

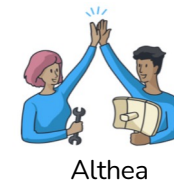

Seattle Community Network

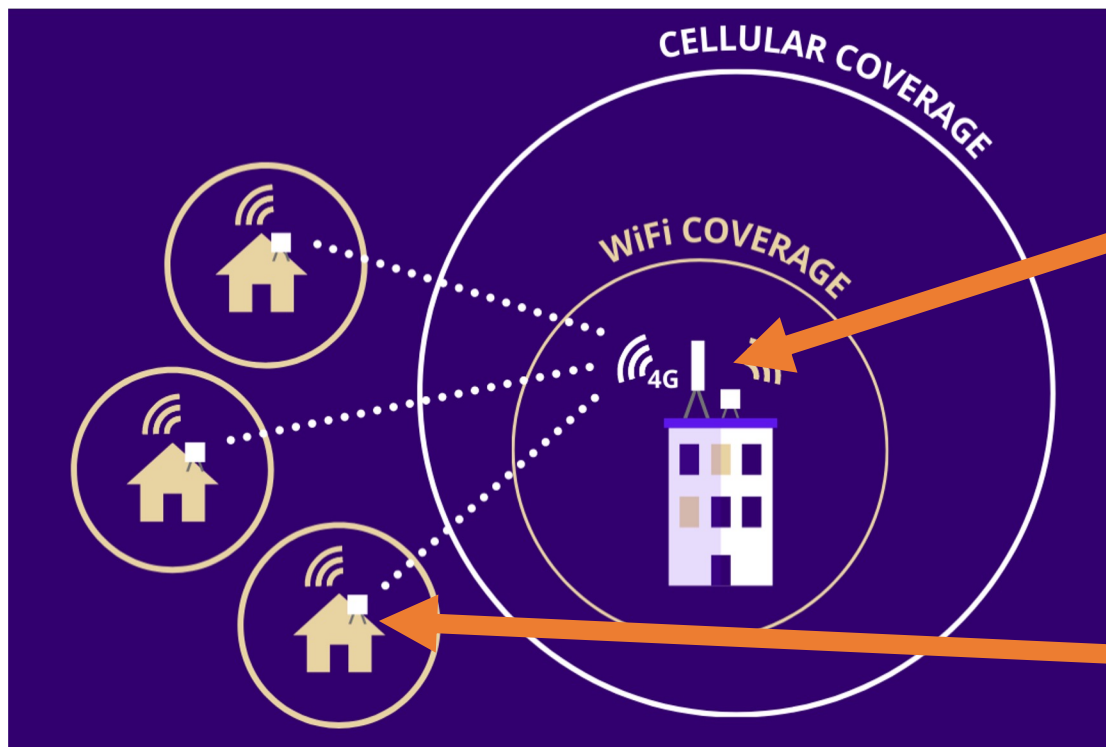
Building free/low-cost access networks in Seattle area for those who:

- **can't afford** to pay for service or devices
- **don't know how** to connect to access networks

Free for *Seniors, Unemployed, Housing-unstable, majority non-English-speaking, low-income families of students.* **For others, suggested-donation cost**



Our LTE Network (Seattle Community Network)



- Cell sites on tall buildings distribute LTE to phones/CPE (fixed wireless)
- CBRS band (LTE Band 48)

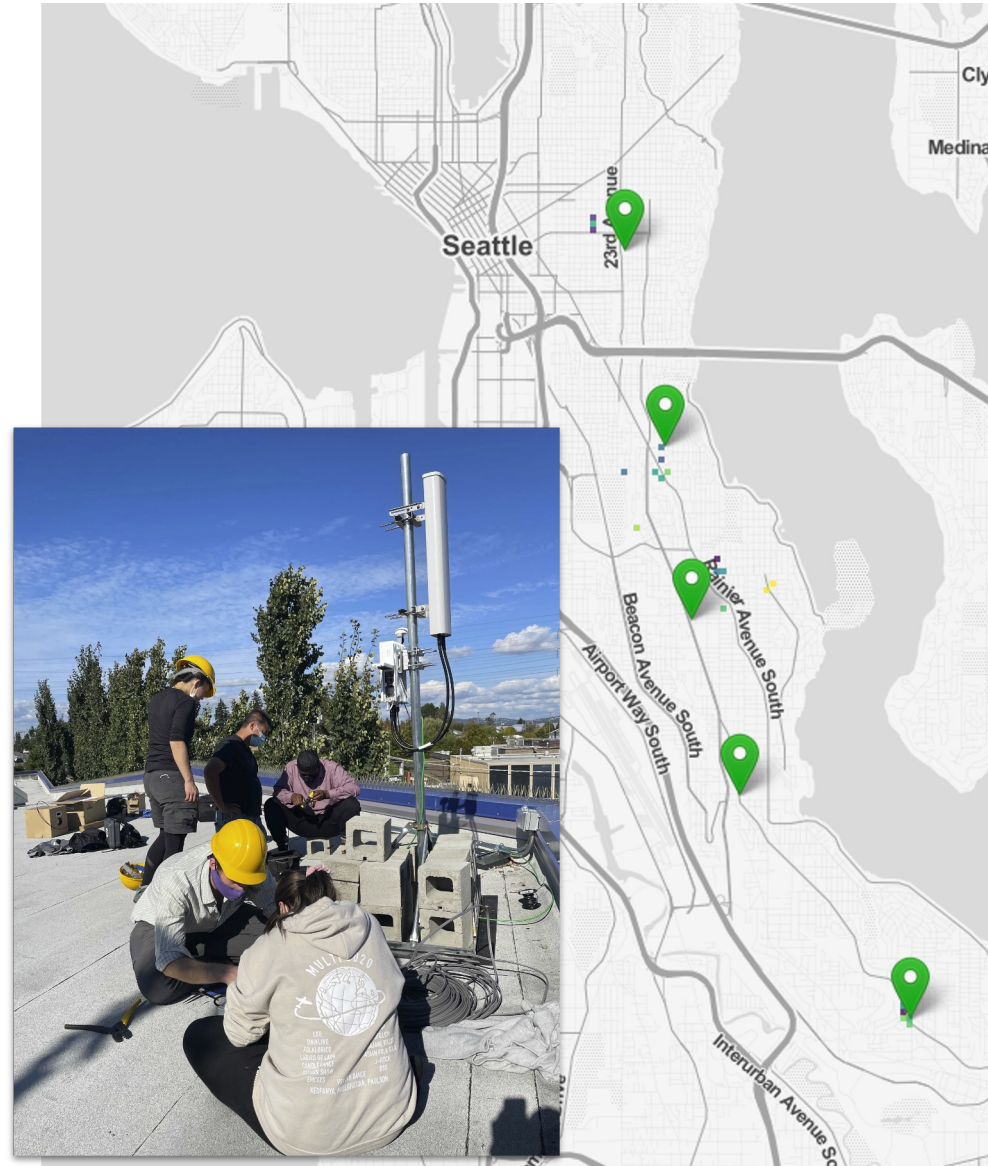
4G LTE CPE provide Internet connection to home WiFi routers

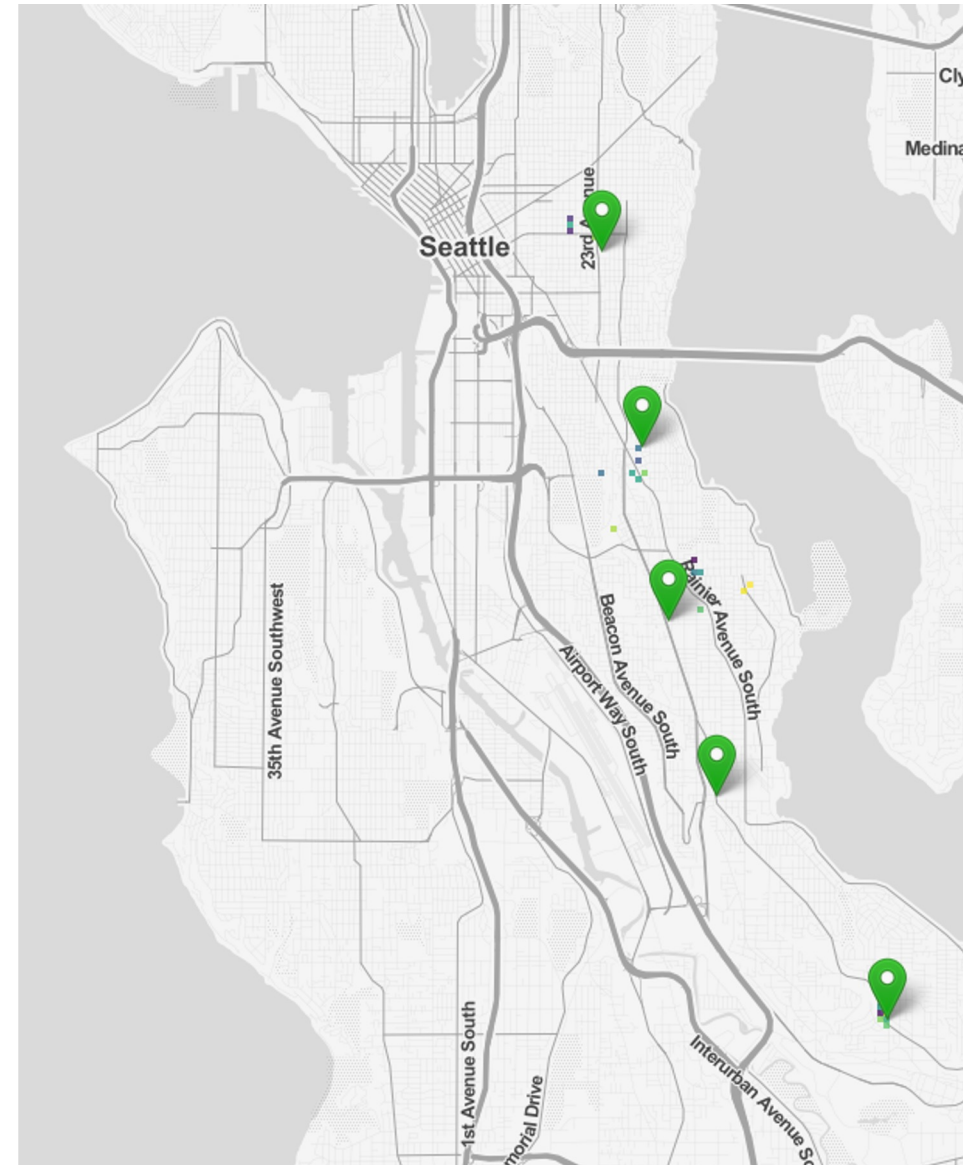

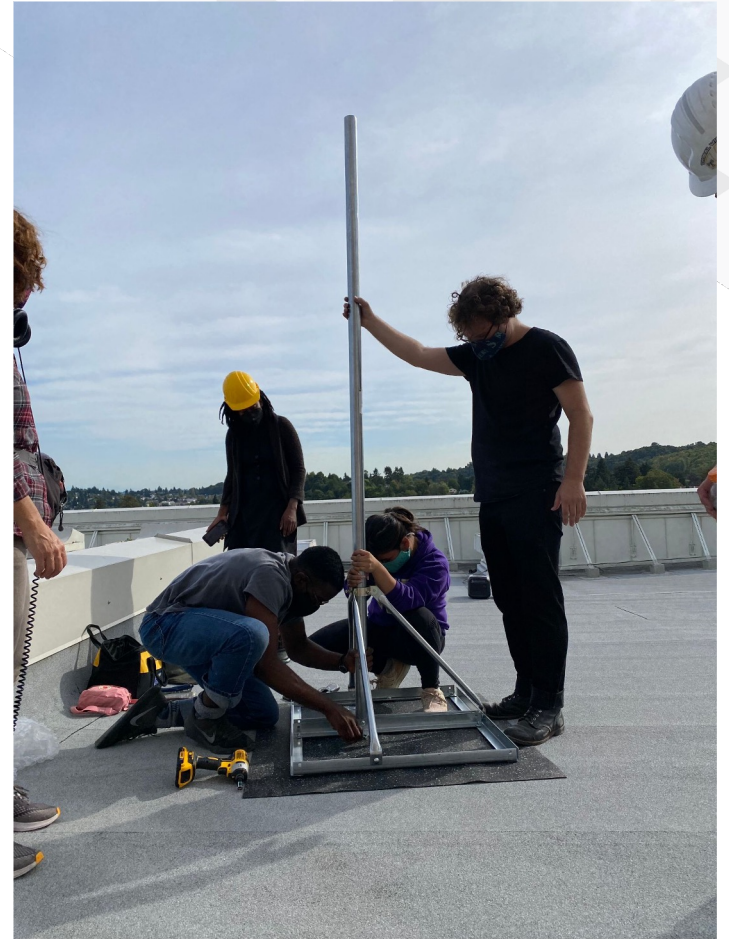
