Standardised Tests

Beidh na daltaí ag gabháil do Scrúdaithe Caighdeánaithe sa Triú Téarma. Standardised tests will be administered to First to Sixth Class pupils in May/June as follows: Gaeilge- Seachtain ag tosnú 21ú Bealtaine, Béarla- Seachtain ag tosnú 28ú Bealtaine, Mata- Seachtain ag tosnú 4ú Meitheamh.

The reading tests in English and Irish give information about how well your child can understand what he/she has read. The tests do not gather information on your child's written or spoken ability. The maths test finds out how well your child can use numbers for different purposes and solve maths problems. The purpose of using standardised tests are to help the teacher plan your child's learning and to inform you about how well your child is doing in English Reading and Maths relative to children of the same age profile nationally. The class teacher will share the results with you in the School Report. Your child's attendance in school is important on these days.

It is best practice not to share your child's results with him/her as it provides a limited profile. It is extremely important to develop your child's self-confidence and to foster a positive attitude towards all aspects of their learning.
