**#WOODWORK**

Senior **MICHAEL WOOD** enters regional play as the ace of the Golden Eagle pitching staff, having served in the No. 1 role for the past 1 1/2 years. On the year, Wood leads Golden Eagle starters with a 5.34 ERA and 8-4 record in 15 starts. He has tossed 84.1 innings with 78 Ks and 22 walks and has taken home 2 OVC Pitcher of the Week honors and a place on the All-OVC Second Team. The Olalla, Wash. native turned in one of the better outings of his career against Belmont back on May 6, pitching in front of his parents for the first time in his Tech career. With his family in town for graduation, Wood completed 7.1 innings while scattering 5 hits and 2 unearned runs to grab his 8th win of the year. He struck out 7 batters and walked none in the outing.

**#USHERUSHER**

Senior **JAKE USHER** turned in a spectacular outing in the 2nd game of the OVC Tournament, holding one of the nation's most potent offenses (Morehead State) to just 4 runs on 6 hits and 3 walks. He struck out 3 while tossing 6.2 innings and gathering his 5th victory of the year, not to mention clinching the Golden Eagles a berth to the OVC Tournament title game. On the year, Usher owns a 5.48 ERA and 5-2 record in 14 starts. He has punched out 56 batters and walked 32 in 69.0 innings pitched while holding batters to a .263 average.

**#FRALIEXFINALE**

Redshirt junior **EVAN FRALIEX** kept his fantastic play in postseason play rolling in the OVC Tournament, helping Tech clinch its 5th tournament title in program history. While moving to 3-0 on the year, the Lexington, Ky. native completed 5.0 innings with just 5 hits and 3 runs allowed. He struck out 3 and walked just 1, despite returning to the rotation just two weeks prior. Fralieux redshirted the 2016 season due to Tommy John surgery performed by Dr. James Andrews. In his first OVC playoff outing in 2014, Fralieux spun a gem of a game against No. 1-seeded Southeast Missouri in 2014, tossing 7.0 innings with just 3 hits and 1 walk allowed. He held the Redhawks to 2 earned runs while striking out 4 for the win. In 2015, he took a tough, no-decision against Morehead State despite 6.2 innings with just 3 earned runs allowed. He scattered 7 hits and posted 3 strikeouts with zero walks in an eventual, extra-inning loss to the Eagles.

**RECORDS WERE MEANT TO BE BROKEN**

Tennessee Tech has really laid waste to the program's record book in 2017, breaking 10 team records with more in the horizon. Matt Bragga's newest edition of the Golden Eagles has tied the school mark of 40 wins and set new standards for at bats (2,178), runs scored (495), hits (698), extra-base hits (248), total bases (1,151), home runs (97), RBI (453), saves (19) and batters struck out (547). Still in view are the program records of singles (8 away), innings pitched (3 away) and putouts (9 away), not to mention the OVC record for batters struck out (8 away).

BRAGGA ON THE BRINK

Head coach Matt Bragga will need a deep run into the postseason from his team to meet his next major milestone at the helm of the Golden Eagles, but never-the-less, he is closing in on his 400th career victory, needing just 7 more in the wins column to become just the second Tech coach to reach the mark. He led Tech to its third OVC regular season title under his watch this season, picking up his third career OVC Coach of the Year honors.

CLIMBING THE RECORD BOOK

RYAN FLICK has put forth an incredible junior season, which also represents his last in a Golden Eagle uniform (Flick graduated this May with a degree in electrical engineering and will pursue a professional career either in the industry or in baseball). With his stellar season, which includes a whopping .381 average, 23 doubles, 17 HR and 65 RBI, he has begun to climb the career record books at Tech. He sits 3rd all-time in home runs (36), 4th in RBI (166), 6th in doubles (47), and 10th in walks (91), all despite playing just three seasons in the purple and gold. He former 2015 OVC Rookie of the Year earned a place on the 2017 All-OVC Second Team.

HE'S FROM SPARTA!

A native of nearby Sparta, Tenn., sophomore ETHAN ROBERTS has put together an even better season than his rookie campaign last year, one in which he earned Freshman All-American honors. Roberts broke the school record for saves in a single season Saturday against Morehead State, totaling his 13th of the season to pass Seth Lucio's mark of 12 (2013). He also set the program mark for consecutive strikeouts against Murray State earlier this season, fanning 9 straight Racer bats. In the game, all 10 of his outs came via the K, part of a streak of 17 consecutive outs recorded at home by punch out. He took home 2017 All-OVC First Team accolades. He also earned 2 OVC Pitcher of the Week honors.

BROOMSTICKS

The Golden Eagles broke out the broomsticks 6 times during the 2017 regular season, taking a four-game set from Toledo to cristen the year and running off 4 straight series to put together their best start to OVC play in program history (12-0). Tech swept three-game series with UT Martin, SIUE, Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois and Murray State.

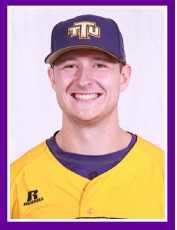

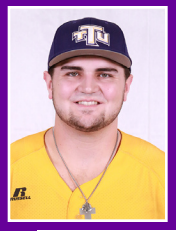
