In addition to our RSE Core package, we can also offer **specialised lessons** on Sex and The Media (this includes pornography and sexting), Teenage Pregnancy, Consent, Peer on Peer Harassment and The Power of Language, but would expect students to have received the core package prior to these.

The sessions are free of charge for a small group of identified students 12-15 maximum.
