

### **2024 Priorities**

- EDUCATE the community about the multi-stakeholder approach to Internet governance, highlighting the significance and objectives of Regional Internet Registries.
- CHAMPION for the continued adoption of IPv6.
- ADVANCE Routing Security services through the utilization of Resource Public Key Infrastructure (RPKI) and Internet Routing Registry (IRR).
- CONDUCT two Public Policy meetings, manage the 2024 Election cycle, and administer Fellowship and Grant programs.
- ENGAGE with the community by participating in industry events, delivering presentations, and offering customer support through help desks.
- CREATE enhanced e-learning modules to provide additional educational resources to the community.



# **RPKI Services Development Priorities**

#### IRR/RPKI integration re-release

- ROA actions create and/or delete linked IRR route objects (after user consent)
- ARIN Authenticated IRR objects reduce negative impact from objects in 3rd party databases


### **RPKI/ROA Intelligence**

- ACSP 2022.30 Improvement to ROA Functionality pending consult in 2024
- Provide foreknowledge of potential impact from ROA creation
- Show ROA validity state based on near real-time data from global BGP table

#### **RPKI advanced features to ARIN Online interface**

- Download full list of ROAs to a file for off-line processing
- Enable ROA changes via file upload
- Allow Organizations to self-withdraw from RPKI services (ACSP 2022.26)





# ARIN Membership Updates

ASN-only holders are now classified as Service Members under a Registration Services Plan (RSP)

As of 30 January 2024: Service Members: 23,372 General Members: 1,903 **Total Members: 25,275** 

As a Service Member, you may request to be a General Member if ARIN's governance is important to your organization.

\*ARIN provides basic services to approximately 14,000 customers which hold Internet number resources that are not currently covered under any type of agreement with ARIN.



# **ASN Fee Harmonization**

The Fee Harmonization process, initiated on 1 January 2022, is now complete.

### **Effective 1 January 2024:**



Transitioned ASNs to the Registration Services Plan (RSP) Fee Schedule.



Removed the \$550 ASN issuance fee.



Converted ASN-only holders to Service Members, making them eligible for General Membership.



# Expiration of Legacy Fee Cap

As of 1 January 2024, ARIN no longer offers a Fee Cap for Legacy resources brought under an Agreement.

The Fee Cap will continue for Legacy resources that were brought under an Agreement before 1 January 2024.



Organizations are not required to use a Qualified Facilitator for IPv4 or ASN resource transfers, however it can streamline the process with ARIN Registration Services.
