We are in the process of updating our in-house TV Channel so that now all Health Center residents will be able to watch live informational broadcasts, movies, exercise classes and other “group” events. Our team is working on having a live feed set up so you can join us in this event. Information for the live stream will be communicated to you by noon tomorrow, April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

For those residents who have previously indicated that they would like to participate in the Service, a Seder Plate with all the items will be distributed to each Suite/Apartment in advance. Staff have been assigned to assist residents throughout the service as needed.

The Culinary Team is busy preparing an amazing traditional Passover Dinner with entree choices of Brisket, Salmon and Roasted Chicken and all the accompaniments for everyone to enjoy following the service.

Our goal is for every resident to forget, at least for a little while, about what’s happening around us, and experience this “Virtual Seder” and enjoy a meaningful Passover with their Sinai family.
