



Parent Interview Week


Hi all...It's parent interview week.

I wanted to send out a quick note reminding parents / carers of the processes for Parent Interview Week and how we intend to keep everyone as safe as possible.

1. Parents / Carers will be asked to wait outside the **MAIN OFFICE** until your interview time.
2. Mrs Ritchie will let you into the school building at your interview time.
3. As far as possible, **only 1 parent / carer** should attend the interview.
4. All parents / carers will be required to wear a mask upon entering the school grounds.
5. A bell will ring to signal the end of your parent interview – interviews must finish when the bell rings. This is to allow staff the time to get the room ready for the next parent. If you feel you need more time to speak with the class teacher, after the bell rings, please let the teacher know and they will arrange a follow up appointment after half term.
6. Parents and carers should then exit the school building via the **Primary 1 Doors**.

If you have your parent interview arranged over the phone, please be advised that the call may come from an unknown number.

During this interview you will get a copy of some of your child's scores. Scores will be sent home for parents having an interview via phone. The October Half Term Progress Card will look similar to the card pictured below. **Please be advised that the CLASS AVERAGE stated on the card is the STANDARDISED AVERAGE which will always be 100. The same way that our end of year assessments and the AQE Exams are marked.**
