Idaho PITA State Shoot. Boise Gun Club. June 27-29, 2025.

124 shooters from Idaho, Washington, Oregon, Nevada, California, Montana, British Columbia, and Utah enjoyed a nice weekend with breezes on Friday and Saturday that held scores down a little bit. 69,500 registered targets were thrown over the three days.

Rookie shooter Grant Tarke won the state handicap with a near perfect 99.

Tony Shuyler defeated junior shooter Blake McCutcheon for the Singles championship after their 197's.

Phillip Barrus was the state Doubles champion after topping Stuart Welton in a shoot-off after they tied with 99's. McCutcheon was the HAA champ all alone with 389 X 400, and Mike Houser won the HOA with 755 X 800.
