

On the day after the Passover, the people of Israel went out triumphantly in the sight of all the Egyptians, 4 while the Egyptians were burying all their firstborn, whom the LORD had struck down among them. On their gods also the LORD executed judgments.” (Numbers 33:1-4)






### The Cities of Refuge








# Guarding the Inheritance.


