Twigs, branches, decomposing wood, tree bark, tall trees, amazing colors --- let a walk into the woods lead you into new design possibilities in this workshop. Inspirational line work awaits you. Discover possibilities for original designs in a color palette new to you. Play with a variety of techniques in small studies during the development process of discovering a design to focus on with wood as your inspiration. You may choose to explore a variety of ideas in smaller quilts or make one larger piece. The decision will be yours. Jean's books "Intuitive Design and Color" (2<sup>nd</sup> edition) and "Journey to Inspired Art Quilting" are good references.

## **SUPPLY LIST**

Choose to piece, applique, fuse, or use a combination of techniques, letting your inspiration lead the way. When considering fabric think about texture as well as color. Commercial fabric, hand dyed, solids, batiks, textural prints. Look for a color palette new to you with strong value changes as well as richness in color. You will need three to four yards of a variety of fabrics, some treasured scrapes just might find a home in the creations. Bring printed on paper images that excite for line and shape inspiration. Do not try to work off of a phone or iPad! ***You will most likely have these supplies when you work at home or you may have similar supplies that you can make work.***

- Sewing machine in good working order, (embroidery foot or free motion quilting foot)
- Medium or large size cutting mat
- Medium size rotary cutter with new blade (no large cutters)
- 6" x 12" or ruler or larger
- Scissors
- Box of pins
- Embroidery needles and thread if you are going to hand stitch
- Chalk marking pencil
- 1 1/2 yd of flannel or quilt batting for a design wall
- Unlined journal style notebook at least 8" x 10"
- Glue stick

**KEEP GOING...YOU'RE ALMOST AT THE END!**

- Fusible web like Wonder Under (1/2 yd)
- Mechanical pencil, Fine tip, Extra fine tip sharpie pens, several sheets of tracing paper
- Backing and batting if you are going to explore several smaller designs and might want to quilt them.
- Optional, digital camera or phone.
