A Babysitter Pass can be added to the Sheldon Outdoor Aquatic Center Family Member Pass for an additional charge of \$30. Only one babysitter is allowed to be registered on the family's membership. The babysitter is only allowed to use the family's Babysitter Pass when attending the Outdoor Aquatic Center with at least one child from the Family Membership. When not caring for the child/children on the Family Membership, the babysitter is responsible for their own pool entry (e.g. punch card, individual membership, etc.). Babysitters must be 16 years of age or older.

Babysitter passes are non-refundable. Babysitter passes are non-transferrable.

A Babysitter Pass will be removed from the Family Membership and no refund will be issued if any of the following occurs:

- 1. A babysitter uses the Babysitter Pass without accompanying the child/children on the Family Member Pass.
- 2. A babysitter misuses the Family Member Pass/Babysitter Pass.
- 3. A member on the Family Member Pass attempts to use the Babysitter Pass for a caregiver not listed under the Family Member Pass/Babysitter Pass.
