New eC-card app

We are in the very early stages of launching a new C Card app.

This will improve access to condoms for young people as well as make the sign up to our scheme for professionals more efficient and reduce the current paperwork required.

Condom Kitemarks

Currently there is only one requirement which is for a CE mark as this shows that the manufacturer is producing the medical device to the required ISO standard (ISO4074:2016) You are correct in saying they meet BSI standards, since this is exactly the same as European standard denoted by the CE mark. Some products will also have a kitemark which is a check on what has already been checked twice.

With such high standards of electronic testing at the factory, the need for low level additional checks is deemed excessive and rendered redundant.

As from July 2025 a New UKCA quality standard will also be required on all medical Devices. This denotes MHRA approval!

In summary and to help all service providers understand what is needed, I would say the only legal requirement is for a CE quality mark on the packaging and from July 2025 a UKCA quality Mark.

Sharing Nudes Update

Key changes in 2024 version:

- Now covers incidents involving Al-generated images and financially motivated sexual extortion (commonly known as 'sextortion')
- New guidance on seizure of devices by police

The Targeted Outreach team attend Dorset Youth at Risk monthly multiagency meetings (YAR). We are currently attending the Chesil, Dorchester, North Dorset and Purbeck YARS to represent and share any concerns and signpost relevant information regarding Sexual Health Services.

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss and plan a way forward for any young person whom any agency has a concern about. These concerns relate to a young person's risk of CE, CSE, ASB and repeatedly being reported as missing. The focus will be on those who do not have any Social Care or Early Help involvement. Focusing on actions, preventative work and keeping these children out of the Youth Justice system.

Please see The Purbeck YAR highlighted concerns held on 16th January 2024:

• Monkey dust and fentanyl: There has been a surge in Monkey dust & fentanyl in the Chesil & North locality areas, with no reports of an increase in other areas (see poster attached).

THC Vapes: An increase in people using liquid THC in vapes. Trading standards are collecting all confiscated vapes and are happy for professionals to email them and they will then collect. They will test the vapes to see if right levels of ingredients and other safety concerns. *Actions: Please can anyone share intel or concerns that they have around young people selling vapes to Lauren Thomas lauren.thomas@edasuk.org and Police- Safer schools: Community partnership intelligence |

VR Headsets: To be aware of sexualised behaviour on VR headsets. More young people getting VR headsets and they're using it – Year 7 and 8's. Groups are talking about these, it involves lots of role-playing games, and meeting with people, but then there's that other extra element. They all interact with them, and they're fully immersed in it. So please do let me know if you know of any.
