What is the Glory of God?

- It is the **Weight** of His Presence
 - It is the **Beauty** of His Holiness
 - It is the **Substance** of His Truth
 - It is the **Power** of His Will
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*The Glory of God is the
Manifestation of His Presence,
Holiness, Truth and Will*

(Exodus 33:1–3)

“1 The LORD said to Moses, “Depart; go up from here, you and the people whom you have brought up out of the land of Egypt, to the land of which I swore to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, saying, ‘To your offspring **I will give it.**’ 2 **I will send an angel before you, and I will drive out** the Canaanites, the Amorites, the Hittites, the Perizzites, the Hivites, and the Jebusites. 3 **Go up to a land flowing with milk and honey;...**

What an amazing offer!!!

...but I will not go up among you,
lest I consume you on the way, for you are a stiff-necked people.””

(Exodus 33:15)

“Then Moses said to him, “If your Presence does not go with us, do not send us up from here.”

Life is not worth living without you. Life is meaningless without the presence, holiness, truth, and purposes of God.

17 And the LORD said to Moses, “I will do the very thing you have asked, because I am pleased with you and I know you by name.”

18 Then Moses said, “Now show me your glory.”

(Exodus 34:5-8)

“5 The LORD descended in the cloud and stood with him there, and proclaimed the name of the LORD. 6 The LORD passed before him and proclaimed, “The LORD, the LORD, a God **merciful and gracious, slow to anger**, and abounding in **steadfast love and faithfulness**, 7 keeping steadfast love for thousands, **forgiving** iniquity and transgression and sin, but **who will by no means clear the guilty**,

The Glory of God summed up in two words

1. **Grace** (God is perfectly Loving)

2. **Truth** (God is perfectly Just)

(John 1:14–18)

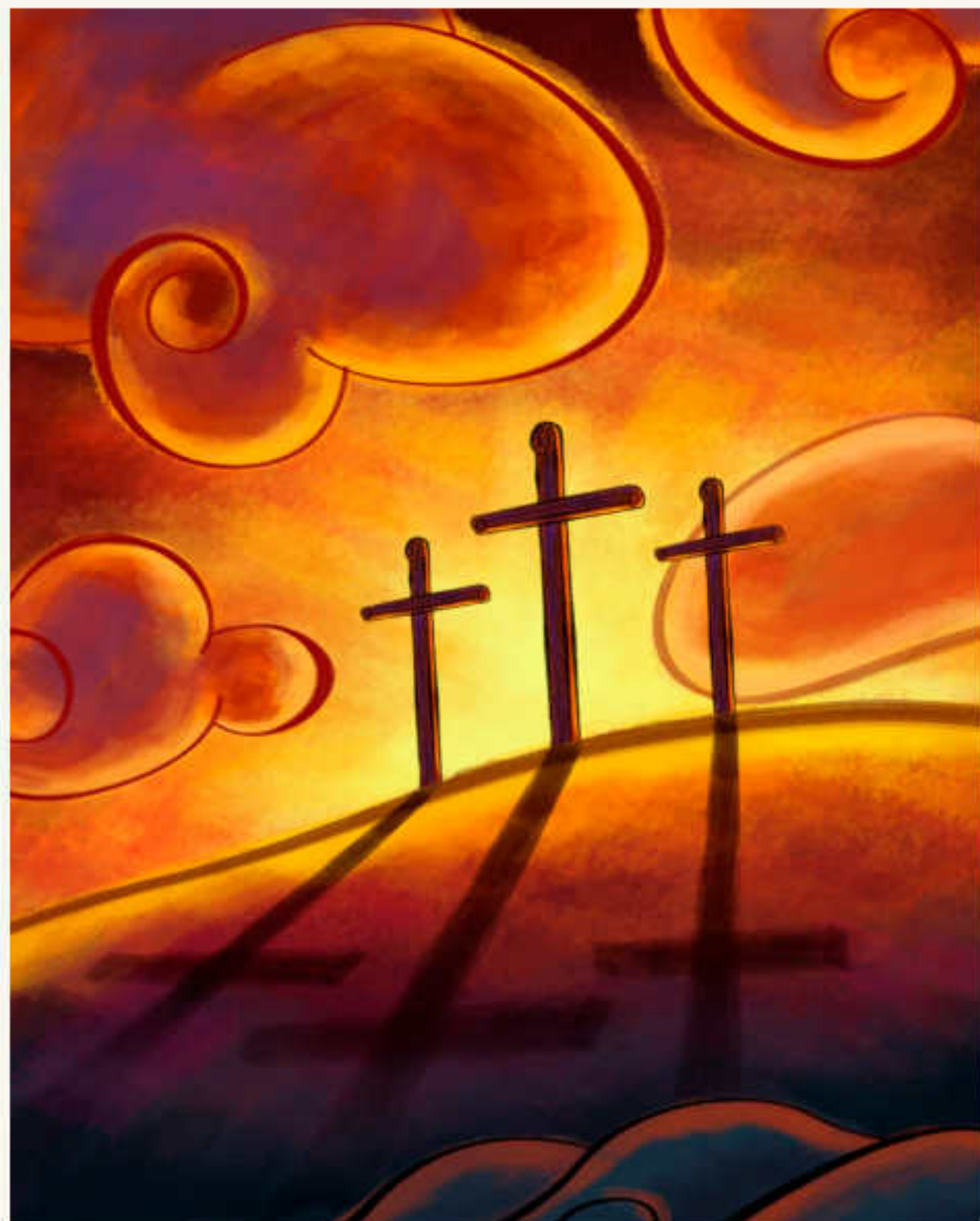
“14 ... and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only (*begotten*) from the Father, full of **grace and truth**... 16 For from his fullness we have all received, grace upon grace. 17 For the law was given through Moses; **grace and truth** came through Jesus Christ. 18 No one has ever seen God; the only (*begotten*) God, who is at the Father's side, he has made him known.”

**The God that Moses
only heard, we have
seen.**

Jesus is God
*(Begotten = of the
same essence, being
and substance of God)*

Thus He Himself is
the full revelation of
God's glory
