Meetings

- Sponsorship revenue for NANOG 77 was second highest revenue on record, second only to the sponsorship revenue for NANOG 75 in San Francisco.

Elections

• The staff is evaluating a new tool for future elections due to concerns with Big Pulse. The Board will review the options before a decision is made. Once a tool has been selected, the staff will run a mock election and invite members to volunteer to test the new tool before it is used in an actual election.

Outreach

- Edward just returned from the Indigenous Community Summit where he gave a <u>talk on</u> <u>NANOG the community and its various opportunities</u>. It was well received, and most had never heard of NANOG. Some attendees committed to come to a future NANOG meeting, and the University of Hawaii plans to submit NCI applications.
- <u>University Outreach Tour</u> starts Sunday, November 17, 2019. Edward found sponsors to be very excited about University Outreach, and they are interested in supporting it. A spring tour in the Northeast is in the planning stage.
- STEM talks for the Montgomery of Alabama Chamber of Commerce will take place December 5-6.
