- **Trash pick-up on the entrance / exit ramps of Hwy. 60;**

- Horse Shoe at City Park
- Roses at City park
- Adopt a berm at City Park (weeding, trimming, etc. for the summer!).
- Trim bushes & trees

Hills Park - Clean Shelter House, Trash pick-up, Pick-up sticks.

- Planter around the sign?

Sheldon Sports Complex Trash pick-up along the fences (ditch across from Hy-Vee) *Sheldon Middle School & Marketing Committee volunteers.*

Thorman Park

- Planting flowers ongoing watering of plants Weeding & trimming of the berm
