

Concentric Circles of Holiness

Numbers 5-6

(Leviticus 19:2 ESV) **““Speak to all the congregation of the people of Israel and say to them, You shall be holy, for I the LORD your God am holy.”**”

Holiness =

- Being separated (called out) from this world.
- Purity in regards to sin.
- Pleasing / Devoted to God.



Numbers 5:1 “The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, 2
“Command the people of Israel that they put out of the
camp everyone who is leprous or has a discharge and
everyone who is unclean through contact with the dead. 3
You shall put out both male and female, putting them
outside the camp, that they **may not defile** their camp, **in
the midst of which I dwell.**” 4 And the people of Israel did
so, and put them outside the camp; as the LORD said to
Moses, so the people of Israel did.





Numbers 5:11 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, 12 “Speak to the people of Israel, If any man’s wife goes astray and breaks faith with him, 13 if a man lies with her sexually, and it is hidden from the eyes of her husband, and she is undetected though she has defiled herself, and there is no witness against her, since she was not taken in the act, 14 and if the spirit of jealousy comes over him and he is jealous of his wife who has defiled herself, or if the spirit of jealousy comes over him and he is jealous of his wife, though she has not defiled herself, 15 then the man shall bring his wife to the priest.... “


