Gaelscoil Charraig na Siúire

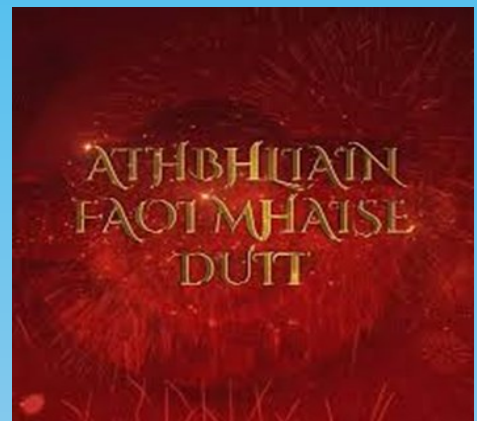


Athbhliain faoi mhaise is faoi shéan.

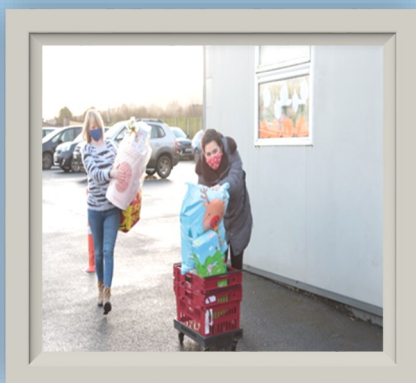
