Covid 19

Agus ár scoil ag athoscailt do scoilbhliain 2021/2022, tá sé tábhachtach go ndíreoimis arís eile ar na bearta a chuideoidh lenár bpobail scoile fanacht sábháilte le linn na bliana acadúla seo.

Tá paidéim Covid-19 i réim go fóill, mar sin féin tá fáil ar vaicsíniú go forleathan dóibh siúd a bhfuil sé dlite dóibh agus tá sé le feiceáil againn go bhfuil leas á bhaint ag mórán daoine as ar fud na sochaí. Cuidíonn sé sin le cosaint a thabhairt dóibh siúd is mó atá i mbaol agus laghdaíonn sé go suntasach an dochar a bhaineann le hionfhabhtú ó Covid-19 ina gcás siúd a bhfuil vacsaíniú iomlán faighte acu.

Bearta um chosc agus Rialú

Ionfhabhtuithe 1) Sula ndéantar freastal ar an scoil: Comharthaí - Cinntigh, le do thoil, nach gcuireann tú do pháiste ar scoil má tá comharthaí ar bith d'ionfhabhtú Covid-19 á léiriú acu.

2) Taobh istigh de do scoil - Bearta maolaithe – cuireadh réimse de bhearta rialaithe i bhfeidhm chun an baol a bhaineann le scaipeadh Covid-19 a laghdú agus chun sábháilteacht, sláinte agus leas foirne, scoláirí, tuismitheoirí agus cuairteoirí a chosaint a oiread agus is féidir taobh istigh den scoil. Is é an bealach is fearr chun scaipeadh Covid-19 a chosc ná scaradh fisiciúil a chleachtadh agus sláinteachas ceart lámh a fheidhmiú; daoine fásta i mbunscoileanna masc a chaitheamh agus saoráidí agus seomraí ranga a aerú.

Covid 19

As we reopen for the 2021/2022 school year, it is important that we renew our focus on the measures that will help our school community to stay safe during this academic year.

The Covid-19 pandemic is ongoing, however vaccination is widely available for all eligible and we have seen very high up-takes across society. This helps protect those most vulnerable and very significantly reduces the harm associated with Covid-19 infection for those who are fully vaccinated. However, we still need to work together to ensure we continue with all measures to best keep Covid 19 out of our school and that we minimise opportunity for onward spread of Covid-19 within school, and our communities at large. The infection prevention and control measures in place in our school have worked very effectively to prevent and control Covid-19. This is down to the immense efforts made by all in our entire school community to implement and adhere to these measures. **Thank you sincerely for all efforts in this regard.**

Infection prevention and Control Measures

: 1) **Before attending school: Symptoms** - Please keep your child at home if they have any symptoms of Covid-19 infection. We advise parents to take a precautionary approach, particularly for children less able to articulate their symptoms, that if they seem unwell, to observe them at home and contact their GP as appropriate.

Covid-19. Close contacts - if you have been told by the HSE services that your child is a close contact of a case of Covid-19, they need to restrict their movements at home and will be offered testing, as soon as possible after they have been identified and then at day 10. Once they are asymptomatic and have received their 'not detected' test result from day 10 test, they can stop restricting their movements and return to school.

2) Within our school – Mitigation measures – A range of essential control measures have been implemented to reduce the risk of the spread of Covid-19 virus and to protect the safety, health and welfare of staff, students, parents and visitors as far as possible within the school.
