School Uniform & Dress Code

Clogheen Kerry Pike NS encourages every pupil in this school to wear the school uniform. Wearing the full school uniform is seen as an important element in maintaining an ordered environment in which pupils can learn. Proper attention to and respect for the school uniform reinforces the school ethos and our code of behaviour.

School Uniform:

Our school uniform is worn on all school days unless parents / guardians are notified of a change.

As we recently changed our uniform (September 2024) with full consultation with Staff, Parents, Pupils and the Board of Management, we expect a period of transition before the whole school is wearing the new uniform. We expect this to happen by September 2026. At this point, all pupils should wear the new uniform and adhere to this policy, unless by prior agreement with the Principal.

Uniform Items:

- Crested School Tracksuit to be worn by all pupils
- School Tee shirt
- School Crested shorts only
- Runners

School Shorts can be worn in warm weather.

Dress Code:

The Board of Management endeavours to maintain the highest of standards in matters of dress code and personal appearance for all pupils in the school.

Accordingly, the Board requests that parents ensure that pupils comply with these standards in matters of general appearance, dress, hairstyles and jewellery during the school term.

The designated school uniform must be worn by pupils during the school day.

- A simple stud earring is permitted. Dangling / long / looped earrings, bracelets and necklaces are prohibited for health and safety reasons. Regular watches are permitted; however, pupils are required to remove watches during Physical Education and other activities. Children with glasses should bring their storage case to school so they can be stored safely and securely.
- Make up of any description is not permitted in school.
- Pupils are asked to keep their hair neat and tidy. Shoulder length and longer hair must be tied back in the interests of hygiene.
