plays.

DeatheRAGE

Junior Brock Deatherage turned in the Pack's first four-hit performance of the season with a perfect 4-for-4 performance in NC State's home opener with Austin Peay on Feb. 24, 2017. The Burlington, N.C., native tallied a pair of doubles, a home run and a single to finish a triple shy of the cycle.

ADLER STRONG

Senior left-handed pitcher Sean Adler earned the opening day start for NC State and delivered a strong performance to earn his first win as a starting pitcher and third win in a Wolfpack uniform.

The Northridge, Calif., native threw five innings, allowing just four hits (All singles) with a walk and strikeout.

He also started NC State's home opener against Austin Peay and recorded a career-best 10 strikeouts en route to earning the win with 5.1 innings pitched.

STELLAR DEBUT FOR WILSON

Will Wilson, a freshman from Kings Mountain, N.C., had a stellar debut for the Pack, as he accounted for all four of NC State's runs on opening day (3 RBI, 1 run scored). He drove in the first run of the season with an RBI double down the left field line in his first collegiate at-bat.

KINNEMAN PICKING UP WHERE HE LEFT OFF

A Freshman All-America Selection in 2016, Brett Kinneman picked up where he left off at the end of last season. He finished opening weekend with a team-best .500 batting average to go along with six hits, including four doubles.

He also hit the Wolfpack's first home run of the season in game two of the series with Hawai'l in a very pitcher friendly ballpark. After opening weekend, his four doubles tied for the ACC lead.

SIX IN A ROW

Brett Kinneman started the season with a hit in each of NC State's first six games, but saw his streak come to an end with an 0-for-5 performance at UNCG.

BACK-TO-BACK

Junior shortstop Joe Dunand homered in game two and game three of the series against Austin Peay, the first and only NC State player to homer in consecutive games this season.

DEJUNEAS' FIRST START

Junior righty Tommy DeJuneas made his first career start on the mound against Hawai'i on Sunday, Feb. 19 and delivered a strong outing to earn the win on 5.2 innings pitched, allowing just one hit.

A TRIP OF FIRSTS

NC State and Hawai'i met for the first time in the history of the programs on opening weekend. Additionally, the trip to Honolulu served as the first trip to Hawai'i for everyone on the 2017 Wolfpack baseball squad, except Sean Adler and Michael Bienlien.

Adler had been to Maui, but never to Honolulu while Bienlien was born in Hawaii and lived there until he was six.

<u>DUNAND NAMED TO GOLDEN SPIKES AWARD PRESEASON WATCH LIST</u>

NC State junior Joe Dunand has been tabbed to the 2017 Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List, announced Feb. 15 by USA Baseball. The Wolfpack infielder is one of 13 representatives from the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) on the list.

Dunand, a native of Miami, Fla., compiled a .297 batting average last season, highlighted by 70 hits with 18 doubles. The Wolfpack shortstop started 58 games in 2016, recording a teamhigh 181 assists to go along with 118 putouts.

He collected 41 RBIs, scored 35 runs and hit four home runs. Dunand put together a nine-game hitting streak at the beginning of the 2016 season and ended the year on an eight-game hitting streak. Additionally, he had 21 multi-hit games, tied for third most on the team and second most among returners for this season.

NC STATE TO PLAY BOSTON COLLEGE IN ALS AWARENESS GAME AT FENWAY PARK

The NC State baseball team will play Boston College in the Sixth Annual ALS Awareness Game at Fenway Park on Saturday, April 22, announced Wednesday by the Boston Red Sox and Boston College.

First pitch is slated for 4 p.m. The game is played annually in honor of former Boston College captain Pete Frates, who was diagnosed with Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) in 2012.

It marks the first season that the ALS Awareness Game will be held at Fenway Park and also the first time that Boston College will play an Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) game at the venue.

Tickets will be general admission for \$10 with all the proceeds benefitting the Pete Frates #3 Fund. The fund was created to aid in Frates' medical costs not covered by health insurance.

Additionally, NC State baseball has a connection to ALS as former standout Chris Combs was diagnosed with the disease in May 2016. He played for the Wolfpack from 1994-97 and is also fighting to bring awareness.

The Wolfpack last played in a Major League Baseball (MLB) stadium in 1996 at the Metrodome, former home of the Minnesota Twins.
